Housing Application

Did you know?

All undergrad students will be assigned a mailbox and key whether you live on or off campus. You will receive your mailbox key once you arrive on campus, and will have the same box the entire time you're here! **Learn More**

Shortly after you have deposited and set up your PUNet ID and login, you can log into **eRezlife** to complete your housing application, indicate roommate preferences and submit your housing contract. **Click here for a step-by-step guide** for how students can apply for housing and create roommate groups.

Housing applications are **due by June 12, 2025**, though we recommend that you sign up as soon as you are able.

Application steps:

- 1. By June 12: Submit your housing application and contract via <u>eRezlife</u>
- 2. By June 20: If you want to match yourself with a roommate, set up your RoomeeZ profile and search for a roommate. Alternatively, if you already know another new student you'd like to live with, you can exchange emails and match with them directly.

Before a student submits their housing application, they will be required to agree to the terms and conditions of the **housing and dining contract**. After submitting the application, they will be sent a link to the contract via their Pacific email. Please read this agreement to understand the various terms and conditions of living in college-provided housing.

Sign, Shake & Ring: **A Pacific Tradition**

A tradition dating back to the late 1800s, Sign, Shake, and Ring marks the beginning and end of a student's journey at Pacific University.

Incoming undergraduates sign the Book of Enrollment (a symbol of their welcome, not a contract), shake hands with the university president, and ring the Old College Hall bell.

Before graduation, students return to "sign out," once again shaking hands with the president and ringing the bell—this time as they prepare to step into the next chapter. Families are encouraged to join, but if you can't make it, photos will be available after the ceremonies!
