



See you at the starting line on September 28, 2025.






03 RACE DAY

in Parque Mediterráneo.


The 5K charity race will begin at 9:05.



Bibs


If you weren't able to pick up your race number on Saturday, you can do so on Sunday at the same location from 7:00 to 8:00.

HOW TO GET TO THE EXCHANGE ZONE

There will be a bus service for relay for those teams that wish to use official transportation, both to get to the exchange area and back to the finish line.

*The bus will return when the last runner has made the exchange.

02

WHAT TIME DOES THE BUS LEAVE?

It will depart at 8:15 from the Arco de Marbella (BP Gas Station) in the Departure Area.

03

WHAT TIME DO RELAY RUNNERS WHO DON'T USE THE BUS HAVE TO BE THERE?

They must arrive at the exchange area at least 15 minutes before the race leader arrives and identify themselves to the coordinator. At 9:00 a.m., RUNNER 2 and before 9:30 a.m., RUNNER 3.

WHERE IS THE EXCHANGE ZONE

The EXCHANGE AREA will be located at Km 7 First change and 14 the second change, both located on the beach of the ANCON. In the Puerto Maritimo of Marbella.








08 INFORMATION FOR SUPPORTERS

We ask athletes to inform their families and supporters of the following recommendations so they can enjoy the race, cheer you on, and help ensure the competition runs smoothly.

- 1. Those accompanying persons who wish to watch the start may do so without any problem, provided they respect the athletes' starting area and do not invade their exclusive space.
- 2. Afterwards, they can go to any point along the route, as long as they respect the "reduced" space of the maritime crossing reserved for runners to compete without interruptions.
- 3. The finish area will be in the Parque del Mediterráneo, and the organizers will provide a path for spectators.
- 4. At the finish line, there will be a dedicated area within the Mediterranean Park for athletes to recover, and another space where athletes and their companions can enjoy the festivities.
- 5. We recommend using the pedestrian walkways over the A7 to reach the finish line, or taking the route along the beach or designated areas before the race leader arrives.
