IPSWICH WANDERERS CLUB HISTORY

- 1980 ▶ The Club started as an under 14's boys team in 1980. Two yrs later they entered the lowest division of the Ipswich Sunday League.
- 1987 ▶ Joined the newly formed Eastern Counties Division One sponsored by Jewsons in 1987 as founder members.
- 1994 ▶ Home games were played at our present ground at Humber Doucy Lane, under the name of Loadwell Ipswich. Jimmy Barker became a very influential chairman and he negotiated a name change to Lancaster Ipswich FC before we eventually became Ipswich Wanderers. Jimmy died in November 1994 and his presence is sadly missed. Thankfully after all his work he saw the floodlights switched on in September 1994 in a match against Ipswich Town.
- ▶ Great ground improvements were made in the early years under the direction of Development Officer Roger Woshalo and ground Manager Tim Davey.
- 1996-97 ▶ A losing Suffolk Senior Cup appearance in 1996/97 lead to the following season becoming Champions of Division One, under the Chairmanship of Alan Haste, nine points clear of Maldon Town and losing only three league matches all season. Reaping the rewards of a successful youth policy which saw numerous trophies filling the clubhouse cabinet, a well organised side with a good balance between youth and experience saw us establish ourselves as a Premier Division side for a number of seasons until we suffered relegation on the last day of the 2002/3 season at Wisbech.
- 2005-06 ▶ The following season saw Jason Dozzell join the Club as Manager and after a midtable finish in his first campaign, the second season saw the Club sweep to the 1st Division title and with the assistance of Kevin Cunningham and Glynn Hague, the team finished 7th in the Premier Division in 2005/6, with the League's second best defence with home crowds on average exceeding 100.
- 2006-07 ▶ At the end of the 2005/6 Jason Dozzell and Chairman David Bugg left. Local businessman Ed Nicholls became Chairman and John Clarkson was appointed Manager having arrived with a reputation from the West Country. During the season he guided the club to the final of the Rudgeons League Cup, the 5th round of the FA Vase and a Suffolk Premier Cup Semi Final against Ipswich Town.
- 2007-08 ▶ At the end of the campaign John left the Club and with an exodus of players, the Club appointed ex player Louis Newman to the role. Louis built a young, inexperienced squad and after a poor start to the campaign which included some record defeats, was replaced by another former player Steve Buckle who was brought in to rebuild the squad and hopefully retain the Clubs' premier status. Unfortunately Steve was unable to prevent relegation and the only positive from the season was the Reserves capture of the Chell Trophy defeating Wroxham.
- 2011-12 ▶ Despite Steve's best efforts over the following few seasons the Club failed to build a promotion push throughout the campaigns and after a poor start to the 2011/12 season, Steve and Assistant Paul Grainger parted company with the Club. New chairman Terry Fenwick appointed Glenn Read and he brought in his own players and former Stowmarket Town boss Steve Jay as his assistant. He quickly revamped the squad and had the Club climbing the table before the end of the season.
- 2012-13 ▶ The 2012/3 season saw the Club just fail to clinch promotion to the Premier Division and lose on penalties in the semi final in the First Division Cup. The season did finish on a high as the Club clinched its first ever Suffolk Senior Cup trophy defeating local rivals Whitton United in the final. It was a remarkable victory coming from a goal down in normal time and then from 3-0 down in the penalty shoot out.
- 2013-14 ▶ 2013/14 saw promotion achieved with two long unbeaten runs ensuring a return to the Premier Division, we also lost a tight Senior Cup final against Whitton United and set a new club record with a 12-1 win over Downham Town.
- 2014-15 ▶ The 2014/15 was mixed as we adapted to Premier Division and finished 9th and enjoyed a good run in the FA Vase but off field the club lost one of its driving forces Roger Woshalo mid-season.
- 2015-16 ▶ In 2015-16 we defeated Canvey Island in the FA Cup and enjoy our best ever FA Vase run but with a heavy fixture backlog, relegation fears were only ended just before the season end. Glenn stepped down at the end of the season and for 2016-17 the Club appointed Shane Wardley as Player/Manager.
- 2017-18 ▶ Shane's first season saw us almost emulate our highest ever position, however, after a poor start to the 2017-18 season Shane resigned and following a disastrous spell under Mark Benterman, club legend Mark Goldfinch took over the side ably assisted by James Buckle and Daniel Thrower. Unfortunately, relegation could not be avoided and in 2018-19 we consolidated and lost in the Senior Cup Semi Final to Cornard.
- 2019-20 ▶ In 2019-20 with Stephen Boyle taking over as Chairman, we rebuilt and after a sticky spell in October we were closing in on the promotion pack and reached a Semi Final of the Suffolk Senior Cup before the season came to an abrupt end. With further additions on field and some good improvements off field under Stephen's leadership, we then looked to gain the vital promotion required for us to take the next steps forward with a good squad. The start to the next season was positive and a second Senior Cup trophy was clinched in the delayed final with a single strike from Connor Field clinching the trophy.
- 2021-22 ▶ After a couple of Covid-19 disrupted and curtailed seasons, for the 2021/22 season Wanderers went into action in the Thurlow Nunn First Division South. With what became a tight run affair and particular rivalry with Buckhurst Hill also aiming for the title, it went almost to the wire, Wanderers finally having the upper hand, and lifting the trophy with a goal 10 seconds from time in the final home game. With the final of the Suffolk Senior Cup to follow, we finished the season with 26 straight wins, and a well deserved double of league and cup was won!
- 2022-23 ▶ The following season started with four cup fixtures in the opening 7 games, and a haul of just 3 points from the first 5 league games meant Wanderers were already playing catch up when our league campaign really got going. A run of 6 wins in an 8 game unbeaten run helped to move us up the table before another rare defeat. More wins followed until in January, we visited top of the table Thetford, which ended in a 1-2 defeat. After this, Wanderers embarked on another 17-game winning run to the end of the season, including coming from behind to avenge the result against Thetford, going above them and ultimately become Thurlow Nunn Premier winners - back to back champions - and into Step 4 football for the first time in the club's history.
- 2023-24 ▶ The 2023/24 season, the first for the club in the Isthmian League North came with added pressure - both on and off the pitch. A poor start to the season on the pitch brought a change in September, with the departure of Mark Goldfinch & James Buckle. Glen Driver came in as manager, with the task of keeping the club clear of relegation. Off the pitch was a mammoth job with a huge amount of work needed to pass the ground grading requirements to stay at this level. The inspection in April brought a great deal of relief, and along with the efforts of Glen and his team on the pitch, meant the aims for the season were achieved.
- 2024-25 ▶ Last season will go down as a disappointment but with green shoots of recovery at the end. We began the season under Glen Driver's management but unfortunately results were not positive and Glen stepped down before Christmas and we welcomed Michael Brothers into the helm, performances picked up but the damage had been done before his appointment. Michael and his management team are rebuilding well and we look forward to seeing how this develops this season as we look for a quick return to step 4.

