



ONS+ DEBATES - THE CHECKLIST

ONS+ brings the energy discussions, social gatherings, and music downtown Stavanger during the week of ONS. We invite you to take lead on the discussions on energy in society.

The ONS+ networking arena is open every night during ONS. The debate programme is a mix of energy discussions, debates, and informal talks facilitated by ONS, NGOs and other organizations interested in setting the energy agenda.

WHEN AND WHERE?

- Monday 26 August – 28 August.
- Different locations around the Stavanger city harbour.

ONS can provide locations on a first-come-first-serve basis. Organizations can also provide their own location, but it should be in close proximity to the ONS+ area at Strandkaian.

WHO CAN HOST A DEBATE?

Anyone interested in putting energy on the agenda. NGOs, academia, think tanks, companies etc.

FOR WHO?

Anyone interested in energy's role in society. Both those attending ONS in the daytime as well as those that are not able to attend ONS but are eager to network and learn more about the energy issues in today's society.

WHAT'S IN IT FOR YOU?

- Set the agenda by creating your own event and make yourselves relevant in energy discussions
- An opportunity to invite your network and your opponent to start a dialogue on energy
- Easy access to plug & play event
- An easy way to be available and attract media attention
- An informal meeting place for your network

CRITERIAS:

- You plan the content and organize panelists
- You invite and share in your network
- Debate can be organized alone or together with partners
- Debates should not exceed 45 min in length (timeslots provided by ONS are 1,5h in total)
- You must cover the cost of NOK 13 000 for basic sound equipment
- If you require more technical equipment, this should be ordered through our technical provider
- Host must be an exhibiting company, an NGO/academia or in a formal collaboration with ONS

ONS WILL:

- Provide locations on a first-come-first-serve basis until the locations are fully booked
- Provide time-slots of 1,5hour per debate at the location
- Assist in providing relevant panelists
- Set up a basic sound system with microphones and sound technician
- Coordinate all debate activities
- Promote all debate contributions as part of the official ONS conference programme in all ONS channels and partner media
- Gather the industry, the politicians, the NGO's, relevant organisations, media and influencers, to fuel conversations that bring the players closer together
- Produce several own debates as part of the ONS+ debate programme

WANT TO MAKE IT SPECIAL? DOCK YOUR BOAT AND HOST A DEBATE

As part of ONS+ we invite boats to dock in the harbour.



Boats that host debate programme onboard, or other open activities for the public will be prioritized for spots in the inner harbour.

MOORING PERIOD:	Sun 25 Aug - Thur 29 Aug
PAYMENT & PRICE: All participating vessels pay a berthing fee per metre boat length for the whole period. Swimming platforms and bow sprits are to be included in the boat length. Disposal handling, water and electricity are included in the fee.	The payment is from 25 – 29 August 2024, which covers the whole ONS period. Prices for 2024 are: Booking before 15 May 2024: Kr 1200/ metre boat length Booking 15 May – 15 Aug 2024: Kr 1500/ metre boat length Cancellation fees: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Before 1 July – no fee • After 1 July – 50% of berthing fee • After 1 August – 100% of berthing fee must be paid
MOORING LOCATION: The harbour is divided into 5 zones. Allocated mooring zone will be sent out in May. Exact location will be sent out in August.	FYI: If you host debates or other open activities for the public you will be prioritized.
PROFILING Each vessel is allowed one banner of a maximum size of 1x 1.5m ² per boat.	Stavanger Harbour is an attractive area for companies to be profiled during events. It is essential that this profiling does not overshadow the aesthetic profile of the event.
HSE	ONS and the Port of Stavanger both have a strong focus on safety. In addition to the regular safety requirements of the port of Stavanger, there is to be a responsible person on board the vessel at all times with knowledge of how to move the vessel if necessary.
DELIVERIES TO THE VESSEL	Deliveries will be limited to certain times of the day. More information will be sent to the vessels ahead of the event.
MUSIC ON BOARD	It is not allowed to play loud music that disturbs your neighbors. One can play music on board as long as it does not disturb the entertainment of neighbouring boats and neighbouring pavilions on the quayside. It is not allowed to play music after 11.00 pm.
