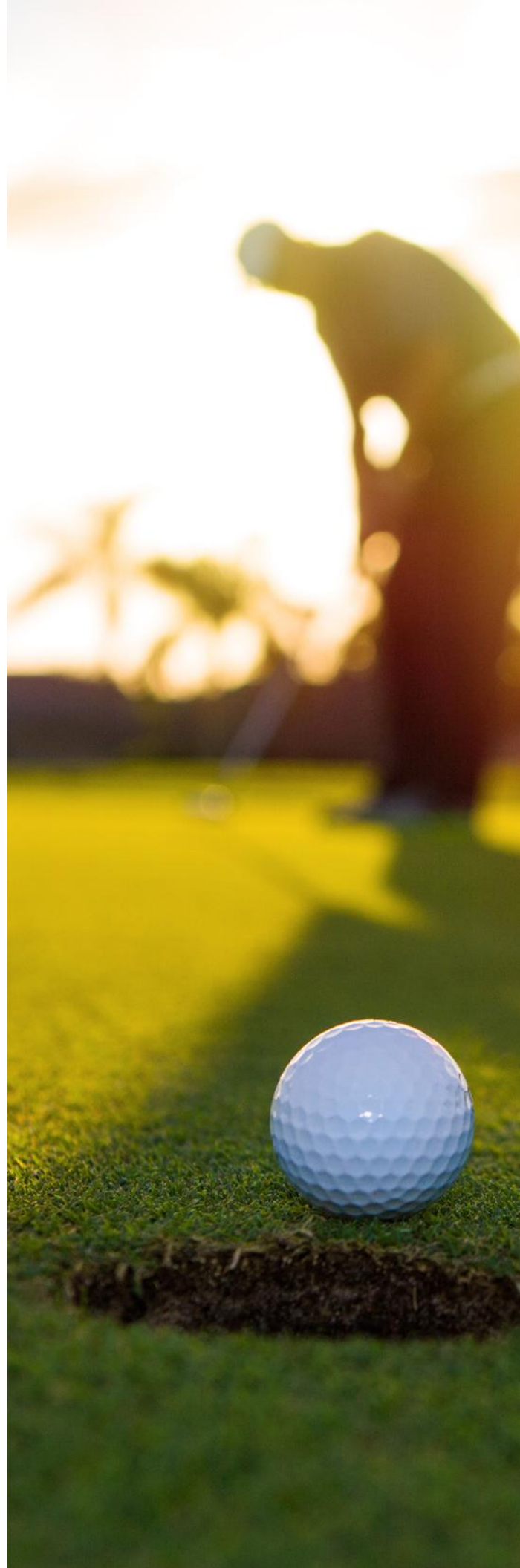

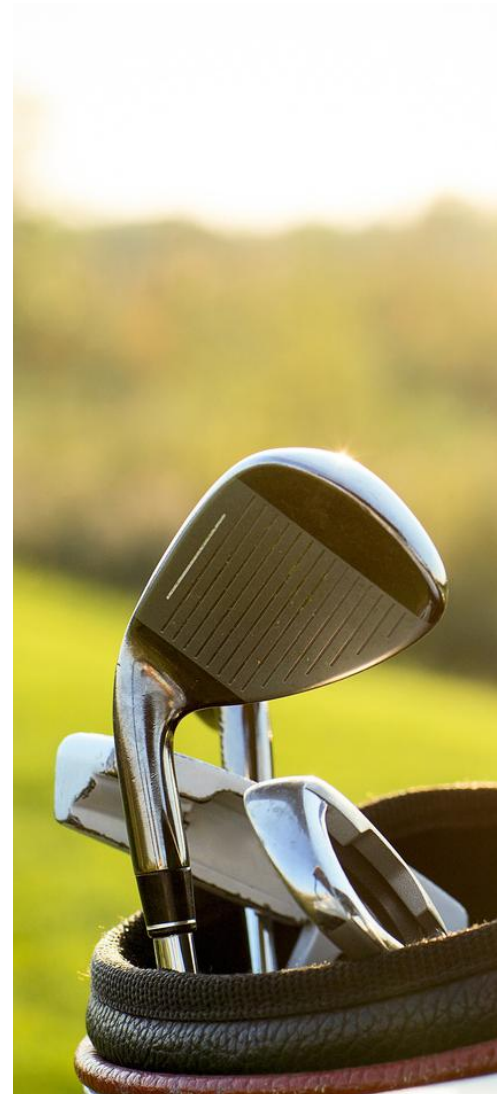
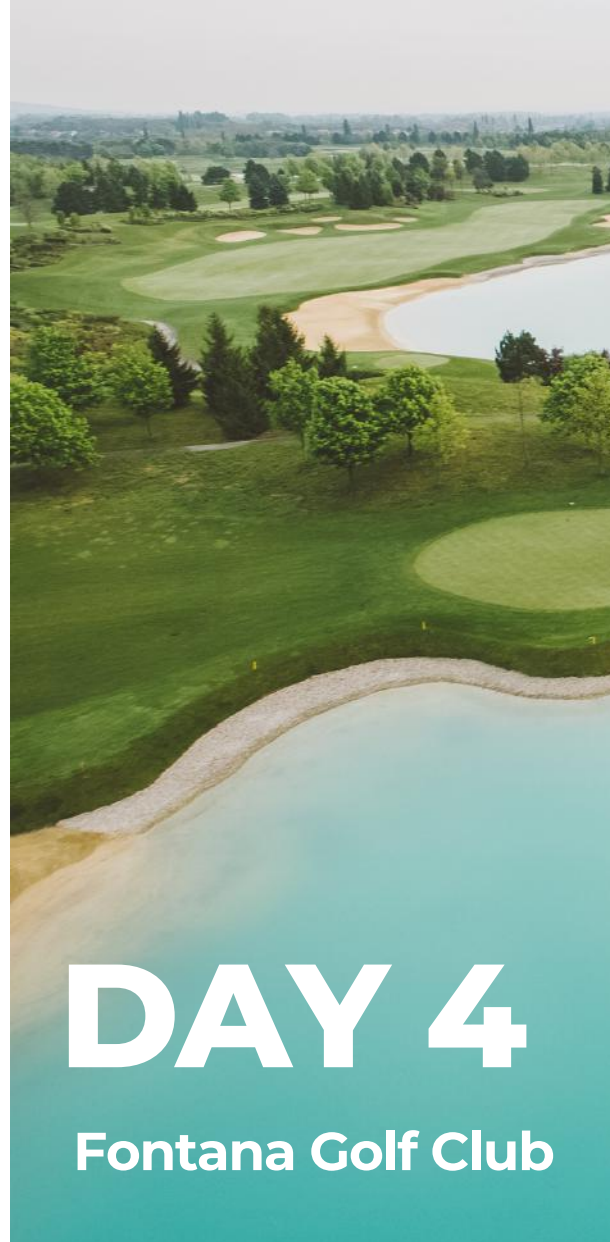

