WHEN AND WHERE?

- Monday 24 August – Wednesday 26 August, Stavanger city harbour
- Plug & Play set-up in pre-booked location
- Promotion of your debate in official ONS channels and listed as part of the ONS Programme

Anyone interested in putting energy on the agenda. NGOs, academia, think tanks, companies, etc.

CRITERIA:

- If you require more technical equipment, this should be ordered through our technical provider

- Location and time slot allocated on a first-come-first-serve basis
- Access to relevant panelists through ONS' network
- Sound system with microphones and sound technician (basic system)
- Debates are promoted as part of the official ONS programme

MOORING PERIOD:	Sun 23 Aug - Thur 27 Aug
PAYMENT & PRICE: All participating vessels pay a berthing fee per metre boat length for the whole period. Swimming platforms and bow sprits are to be included in the boat length. Disposal handling, water and electricity are included in the fee.	The payment is from 23 – 27 August 2026, which covers the whole ONS period. Prices for 2026 are: Booking before 15 May 2026: Kr 1500/ metre boat length Booking 15 May – 15 Aug 2026: Kr 1800/ metre boat length Cancellation fees: • Before 1 July – no fee • After 1 July – 50% of berthing fee • After 1 August – 100% of berthing fee must be paid
MOORING LOCATION: The harbour is divided into 5 zones. Allocated mooring zone will be sent out in May. Exact location will be sent out in August.	FYI: If you host debates or other open activities for the public you will be prioritized.
PROFILING Each vessel is allowed one banner of a maximum size of 1x 1.5m2 per boat.	Stavanger Harbour is an attractive area for companies to be profiled during events. It is essential that this profiling does not overshadow the aesthetic profile of the event.
HSE	ONS and the Port of Stavanger both have a strong focus on safety. In addition to the regular safety requirements of the port of Stavanger, there is to be a responsible person on board the vessel at all times with knowledge of how to move the vessel if necessary.
DELIVERIES TO THE VESSEL	Deliveries will be limited to certain times of the day. More information will be sent to the vessels ahead of the event.
MUSIC ON BOARD	It is not allowed to play loud music that disturbs your neighbors. One can play music on board as long as it does not disturb the entertainment of neighbouring boats and neighbouring pavilions on the quayside. It is not allowed to play music after 11.00 pm.
