## How to Run for Office in the City of Concord in 2026

Running for office is an exciting opportunity to serve your community and make a meaningful impact. In 2026, the election will take place on Tuesday, November 3, and will include City Council seats for Districts 1, 3, and 5, as well as the City Treasurer position.

### Office Responsibilities Summary

Councilmembers set the policy and the direction for the City of Concord and approve staffing and budget allocations. The Council makes decisions as a team, and three Councilmembers must agree at a public meeting for direction to be provided to City staff. Each Councilmember is elected to a four-year term. The City Council meets on the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month. In addition to regularly scheduled Council meetings, Councilmembers will generally spend time reviewing material in preparation for the meetings; attend additional meetings as necessary, including Council Committee meetings; and may be required to travel. Councilmembers are compensated \$1,900 per month and receive some benefits.

The City Treasurer is an elected position that serves at-large, representing the whole city rather than a specific district, for a four-year term and does not serve the City on a full-time basis. The daily duties associated with the office of Treasurer are performed by a Senior Financial Analyst, a regular City employee within the City's Finance Department. The Treasurer serves primarily in an advisory capacity and provides oversight in managing the City's investments to meet the City's needs and reports quarterly to the City Council on the status of the City's investments.

The Treasurer is compensated \$600 per month and receives some benefits.

### Eligibility Requirements

To run for City Council, you must be a Concord resident and a registered voter in the district of the office you seek. To run for City Treasurer, you must be a Concord resident and a registered voter.

General voter requirements include being a U.S. citizen, at least 18 years old on Election Day, and not disqualified by law (e.g., serving a felony sentence or declared mentally incompetent). To register to vote, please visit [www.contracostacosta.gov](http://www.contracostacosta.gov).

### How to Officially Get on the Ballot

The candidate nomination period is Monday, July 13 to Friday, August 7, 2026, during which candidates can obtain a nomination packet (aka forms) from the City Clerk by scheduling an appointment at (925) 671-3390 or by emailing [cityclerk@cityofconcord.org](mailto:cityclerk@cityofconcord.org).



# Thank You, Concord: A Message from Retiring City Manager Valerie Barone

## Dear Concord Residents,

Joining the Concord organization in 2008, I knew I was fortunate to become part of the vibrant, engaged community that is Concord—a place with an incredible quality of life. Our city is enriched by the amazing lifestyle centers like The Veranda, The Willows, and the Sunvalley Shopping Center, world-class entertainment at the Toyota Pavilion at Concord, and cherished local events like Music & Market at Todos Santos Plaza. Our parks, trails, and public art, including the award-winning Creative Concord mural program, further enhance our community pride.

Serving you as City Manager for the past 14 years has been an honor and the highlight of my 38-year career in public service. I am deeply grateful to our residents, City Councilmembers past and present, City staff, nonprofit partners, and business leaders for the trust and collaboration that have shaped Concord's progress.

Throughout my career, I have believed that meaningful, lasting outcomes are achieved through collaboration. One powerful example is the A3 (Anyone, Anywhere, Anytime) Community Crisis Response program, developed by Contra Costa Health with behavioral health professionals, law enforcement, city and county leaders, and community members. This partnership, in which I am proud to have played a role, transformed how mental health crises are addressed in our City and County. By decreasing our Police Officers' involvement in involuntary mental health holds by 25%, we have ensured better outcomes for individuals in crisis and more efficient use of our resources.

Another community-driven process I am proud to have helped Council advance is Concord's first Homeless Strategic Plan. With this plan, and the Council's investment of over \$5 million in one-time funds in community organizations, we have helped several hundred individuals move from homelessness toward stability. Combined with City efforts and assistance from our regional partners, we have experienced a 43% decrease in the number of unsheltered individuals in Concord over the last two years (as identified through the County's annual point-in-time count).

Quality of life has always been a shared priority of the City Council, our residents, and our dedicated staff. Innovation has strengthened public safety and infrastructure, from Drones as First Responders to major roadway and signal improvements throughout the city.

Over the last few years, almost every major road in Concord has been repaved or improved, and these efforts are paying off: the City's pavement condition index has stabilized and steadily increased since 2023, reversing a decade of decline. With the recent creation of a Residential Roadway Maintenance Crew, neighborhood streets will also begin to see direct investment in the coming years. Another forward-looking project I helped the Council advance is the adoption of an Economic Strategic Plan. The Plan's goal is to attract new businesses and foster the growth of existing ones. Additionally, through discussions with the Navy and the Council's chosen master developer, Brookfield Properties, the City continues to advance the long-awaited redevelopment of the Concord Naval Weapons Station.

My tenure was not without challenges, which we faced together—from the Great Recession and a 20% reduction in City staff to the COVID-19 pandemic, budget constraints, and rising infrastructure costs. Yet Concord has remained resilient and forward-looking.