With challenging bunkers, water features, and fair yet rewarding holes, Fontana has hosted the European Tour and is ranked among the top golf courses in Europe.

After returning to the ship and enjoying dinner, prepare for an evening of pure elegance with the “Sound of Vienna” classical concert (*Optional excursion). Set in the very hall where Johann Strauss once led his orchestra, this magical performance features a mix of waltzes, operettas, and ballet, capturing the timeless beauty of Viennese music. Let the melodies of Strauss and Mozart sweep you into the heart of Austria’s cultural soul.

DAY 5

Dürnstein

SCENIC WACHAU VALLEY

Step into the storybook charm of Dürnstein, a picturesque village in Austria's Wachau Valley. Wander cobble streets lined with historic buildings and castle ruins as your guide shares stories of the town's rich heritage. Along the way, sample local apricot treats—from juice and brandy to liqueur—made from the region's famed fruit.

Continue to the 700-year-old Schloss Dürnstein for sweeping views of the Danube and surrounding cliffs. Then visit the striking Dürnstein Abbey, known for its blue Baroque tower. End your tour with a glass of local wine—a perfect toast to this unforgettable cultural experience.

Optional Excursion:

Melk Abbey - A Baroque Jewel

Melk Abbey is an Austrian Benedictine abbey and one of the world's most famous monastic sites. The impressive Baroque abbey was built between 1702 and 1736 and is the biggest monastery complex of the Austrian baroque period. The abbey's church, with frescos by Johann Michael Rottmayr, and the impressive library with countless medieval manuscripts and frescos by Paul Troger are particularly noteworthy.

A guided tour takes you through the abbot's chambers, along the emperor's walk, through the marble hall, the balconies and the library.



DAY 6

Linz

Quellness Golf Resort

The Legendary Beckenbauer Golf Course

Today's golfing highlight takes you to the renowned Quellness Golf Resort, home to the prestigious Beckenbauer Golf Course, designed by golfing legend Bernhard Langer. 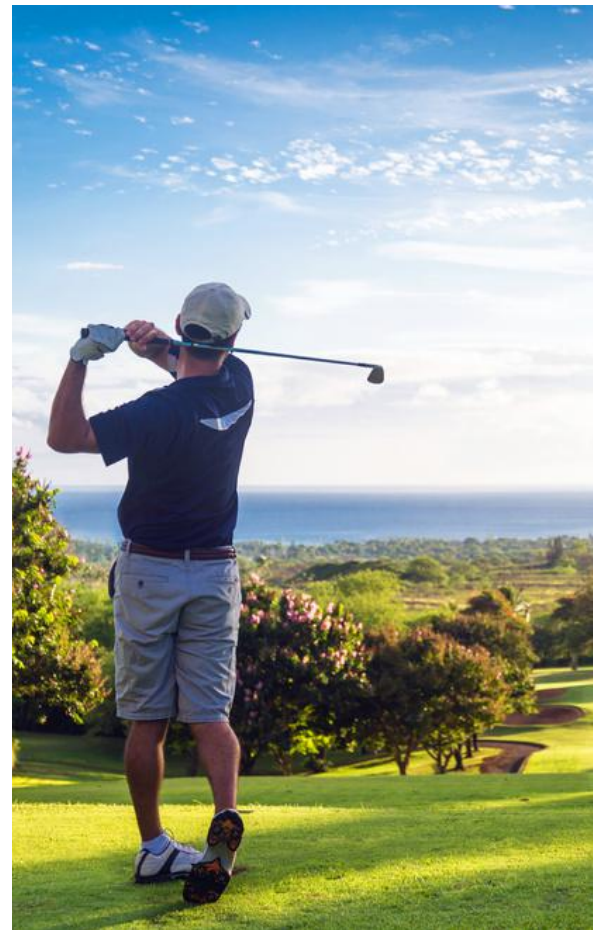
