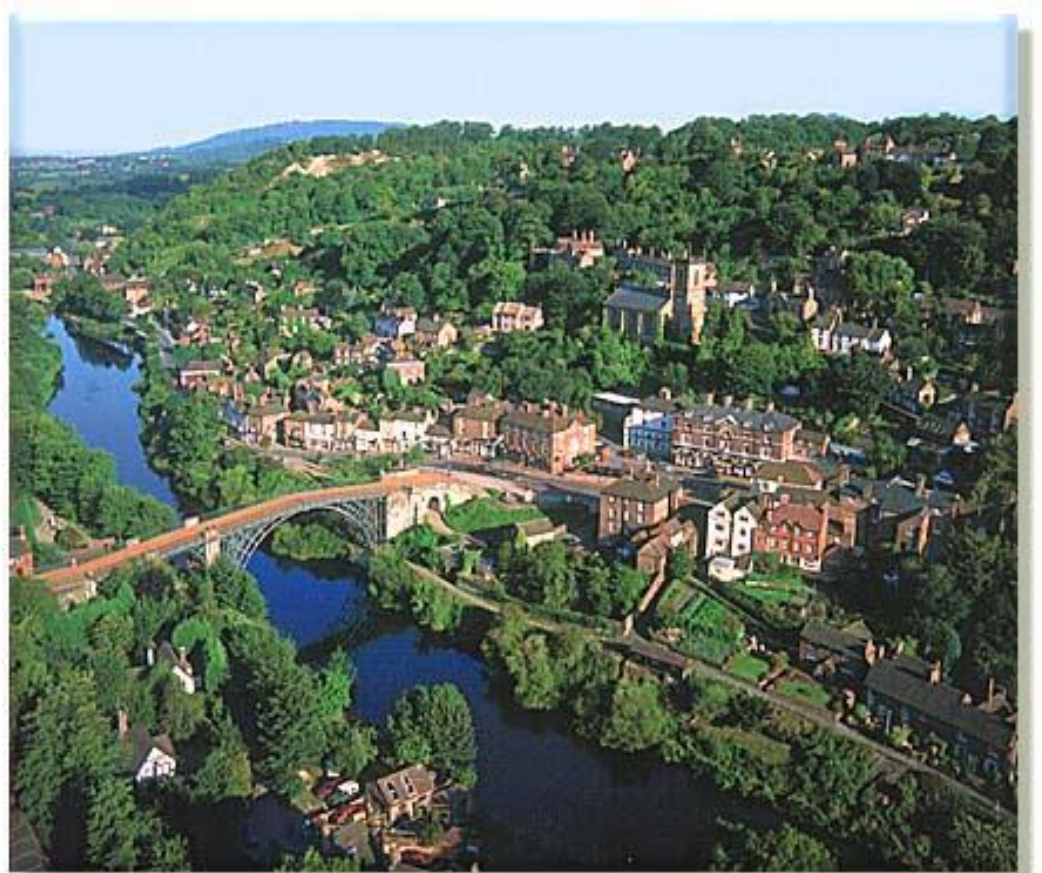

Small rucksack or backpack for use during the days	Case or large holdall for packing equipment
Lightweight waterproof jacket	Comfortable shoes / trainers
Sunhat	Wellington boots (named and pegged together)
Plastic drinks container	Socks
Disposable or cheap camera and film (optional, named)	Underwear

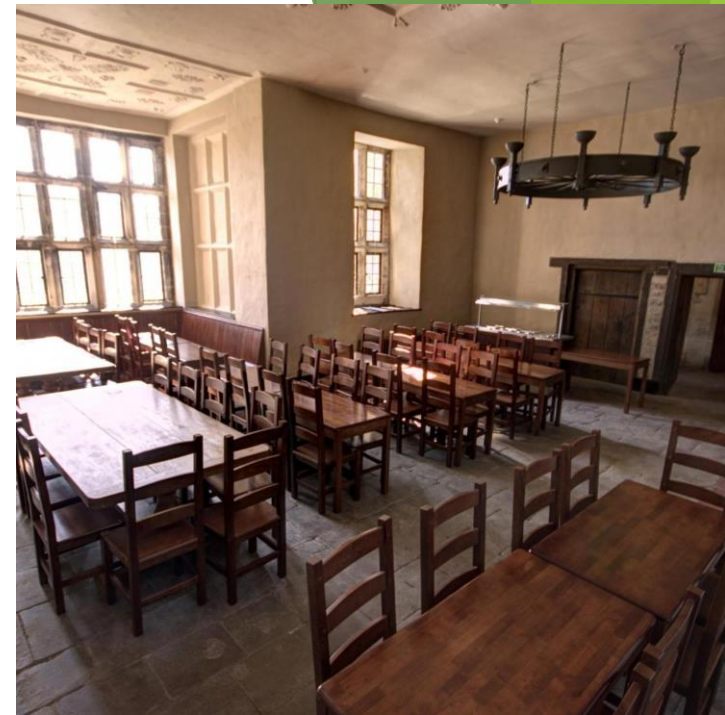

Make your first stop the Blists Hill Bank and change your decimal money for old-style pennies, half pennies, farthings and silver threepenny bits. Then use them to buy goods from the shops, food and drink from the pub, sweets from the Sweet Shop or candles from the Candle Factory.

The exchange rate is as follows:

1d	one farthing	10p
1/2d	one halfpenny	20p
1d	one penny	40p
3d	threepence	£1.20

You can exchange as much or as little money as you like. You can then pay for your purchases in Ironbridge.
