It's okay to show **emotions**

AMFA is a Museum for everyone

Art is made from expression, so feel free to express yourself. AMFA is a place of belonging, especially for little ones who feel big emotions.



When **planning**, keep this in mind:



1. Remember, **admission is free**

While entering AMFA (and the Galleries) is free, some events do require paid tickets. Parking is always free.

2. Check **arkmfa.org** for the latest info

The Museum's website is always up to date regarding closures, events, and other key details.

3. **Pack your bags** accordingly

Please no outside food or drink. Capped water and formula bottles are allowed. Strollers are welcome, but no wagons please.

Guest Services Desks are located near both entrances and can help you with:

- Checking items (like big bags and umbrellas)
- Directions to navigate the Museum
- Sharing accessibility tools, like booster seats and sensory bags
- Purchasing event tickets, classes, memberships, and more

In the Galleries, remember **three things**:



1. **Look** and be mindful

Help protect the art! Stay two feet away and listen to any guidance from security team members. (They act in your best interest.)

2. **Stay together**

As you walk through the Museum, keep close to each other. It's more fun that way!

3. **Make memories**

Snap a photo (without flash, of course), talk about what you see, and enjoy! #myAMFA

Make art, too!

Drawing in the Galleries is **okay**

Only pencils are allowed, but don't worry! If you need one, pencils are available at Guest Services.

Create more in the **art school**

Classes for kids are available at AMFA's Windgate Art School. Visit classes.arkmfa.org to see the current schedule.
