A Message from the Director

Dear Friends of CASA of Central Virginia,

As we reflect on 2024, one word stands out above all – “Connection”. This year, we have focused on deepening connections within our team, with our volunteers, and most importantly, with the children we serve. Through new initiatives, expanded training, and a strengthened sense of community, we have worked to ensure that every child who has experienced abuse or neglect has a powerful voice in court and a brighter future ahead.

One of the most exciting milestones of 2024 has been the expansion of our training program. Thanks to your support, we have grown from hosting two trainings per year for new CASA volunteers to implementing a year-round training model. To support this effort, we have added a new staff member to our team, which increases our capacity to train new volunteers and advocate for more children.

Volunteer recruitment and retention have also taken center stage this year. Through our 'I Am CASA' campaign - including billboards, radio ads, yard signs, and posters featuring our incredible advocates and supporters - we have generated increased interest in volunteering. Additionally, we launched a Self-Care Series to provide essential support and resources for our volunteers and staff, ensuring they have the tools to care for themselves while they care for others.

Our volunteers remain the heartbeat of CASA. This past fiscal year, 80 dedicated advocates served 210 children, with an impressive 77% of volunteer recommendations accepted by the court. Their work goes beyond advocacy; they change lives.

Internally, we have strengthened our team in meaningful ways. We welcomed four new staff and five new board members who bring fresh energy and expertise to our organization. Our focus has been, and will continue to be, on leadership, collaboration, teamwork, continuous learning, and of course, connection.

Of course, none of this would be possible without you—our supporters, donors, and community partners. Whether you have given your time, resources, or encouragement, your investment in CASA has strengthened our connections and made a lasting impact on the lives of vulnerable children in Central Virginia. As we look ahead to 2025, we remain steadfast in our mission, fueled by the passion and generosity of this incredible community.

Thank you for standing with us and believing in the power of advocacy. Together, we are making a difference and changing lives - one child at a time.

About **CASA of Central VA**

The nation's first CASA program was developed in Seattle, Washington in 1977 by Judge David Soukup. Judge Soukup realized that he needed help in determining what was in the best interest of the children whose cases he had before him in court. Since then, over 940 CASA programs have been established throughout the nation.

The late Judge Dale Harris helped CASA of Central Virginia get started in 1989. CASA of Central Virginia is now one of the top three programs in the state of Virginia, supporting more than 80 volunteers who advocate for 200-225 children each year.

Court Appointed Special Advocates, or CASA volunteers, are appointed by Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court Judges to cases of children who have been abused or neglected. They assist the Court by (1) thoroughly investigating the child's situation; (2) submitting to the Court a written report regarding the child's best interests; (3) monitoring the case to ensure that the child receives the services ordered by the court; (4) aiding the guardian ad litem (GAL); and (5) serving as a Mandated Reporter of child abuse/neglect. CASA volunteers are authorized by the Code of Virginia, Sections 9.1-153 to perform the five duties listed above.

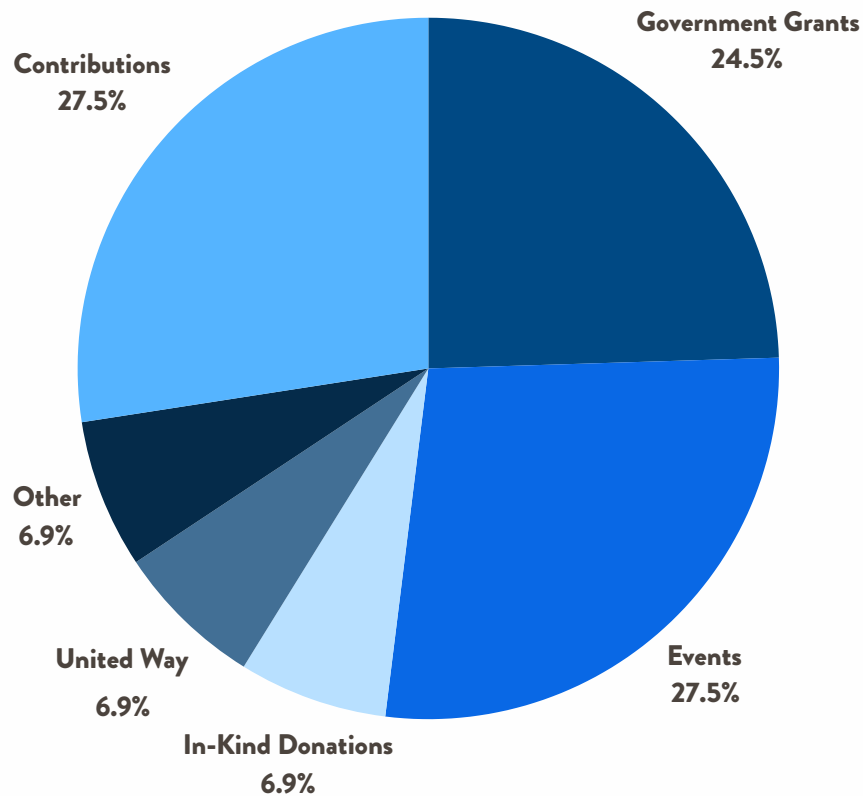

The Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services issues state and federal funding to CASA programs based on the number of children served by a volunteer in the prior fiscal year.



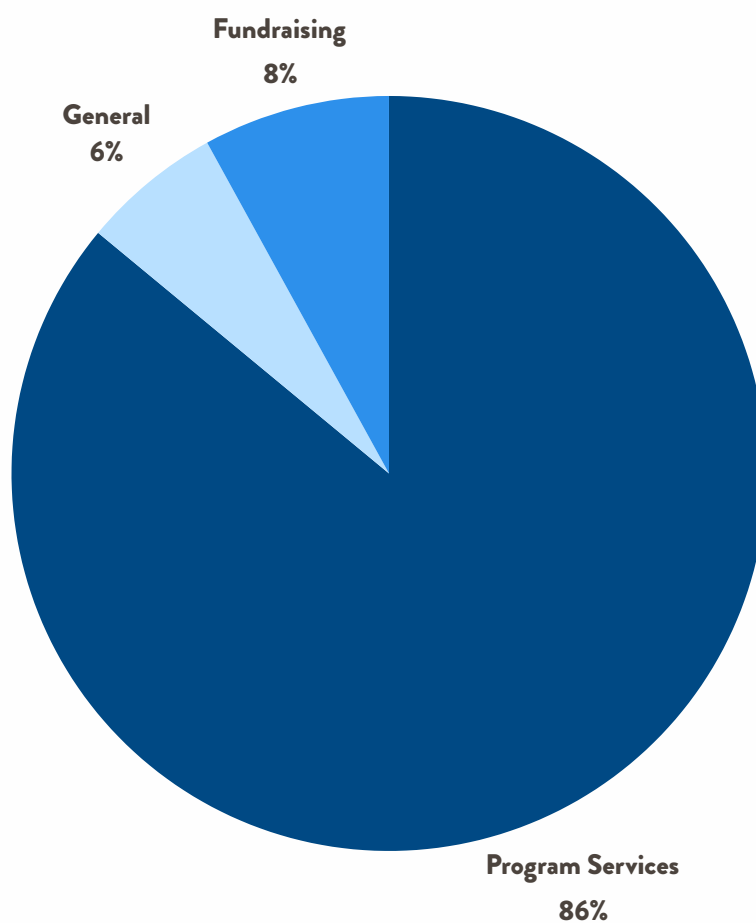
