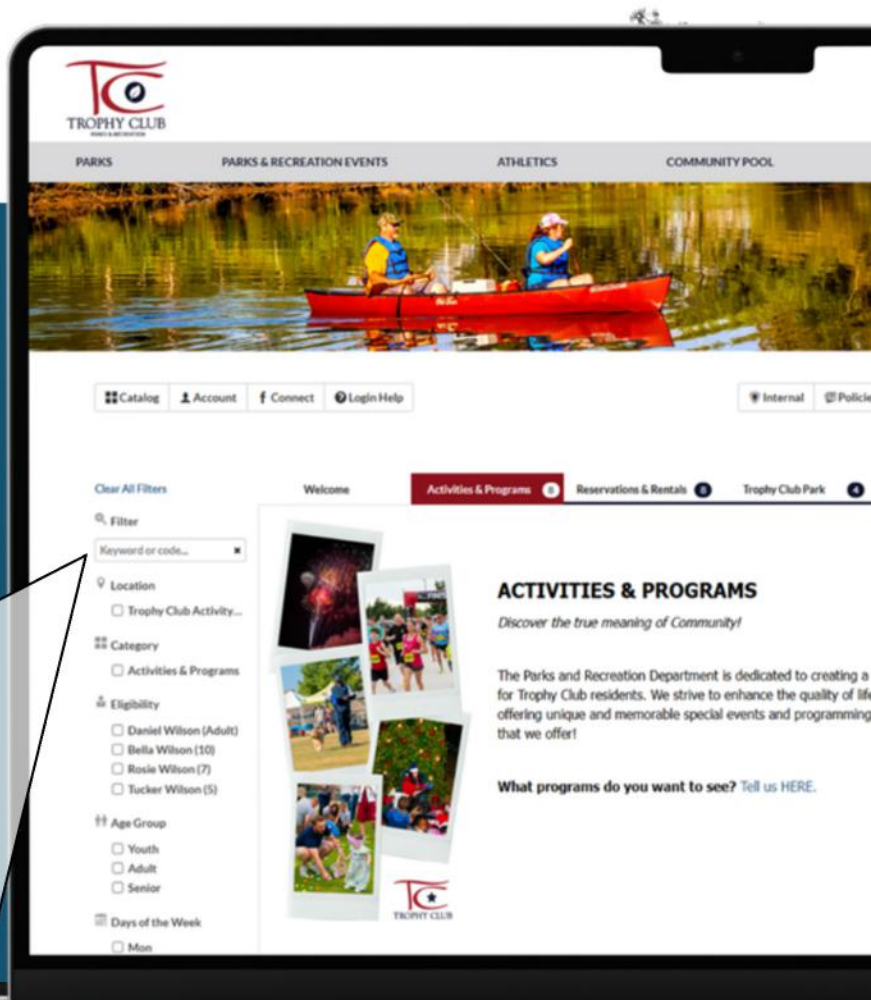

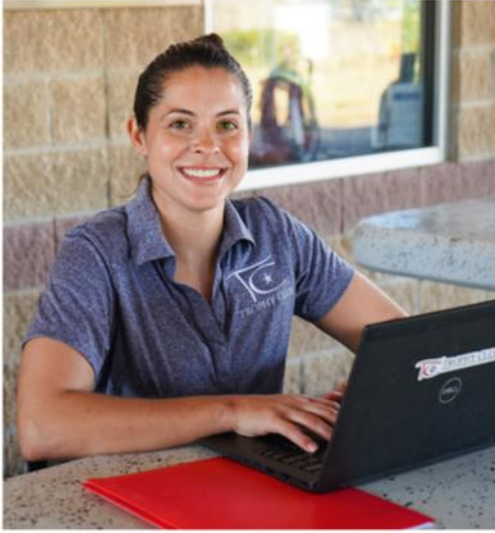

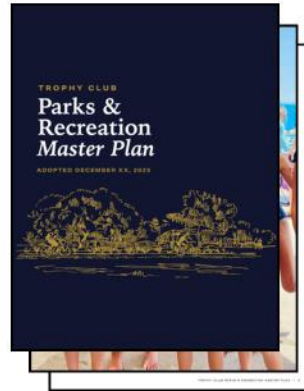

Recently adopted by the Town Council in February of 2026, the Parks & Recreation Master Plan serves as a comprehensive, long-range roadmap for the future of parks, facilities, programs, and operations in Trophy Club. Developed through community input, data analysis, and collaboration with Town leadership, the Master Plan helps ensure that decisions are intentional, fiscally responsible, and aligned with the needs and values of residents. It provides a unified framework to guide capital investments, policy development, and service delivery while supporting the department's commitment to excellence, equity, and sustainability. The plan includes recommendations on future park and facility developments, financial policies, and recreational opportunities that will guide the department in its future development.

TREE INVENTORY & MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Tree Inventory & Management Plan project aims to digitally scan and catalog all publicly owned trees to create a comprehensive, data-driven understanding of the Town's urban forest. Guided by certified arborists and landscape architects, the project will result in a long-term management plan focused on the preservation, conservation, and maintenance of trees throughout the Town. This plan will help inform future maintenance practices, improve tree health and safety, and support thoughtful planning decisions that protect this valuable community asset for years to come.

PARK HOURS & RULES

Hours: 6:00 am - 10:00 pm, except Trophy Club Park. Town Ordinance §1.08.061 provides guidelines of proper and safe use of Town parks. When visiting, please observe the following to make your experience and that of others more enjoyable:

- Please leave these items at home: alcoholic beverages, glass containers and unleashed pets.
- Leave your motorized vehicles, such as golf carts, in designated parking areas - do not drive or park on the grass.
- Please confine your fires to the barbeque grills and your litter to the proper containers, both of which are located throughout the system.
- Be sure to pick up after your pets.
- NO loitering or soliciting.
- NO damaging or defacing park property.

PARK RENTALS

