# Message from the Chairman



India's next economic transformation will rise from its semi-urban and rural regions—Bharat. The entrepreneurs solving for Bharat's needs will be at the center of this transformation.

Deshpande Startups began as a small experiment a decade ago. Today, it has grown into a movement of over 500 startups that have collectively generated more than ₹1061 crore in revenue, created 115+ patented solutions, and raised ₹250+ crores in investments. These outcomes highlight the strength of a structured ecosystem focused on unlocking the opportunities of Bharat.

Last year, we concentrated on three priorities. First, we redefined mentorship by integrating alumni founders who had scaled their ventures. Their lived experience proved invaluable, with 24 mentors contributing over 600 hours of guidance. To ensure balance and diversity, women entrepreneurs were also added to the mentor pool.

Second, we advanced corporate engagement. Hitachi Construction Machinery established its Global R&D Centre on our campus, marking a milestone for industry–startup–ecosystem collaboration. Encouraged by this, more corporates are exploring strategic partnerships with our ecosystem.

Third, we expanded into North Telangana. With the generous support of ₹20 Crore from renowned Indian-American entrepreneur Kanwal Rekhi, we launched the Kanwal Rekhi Rural Entrepreneurship and Startup Centre (KREST) in Nizamabad, the heart of North Telangana. His belief in our mission for Bharat is deeply encouraging. KREST's inaugural hackathon and pitchathon at RGUKT Basar showcased the region's vibrant entrepreneurial energy, reaffirming the strength and scalability of our model across new geographies.

If the first decade was about sowing seeds, this past year has been about deepening roots. With Hubballi and Nizamabad as proving grounds, we are shaping a replicable model of entrepreneurship for Bharat—focused, purposeful, and future-ready. I invite all like-minded partners to join hands with us as we script this journey.
