

Cultural Scholarship Terms & Conditions

Scholarship recipients must:

- 1. be accepted as a resident at The Women's College: enrolled and attending University as a full-time student or have applied to QTAC and expecting a positive outcome
- 2. consistently demonstrate a high level of commitment to their academic studies
- 3. provide The Women's College with their results at the end of each semester within two weeks of the release of results
- 4. contribute to The Women's College community in the Inter-College Competition (ICC) by supporting or participating in sport, cultural and community activities
- 5. attend College events
- 6. serve as a role model to other residents with exemplary behaviour
- 7. actively participate in any scheduled scholarship activities which may include presenting to the College Council, writing to College donors on how the scholarship has been used to support their College experience and/or engaging in any College fundraising promotional activity.

Termination of scholarship:

Failure to meet any of the terms and conditions as outlined above may result in termination of the scholarship at the discretion of the Head of College.
