

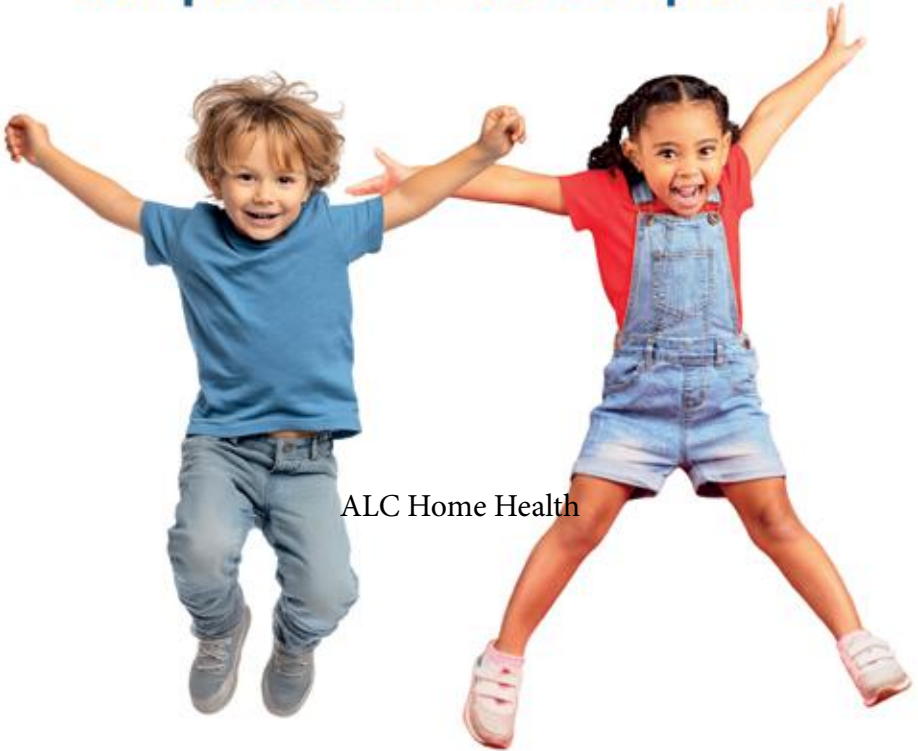

IMPACT Award



Ms. Carmen Pardiñas has dedicated 15 years to adult education within Miami-Dade County Public Schools. An alumna of Florida International University (FIU) where she earned her Master's Degree in Social Work, her deep understanding of systemic support and community resources has been instrumental in her career. Prior to her current role, she was a founding member of the Success Management Academy, an initiative that helped hundreds of young adults (ages 16–19) attain their GED in Spanish while providing a high school immersion experience. Her dedication during this time saw students graduate and achieve notable success, with some even attending the University of Florida and becoming professional network broadcasters.

In 2023, Ms. Pardiñas embraced a new, deeply meaningful chapter. Driven by a collaborative vision, she became the Project SOAR Coordinator at the Miami Beach Adult and Continuing Education Center, housed at Miami Beach Senior High School. Project SOAR is a pioneering pre-employment program for young adults (ages 21–26) with unique abilities. The goal, supported by the administration, was to create a classroom environment that provided real world experiences essential for students to gain workforce ready skills. For Ms. Pardiñas, this program is not just a job it is a calling. She immediately began building a robust network, leveraging her social work expertise to partner with organizations like Parent to Parent of Miami, UM CARD Center, Center for Independent Living, and the City of Hialeah Parks and Recreation Center, ensuring her students are given every opportunity to thrive. This comprehensive approach shows how she inspires, motivates, and promotes the potential of every young adult she serves.

Since the program's inception, Ms. Pardiñas has expanded Project SOAR's reach to create a truly inclusive network. She partnered with the City of Miami Beach Parks and Recreation to form a Special Olympics Team and collaborated with the Miami Dade Library and Visionary Artists to foster artistic expression among her students. This extensive Community involvement and relentless spirit of Advocacy demonstrates her role as a transformational leader. The success of the inaugural cohort speaks volumes about her commitment. Last year, Ms. Pardiñas successfully assisted six Project SOAR students in securing diverse post-program opportunities: two were accepted into the DeMoya Foundation (with one recently hired as a Teacher Assistant), one was interviewed and hired by Publix, two were accepted into college programs (FIU's Embrace Program and Miami Dade College), and the final student was accepted into Job Worx and is now working at TJ Maxx. This level of commitment fostering success in the classroom and securing opportunities in the community is the profound impact Ms. Carmen Pardiñas brings not only to her students but also to their families. Because of her dedication, these young adults with unique abilities are now part of an inclusive network, opening doors for others to follow. Ms. Carmen Pardiñas is truly making an IMPACT for all.
