

Each month, we shine a spotlight on a talented member of our music ministry. This month, we are introducing you to the talented Soprano, Carolyn White!

Carolyn began singing in church during grade school, influenced by her musical parents - her father, a trumpet player in the Detroit Police band, and her mother, a singer. At fifteen, she joined a "Teen Team" mission to the Dominican Republic, ministering through song and service. She excelled in school performances, winning her high school talent show. After moving to Ventura, California at seventeen, she performed in church productions and school plays, later attending a performing arts camp where she felt called to pursue voice and performance.

At Spring Arbor University in Michigan, Carolyn majored in voice, starring in "Carousel." She then attended Seattle Pacific University on a drama scholarship, performing in various productions and earning a BA in voice and theatre.

Her professional career included roles in films like "The Philadelphia Experiment" and television specials. She performed in musicals, toured with notable artists, and sang in various venues in Florida, including church productions and as a backup singer. A highlight was performing as Elizabeth Dole's singer during presidential campaigns.



In Orlando, she performed with "The Voices of Liberty" at Disney, appeared in various shows, and continued her film work. Though cast as Houdini's wife in a Broadway musical, the show unfortunately never opened.

In Los Angeles, God directed her path as a Vocal, Voice Over, and Dialect Coach for film, television, and Broadway. She coached contestants on "American Idol" and "The Voice," trained artists for shows like "High School Musical," Disney and Nickelodeon sitcoms, and films including "Tommy's Honor" and "The Rig." She also prepared actors for Broadway productions such as "Thoroughly Modern Millie" and "Tarzan." Her students described her as "a calm in the storm," and she quietly shared Jesus' message in one-on-one conversations.

After retiring to The Villages with her husband Tracy, they found their spiritual home at New Life Christian Church, reconnecting with their friend Lynn Bowman. Joining the choir brought them unexpected love and acceptance. Their new church community, Bible study, and pastors have enriched their spiritual journey.