As I conclude my service, retiring this coming June, I remain confident in Concord's future as a welcoming, inclusive city where residents, businesses, and employees flourish, and where collaboration creates an environment for innovation and problem-solving. Thank you for the privilege of serving you. I know our Concord organization will continue delivering the reliable, responsive services you deserve.



## About Valerie

Valerie Barone has served Concord residents as Assistant City Manager and then City Manager since 2008. Ms. Barone began her career as a Community Development Specialist with the U.S. Peace Corps, serving in the Philippines. Over the years, she has held key roles in local jurisdictions, including Community Development Director for the City of Walnut Creek and Director of Planning, Recreation, and Neighborhood Services for the City of Milpitas. During her tenure, she guided Concord through the State's elimination of redevelopment, the Great Recession, and the COVID-19 pandemic, stabilizing the City's General Fund Operating Budget and restoring reserves to 30%. Her leadership also drove infrastructure upgrades and economic development. Valerie will retire in June 2026.

## Transitions of City Leadership – the Search for a New City Manager

The City Manager, appointed by the City Council, oversees daily operations and implements Council policies and goals. Valerie Barone, the longtime City Manager, will retire in June 2026. The search to find her successor is underway.

On December 16, 2025, the city entered into contract with Bob Murray & Associates to perform the recruitment. At the January 13, 2026 Council Meeting, the full City Council approved the City Manager candidate profile, which outlined the most important characteristics, attributes, and experience the Council seeks in the next City Manager.

Recruitment ran from late January to March 1, 2026, with Council interviews of the most qualified candidates planned for April and the new City Manager to be hired at a public City Council meeting in May.

# Newly Paved Roads Mean Smooth Rides

Over the past year, the City has made major investments in improving local roads and signal technology, thanks largely to City funds, grants, and state and local funding sources. These efforts are focused on making travel across town safer, smoother, and more reliable for everyone.

The Pavement Condition Index, or PCI, is a standardized 0–100 rating used to measure the surface condition and overall health of pavement, where higher scores indicate better condition. The City of Concord's PCI rating for 2025 has improved from 55 to 59. This overall rating is a weighted average based on the percentage of the roadway network by category (arterial, collector, and residential). Arterials are major roads; collectors are low- to moderate-capacity roads that serve to move traffic from local/residential streets to arterials, and residential roads primarily serve our homes.

One of the biggest areas we saw improvement was in our arteries/ major roads, which scored a high of 75 on a 100-point scale. Several major roadways received significant upgrades. Almost two miles of Willow Pass Road, from the Dana Estates neighborhood through downtown, was repaved and improved with more pedestrian safety measures, including a pedestrian traffic signal. One and a half miles of Bailey Road was repaved from Myrtle Drive to the city limits, improving a busy route to East Contra Costa County. Port Chicago Highway was resurfaced from Olivera Road to Clayton Road, as part of a larger paving project in the Holbrook Heights neighborhood. The second phase of the Treat Boulevard paving project was completed, covering the area from San Miguel Road to Clayton Road.

All of these projects included accessibility improvements, such as curb ramps and sidewalk upgrades that meet the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Some locations also received upgraded traffic signals and improved bike lanes.

## Sign Up for Capital Improvement Program Updates



Beyond paving, the City modernized traffic signals at intersections throughout Concord. Individual intersections were upgraded to state-of-the-art technology, including vehicle detection systems, new signal controllers, and new traffic cabinets (the roadside boxes that house the electronics that control traffic signals at an intersection). An example of these improvements is the Clayton Road fiber project, which installed over four and a half miles of new fiber optic infrastructure from Kirker Pass Road through the downtown, improving traffic operations and broadband capabilities for the City's future. Fiber enables better signal timing and the ability to adapt to real-world traffic conditions, making our signals more efficient.

Improvements weren't limited to major roads. Several residential neighborhoods—including Holbrook, Ridge Park, Ayers, Olive, and Limeridge—also saw paving and infrastructure upgrades. These improvements included resurfacing or repaving existing residential streets and, in some cases, enhancing pedestrian safety by installing new ADA curb ramps, crosswalk striping, and RRFBs (Rapid Rectangular Flashing Beacons) at critical crossing locations. RRFBs consist of two rectangular yellow signals, each with LED lights that flash rapidly to alert drivers when a pedestrian is crossing or waiting to cross.

## Update on the Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing Program

The City of Concord's Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing (AFFH) program complies with California's mandate to expand housing opportunities. Rooted in state housing law, AFFH requires cities to proactively plan for a range of housing types, particularly in higher-resourced areas that have strong access to jobs, schools, transit, and services, so that all residents can benefit from inclusive growth.