TODAY'S VISITORS TO THE DOUCY

We welcome the players, management, officials and supporters of Haverhill Rovers.

CLUB HISTORY

Haverhill Rovers were founded in 1886, but their beginnings are shrouded in some mystery. The club first started playing at Hamlet Croft in 1913; previously they played at Seven Acres, an area bordered on two sides by the old railway line and Wrattling Road. They spent the 1908/09 season in the East Anglian League. Other clubs in that league at that time included Clacton Town and Halstead Town.

At the start of the 1924/25 season Rovers joined the Essex & Suffolk Border League but, after finishing bottom at the end of the 1927/28 season, elected to leave that league. Eight years later, in the 1935/36 season, Rovers rejoined the Border League. In 1946/47, Rovers were runners up behind Colchester Casuals; however, the following year Rovers won not only the championship but also the Knock Out Cup, beating Brightlingsea United 1-0 in the final.

In 1950/51 Rovers were runners up behind Stowmarket Town. In 1962/63 they won the league for the second time, retaining the title the following year, when they also won the Knock Out Cup again to record their second "double".

In 1964 Rovers joined the Eastern Counties League, finishing a creditable sixth in their first season and also winning the League Cup, defeating Stowmarket Town. The following year, Rovers again reached the final of the cup, but lost out to Lowestoft Town. Rovers finished in the bottom three every year from 1970 until 1977. In 1978, under the guidance of former player Roger Staples, Rovers were champions for the first and, so far, only time, pipping Great Yarmouth Town by one point. A crowd of 1,300, a record at the time, packed into Hamlet Croft to see the last game, the decider, against Chatteris Town. Unfortunately this proved to be a one off, as the following season saw them finish in the lower half of the table.

After this the club made steady progress: 7th in 1989, 14th in 1990 and an excellent 4th in 1991, the first full season under manager Martin Murray. A glut of injuries at the start of 1991/92 meant a final placing of eighth. In 1988 Rovers reached the final of the League Cup for the fourth time, losing to Braintree Town.

In national competitions Rovers have never reached the first round of the FA Cup, but reached the 6th Round (Quarter Finals) of the FA Vase in 1986/87, losing 3-1 at home to Warrington Town. The attendance on that day was 1,578, which broke the previous record attendance. The club has never won the Suffolk Premier Cup, losing in the final twice, in 1965/66 2-1 to Bury Town and in 1990/91 3-2 to Stowmarket Town. They have lifted the Cambridgeshire Invitation Cup three times. Rovers won the East Anglian Cup in 1990/91, beating Eynesbury Rovers 2-1 at Eynesbury in the final.

Season 1995/96 saw Rovers relegated for the first time in their long history, but this disappointment was sweetened by winning the Suffolk Senior Cup for the first time (at Portman Road) at the end of the 1996/97 season. They were also defeated finalists in the Jewson

League Cup, losing 2-0 at Harwich & Parkeston.