Host your next gathering at one of Trophy Club's beautiful parks! We offer a variety of rental options, including pavilions, athletic fields, and special event spaces, perfect for birthdays, picnics, and community events. HARMONY PARK PAVILION

The reservation of the Harmony Park Pavilion includes private use of the area, including the large charcoal grill and picnic tables.. Lighting is available for evening events.

- **Capacity:** 50 people
- **Trophy Club Residents:** \$100 per 4-hour block
- **Non-Residents:** \$150 per 4-hour block



TROPHY CLUB PARK PAVILION

Trophy Club Park provides a large covered pavilion with two ceiling fans, lighting, electricity and two eight-foot bench-style picnic tables. A second smaller pavilion houses a six-foot bench style picnic table and is adjacent to a charcoal grill and a water fountain.

- **Capacity:** 50 people
- **Trophy Club Residents:** \$150 per 4-hour block
- **Non-Residents:** \$200 per 4-hour block



INCLEMENT WEATHER

Park closures due to weather are updated regularly to keep visitors informed. Check the latest status by visiting www.trophyclub.org/rainout or calling the Rainout Line at 682-214-6024. Stay safe and plan ahead before heading out!

When lightning is detected with a 10-mile radius of a park or thunder is heard, the park will close all amenities for 30 minutes. Independence Park, Harmony Park, and the Community Pool are equipped with Outdoor Warning Systems (OWS) that will sound when inclement weather is detected (one, 10-second tone) and again when the 30-minute "All Clear" timer has expired after the weather has passed (three short tones).

TAKING CARE OF TROPHY CLUB'S PARKS

Determining Residency

Trophy Club Parks & Recreation determines residency based on an individual's primary place of residence. A resident is defined as any person whose permanent, legal address is within the corporate limits of The Town of Trophy Club. Residency may be verified through a valid government-issued ID, utility bill, lease agreement, or other official documentation. Non-residents are those who reside outside Trophy Club town limits, regardless of property ownership or employment within the town. Residency status may impact program fees, facility access, and other departmental services. False representation of residency status may result in denial of services, revocation of privileges, or additional fees.
