Inside you will find information about this year's Central Illinois Senior Prom and the 2026 Bingo Bash. Along with all of our upcoming trips, activities and so much more!

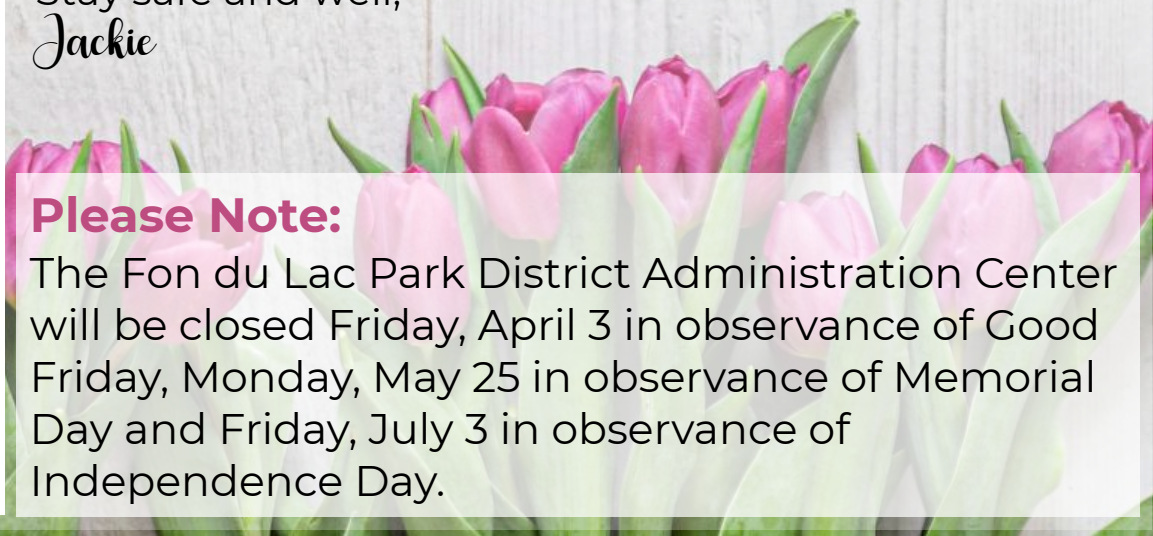

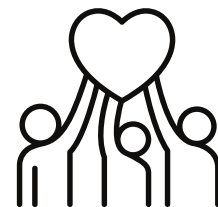
Come Join Our Weight Loss Group

Home Extension of East Peoria Home & Community Education



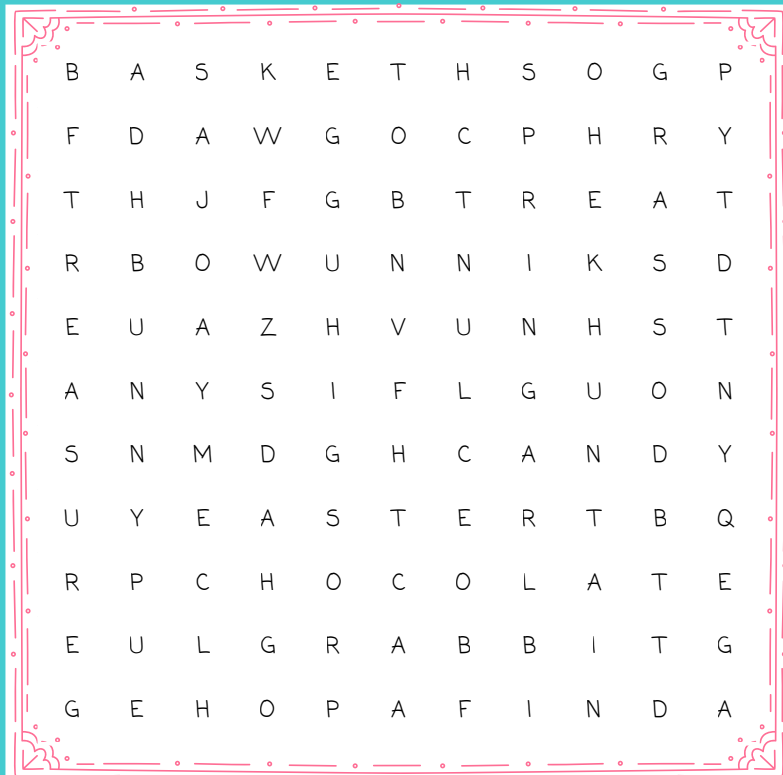
We have a gem of a group meeting right here and you are all invited to join in!

5. Be Patient and Enjoy the Hunt



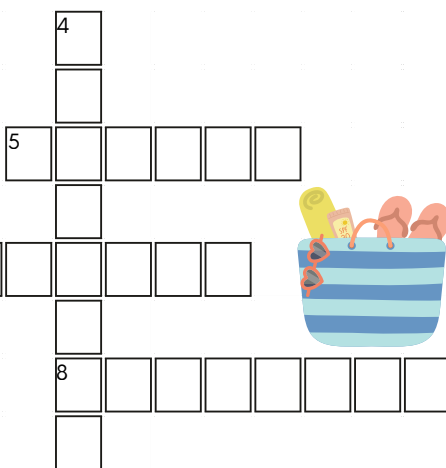
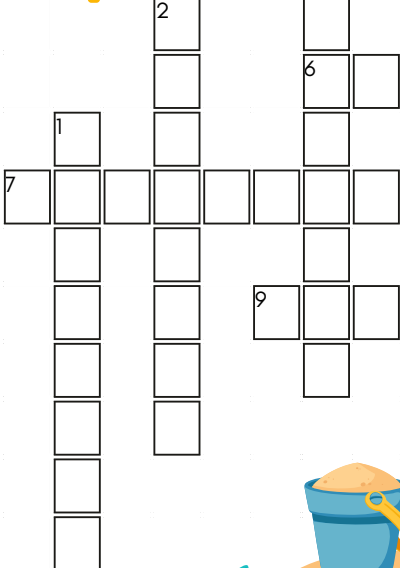
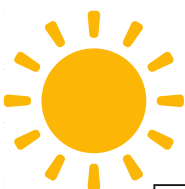