1997 saw Rovers win the Suffolk Senior Cup after they defeated Ipswich Wanderers 4-1 at Portman Road. They are also the only team to have lifted the First Division Knock Out Trophy three times (2-1 after extra time against Needham Market in 2001, 2-0 against Kirkley in 2004 and 3-1 against Saffron Walden Town in 2007).

An excellent run in the FA Cup three seasons ago for Rovers included their best result in the past few years when, in the Second Round Qualifying in front of 504 spectators, they defeated Eastbourne Borough 1-0 on 30th September.

Eastbourne were in the Conference South at the time, a huge four divisions above Rovers, but a goal by striker Paul Shaw three minutes into added time at the end of the game was enough to see them through and invoke a roar that was heard all around the town. This was then followed two rounds later with Aldershot Town, who were in the Conference, coming to the Croft in the FA Cup Fourth Qualifying Round. Although Rovers lost 4-0 on the day an amazing 1,730 people packed into the ground to become the biggest gate ever as the team's best FA Cup run to date ended at the final hurdle before the First Round Proper.

The jubilation of the cup run resurfaced at the end of the season when, on the last day, Rovers secured promotion back to the Premier Division after a ten year absence with a nail biting 3-2 win over March Town United that saw them finish second in the First Division.

Rovers' time at Hamlet Croft came to an end at the end of 2009/10 with the building of The New Croft, a fantastic brand new community stadium built to encompass the many teams at several levels that are now a part of the club. (The pitch is currently and professionally maintained with the assistance of Parkers Pitches and in 2020/21 had an irrigation system put in place.)

Their arrival at the new ground seemed to spur them on to greater heights, the team finishing an extremely credible 8th in the Ridgeons Premier League in the first season at their new home after being in the top four for the first two thirds of the season.

2012/13 season was tumultuous but, despite having three different first team managers in four separate spells, the team still finished 10th. Then, 2013/14 under new permanent first team manager Dean Greygoose, who brought a wealth of experience of this level and above, on and off the field, with him, had the Rovers in 2nd place at Christmas but with injuries to key players in the new year still finished 7th in his first year.

Unfortunately, Greygoose's time at Rovers came to end not long after that successful season. After a difficult start, he left the club in September to be replaced by local player Michael Shinn, a difficult season followed after Dean's departure and Rovers finished the season in 17th place.

Shinn left in January of 2016 with the club in 12th, to be replaced by Peter Betts and Dan Pilcher on a temporary basis. Despite the departure of several first team players, Rovers managed to remain in 12th place at the end of the season.

A familiar face came in for Rovers loyal fans after this, with former

player Ben Cowling taking over the reins at The New Croft with Rod Gaffan at his side. That season Rovers finished in 16th, never really finding a long run of form to guide them up the league.

Rover's inconsistent form continued into the 2017/18 season and eventually saw Cowling leave the club. He was replaced by long-time Rovers favourite, Marc Abbott, with the club languishing towards the bottom of the table. Marc and his players eventually finished comfortably outside of the relegation zone in 19th, one position above local rivals Haverhill Borough.

Rovers began the 2018/19 season in exciting fashion, with a cup run. Their first match vs the team next door, Haverhill Borough, was screened live on the BBC online. An exciting run followed, beating Maldon and Tiptree and then Long Melford after a thrilling replay. However, it was not to be as Rovers fell at home to Isthmian League Premier Division side, Leatherhead FC.

A solid season 2018/19 looked all set for Rovers, but this was rocked by the departure of Abbott in February of 2019 to manage at Step 3 St. Neots Town. Despite this, caretaker managers, ex-player and Saffron Walden Town boss Stuart Wardley and Dario Seminerio, managed to see Rovers finish respectably in 12th place in the league.

2019/20 began with ex Walsham-Le-Willows Assistant Manager Fergus O'Callaghan at the helm, after a very bright start to the season Rovers tailed off and Fergus only a few months into the season when the manager's position at his old club became available. He was replaced by the youthful James Bloomfield, but Rovers continued to struggle throughout the season before Bloomfield left by mutual consent.

The homecoming of Abbott after his year long stint at St Neots and Rovers fortunes soon turned around, losing only one game in nine before the season was brought to an abrupt end by the outbreak of Coronavirus when we were lying in 14th position. There wasn't much of a Season 2020/21 to talk off due to the Thurlow Nunn League curtailing the season due to the outbreak of Covid-19 and

its' restrictions. Marc would stay with the club until mid-October Season 2021/22. The home fixture against Wroxham would be his last.

Liam Aves would take the helm with first fixture in charge of our visitors from Ely City, bringing the club a much-needed point from an exciting 3-3 draw. It was a lengthy, hard-fought season for the team to avoid relegation, and it was only the penultimate home game to Melford where we won 2-1 sealed our survival in the Premier Division. The club was reluctant to accept Liam's resignation at beginning of August 2022.

Peter Bett's stepped in as a temporary measure, until the club was ready to announce the permanent appointment of Mark Benterman as Manager at the end of October 2022. New players have been introduced to the squad to help strengthen and improve results.
