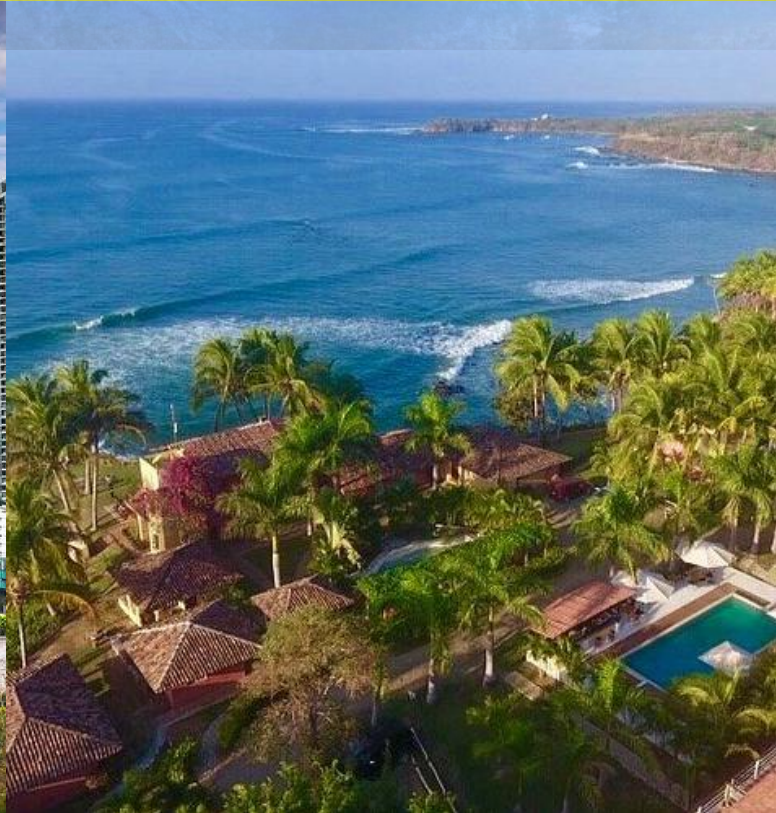

Learning sessions are balanced with outdoor activities such as surfing, beach exploration, cultural visits, and guided outdoor experiences, allowing students to reset, connect, and build confidence outside of traditional classrooms.

2 Hold your space in the program of your choice.

3 Complete the online application. Part of the application process is for you to reflect on yourself as an applicant. Complete a brief series of short answer essay questions and a self-evaluation, which help us get to know your motivation for going on a DreamSpear program. This also ensures that your interests are aligned with what the program offers. Finally, complete a medical questionnaire, which helps us prepare to accommodate for preexisting conditions, food allergies and other safety and health-related considerations.

CAMP Q&A | DreamSpear

What is DreamSpear ?

DreamSpear Azuero is a 21-day immersive educational camp focused on entrepreneurship, innovation, leadership, and real-world learning. Students learn through hands-on projects, community engagement, cultural immersion, and outdoor challenges – not traditional classroom lectures.

Who is this camp for?

This program is designed for students ages 18–25 who are curious and interested in learn about leadership, entrepreneurship, creativity, and meaningful experiences beyond traditional education.

Where is the camp located?

The camp is hosted in Pedasí, Azuero Peninsula, Panama, with the main base an oceanfront learning space that serves as the center for activities, classes, and student life.

How do students arrive?

Students arrive in Panama City, where the program begins. The following day, the group flies together to Pedasí, ensuring safe and supervised travel throughout the program.

What is the learning structure like?

Each day combines:

- experiential classes (mindset, innovation, leadership)
- community projects with local organizations
- outdoor challenges (surf, hike, kayak, etc.)
- cultural workshops (cooking, artisan labs, storytelling)
- individual project development
- Learning follows the DreamSpear framework: Mindset → Visualization → Process → Execution.

Do students work on a project?

Yes. Every student develops an individual entrepreneurship or innovation project from observation to final presentation, supported by group activities and daily mentorship.

What kinds of activities are included?

Students participate in:

- surf and water sports
- hiking and nature exploration
- community service with local NGOs
- cooking labs and cultural workshops
- leadership and trust challenges
- creative labs and reflection sessions

All activities are designed as learning experiences, not excursions.

What are accommodations like?

Students stay in shared bedrooms at Hotel Punta Franca to encourage community living. A limited number of private rooms with private bathrooms(6) are available for an additional fee.

What is the student-to-staff ratio?

The camp maintains a regular 10:1 student-to-staff ratio, ensuring close supervision, mentorship, and support at all times.

How many service hours are included?

Students complete 16+ hours of service learning, working alongside local organizations such as Wave Pedasí, Fundación Salamandra, and Pro Eco Azuero.

What is the food like?

Meals are fresh, balanced, and locally inspired.

Students also participate in cooking labs, where food becomes part of the learning experience – understanding culture, process, and self-sufficiency.

What is the climate like?

Azuero has a warm, tropical climate.

- Mostly sunny days
- Occasional rain showers
- Coastal humidity

Students receive a complete packing list to be fully prepared.

Is this program safe?

Yes.

- All activities are supervised by the DreamSpear team
- Safety protocols are in place at all times
- Adventure activities are led by trained local professionals

Students are supported throughout the entire experience.

Can the program change?

Yes.

While the program is carefully designed, some activities may adjust based on:

- Weather conditions
- Local logistics
- Learning opportunities

Every change is made to ensure an equal or improved experience.

What do students leave with?

Students leave with:

- A completed business project
- Strong leadership and communication skills
- Real-world experience, not just theory
- A deeper sense of independence and confidence
- Meaningful relationships and lifelong memories
- Entrepreneurship and Leadership DreamSpear Certificate
