### Whirlpool galaxy

The view of the Whirlpool Galaxy (M51), using near-infrared rays, left an unexpected image taken by the Spitzer Space Telescope. M51 is being captured by the Hubble Space Telescope in the visible light. Right is image taken by the Chandra X-ray Observatory.



**Redshift**  
Astronomers have discovered that the spectra of remote galaxies are becoming less and less energetic. This is due to the expansion of the universe. The farther from our galaxy they are, the more they are moving away from us and the higher they recede. Due to this receding they lose energy. The wavelength of an object moving away from the observer increases and some of these waves are the red part of the spectrum. Conversely, blue shift occurs when an object moves towards the observer.

### Black hole

This large image of a supermassive black hole, located in the middle of the M87 galaxy. The black hole itself is smaller, the dark spot in the middle is just its shadow. It is surrounded with its gas, whose radiation has managed to reach Earth. That's why we see the image as completely black.

### Our galaxy

The word Milky Way refers to the galaxy we live in. It consists of stars visible to the naked eye, including our Sun which, like the Galactic Centre, is at the distance of roughly 26 thousand light years. What we see from the side, the Galaxy appeared already from its formation, roughly 13 to 14 thousand light years. On the other hand, it's approximately 200 thousand light years wide. It contains roughly 300 billion stars.

### Elliptical galaxies


Elliptical galaxies are one of the largest star islands in the universe. Though they're not as impressive as their spiral siblings, their luminosity may be even greater. The image shows the large elliptical galaxy M87 in the Virgo constellation, located 54 million light years away from us.

### Galaxy cluster

Galaxies don't live being alone. Most of them are bound by gravity to other galaxies, forming so-called clusters. Small galaxy clusters contain several tens of stars, others, large ones take up the space of tens of millions light years on average, encompassing up to thousands of star islands!

### Edwin Hubble

In 1929, when Edwin Hubble created his telescope on the Mount Wilson in the Milky Way, he was still in town. The major galaxy which he spotted had been considered to be nothing more than a bigger star in the night sky made into thousands of stars. Then, Hubble found out we were living in the middle of a huge every island - a galaxy. Over time, astronomers discovered our distant worlds, however, didn't turn out to be star systems. Many of them were dark clouds in our galaxy but there were also some which weren't related at all. These included the Andromeda Nebula in 1925 and 1929 when the U.S. astronomer Edwin Hubble learned it was a very distant galaxy, similar to ours.



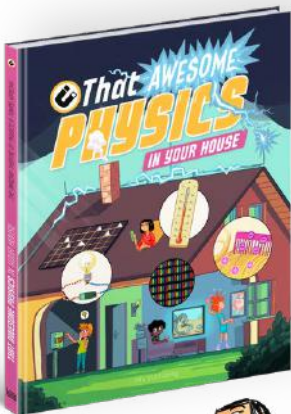

## MEDICINE OF THE ISLAMIC WORLD

While in medieval Europe medicine was still finding its way, in the Islamic world, influenced by the traditions of Greece, Persia, Assyria and India, it had reached a very high level. The period between the 9th and 12th centuries is regarded as Islamic medicine's golden age. At Baghdad's House of Wisdom, which originated in the 8th century, translations of works by great scholars of Antiquity were produced, and Islamic physicians would continue to build on their knowledge and insights. So it was that in the Middle Ages, only the Islamic world had a unified system of medicine.

### BALANCE AGAIN

The human body contains four humors: blood, phlegm, black bile, yellow bile. These four fluids correspond to the four qualities of coldness, dryness, warmth and moisture, and also to the four seasons. The proportions in which the bodily humours were present in each individual was determined by their overall health. A person determined to remain healthy – i.e. to balance – kept a healthy lifestyle with the right ratios of wakefulness and sleep, activity and rest.

### SINGULARITY

You will hardly be surprised to learn that Islamic physicians came up with the idea of the singularity of these proportions in the body of each individual. What provides one person with the balance they desire may not be the case for others. Age is a factor, as are surroundings, natural conditions and lifestyle.



### BALANCE OF THE FOUR ESSENCES OF THE BODY

Every physician of physical diseases (Ibn Sina) before the actual treatment, first proceeds to ascertain the ratio of the four essences of the human body:

- blood essence: hot and moist
- phlegm essence: cold and moist
- bile essence: hot and dry
- black bile essence: cold and dry

The balance between these essences could be restored, for example, by a suitable change of diet. This is why Arab physicians began the dialogues between warming and cooling foods.

### LIFESTYLE

An observation, reported by an Arab physician, was observed in Arab countries. Anatomical knowledge was based on the writings of ancient Greek scholars. Arab physicians therefore clearly preferred not to interfere with the human body. First and foremost they supported a change in lifestyle – dietary modification, exercise, relaxation, increased hygiene and less but not least music therapy. None of this helped, then drugs, blood, vein tapping, and only when even these practices proved ineffective did surgery come into play.

### SURGICAL PERFECTION

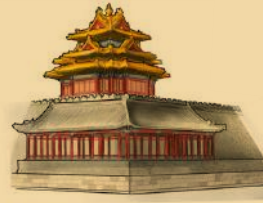
Although surgery wasn't a popular field of research even in the Islamic world before the 10th century most of its practitioners were surgeons. Islamic surgeons managed even complicated operations. In the 10th century, they operated successfully on cataracts of the eye, to say nothing of removing tumours. They used anaesthetics and complicated techniques for the stitching of wounds.

**Past and present:** Its blue flowers are like the eyes of blue-eyed girls waiting for their beloved to come home from war. Some don't stay the course, and they wither. 'The one who waits', such is the name of this flower in Slavonic languages. Perhaps for this reason, chicory is sometimes referred to as a sorrowful flower. It is also a symbol of eternal love. It thrives all over the world, except in colder regions.

Many legends and superstitions relate to chicory. Not everywhere was it an expression of sorrow. Indeed, in eastern lands of the ancient world it was considered a magical bearer of beauty. The Egyptians regarded it as a panacea. Our ancestors also believed that whoever should pluck it on Walpurgis Night would become invisible. On the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, a person desirous of love or friendship should touch the object of their desire with the flower.

Chicory of the aster (*Asteraceae*) family is prized for its medicinal properties as well as its beauty. Each part of it will benefit the human body. It is said to have antiparasitic effects. It supports the workings of the liver, gallbladder and metabolism, is a mild diuretic, and lowers blood sugar levels. It works against constipation and generally improves digestion. Powdered chicory root is used as a coffee substitute.
