

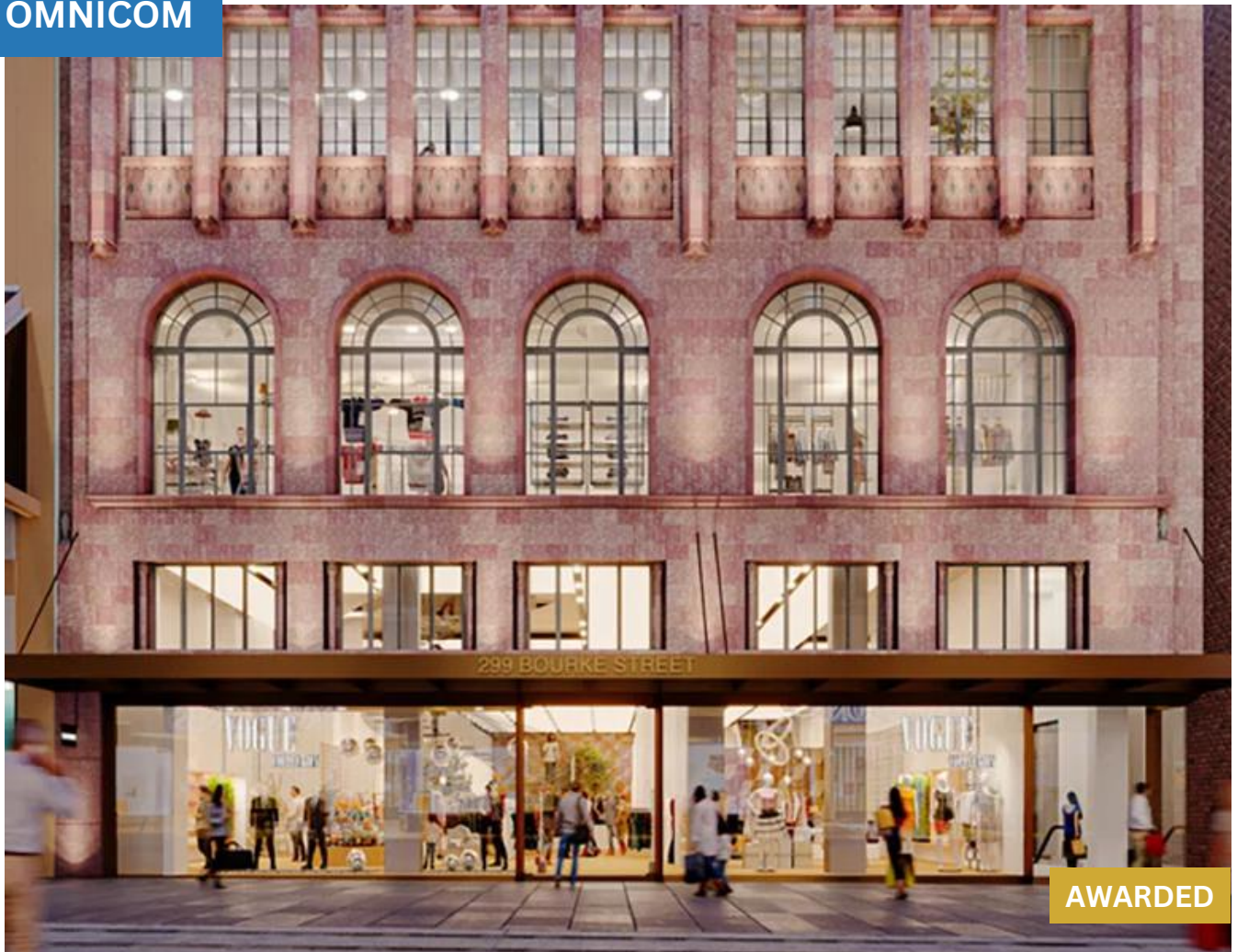

Highrise Mechanical Services has been awarded the tender for the new fit-out of levels 2 to 6 for Omnicom Media Group at 299 Bourke Street.

The 299 Bourke Street building, constructed in 1929, will undergo a transformation that retains its timeless appeal while meeting the demands of today's workplace needs. The office space will occupy over 800 staff under the Omnicom Media Group umbrella.

The scope of works will include demolishing and relocating base build ductwork, installing new ductwork, exhaust fans, and Mitsubishi FCU units, and relocating temperature and CO2 sensors across multiple levels. The scope also includes the installation of 19mm Armaflex insulation, new grilles, diffusers, and spigots, as well as fire sealing penetrations and electrical / control relocations.

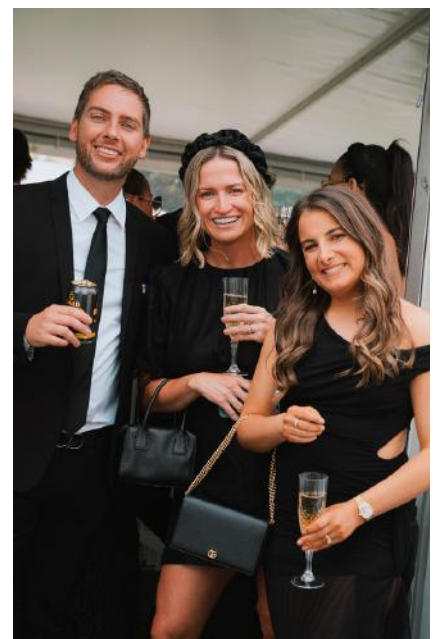