In Concord, the AFFH program is being implemented through an overlay zoning approach, allowing up to 60 dwelling units per acre on approximately 20 acres of land. Zoning is the method that local governments use to establish the rules for how land can be used and developed in a city. Rather than changing the base zoning of this land, the overlay provides an additional option that allows residential development consistent with the AFFH program on specific sites. This helps the City meet state housing requirements while encouraging housing in higher resource areas.

On March 10, 2026, the City Council adopted the ordinance that amends municipal code by applying the AFFH overlay zoning district to five sites: the former Kmart property, Clayton Faire (near Centre Concord), Palm Lake Apartments (780 Oak Grove Road), 5390 Myrtle Drive, and 1539 Kirker Pass Road. In total, the program will allow up to 1,000 new housing units to be dispersed among these five properties.

While the overlay zoning district allows additional development opportunities, it does not eliminate any of the currently allowed uses. Each property owner retains discretion related to future redevelopments and sites may remain as they are today. There is no requirement for property owners to make changes to their property.

These actions represent a key milestone in Concord's housing strategy, balancing flexibility for property owners with the City's commitment to expanding fair and equitable housing opportunities communitywide.

## Important information when visiting the pool...

- Lap Swim is for exercise only and is defined as continuous swimming back and forth in the lanes.
- All swimmers are required to self-check prior to arriving for their swim. If you do not feel well, exhibit flu like symptoms, fever of 100.4 degrees or higher, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, loss of taste or smell please don't come to the pool until symptoms have completely subsided.
- During Lap Swim times lanes may be utilized to accommodate city programming.
- Please choose a lane that meets your needs and your swim pace.
- Always announce your presence when entering a lane that is currently occupied.
- If you are sharing a lane with another swimmer you are required to circle swim. Please swim down the right side of the lane and back up to the right side of the lane.
- NO DIVING – Please enter the pools feet first.
- Lifeguards are on duty to recognize and respond to an emergency and provide care. They are not on deck to police lanes.
- Be kind and courteous to others.
- Please continue to bring your own personal lap swim equipment.
- Private instruction, coaching, organized events and workouts are not allowed without prior approval from Aquatic Staff.

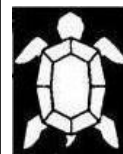

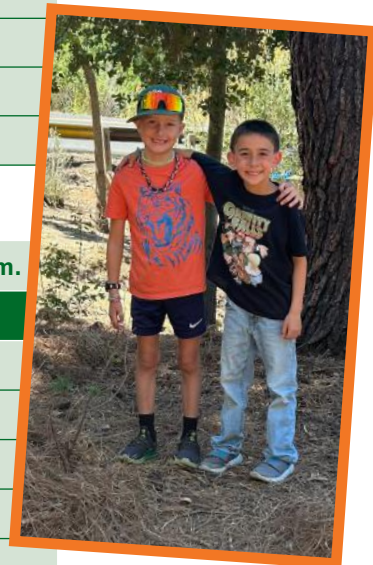

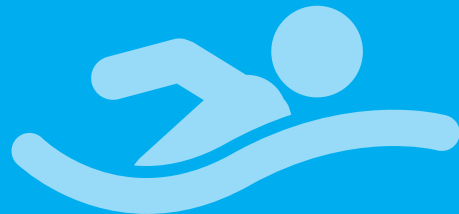

## How To Participate

## Participant Eligibility

Our travel programs are designed for specifically for adults 50 and better. However, passengers may register younger family members or friends to join them as guests, as long as they are accompanied at all times during the trip.

## Sold Out & Waitlist

If a trip is sold out, a waitlist will be formed. If there is a cancellation, registration staff will contact interested participants on a first-come, first serve basis.

## Trip Minimums

Travel programs may need to be canceled in advance if trip minimums are not met in advance. Help us spread the word about upcoming trips to avoid potential cancellations.

## Cancellations & Refunds

As a result of passenger minimums and prepaid deposits, refunds will not be permitted within 30 days of a trip without a replacement. Cancellations are subject to a \$5 withdrawal fee. Trips are rain or shine.

## Transportation

Roundtrip transportation from the Concord Senior Center will be provided on a commercial motor coach or in a passenger van. Refer to the trip flyer for details.

## Mobility Levels

It's important to note that each person's mobility can vary widely, and these ratings are intended to provide a general guideline for mobility levels of day trips.

### MOBILITY LEVELS FOR DAY TRIPS

#### Level 1: Accessible

Suitable for passengers who have limited mobility, use a wheelchair, or use a walker. Walkable destinations in this category include places that have flat terrain, easy-to-navigate or handicap accessible paths, and minimal obstacles.

#### Level 2: Moderate

Suitable for passengers who are mobile but may need occasional rest breaks. Walkable destinations in this category include places with some inclines or stairs but still offer easy-to-navigate paths and seating areas.

#### Level 3: Strenuous

Suitable for passengers who are active and enjoy a good workout. Walkable destinations in this category include places with steep inclines, uneven terrain, and longer periods of standing or walking.
