TRAVEL TIPS

WHEN TO GO

Like anywhere in the Northern Hemisphere, the summer months (June, July and August) are the most popular, but also the most crowded. For this reason, the spring and autumn months are recommended, due to their mild climate and fewer people to contend with.

There's never a bad time to visit the USA West Coast, as you'll find sunny days year-round in California. The middle of summer (July to August) can get extremely hot in Las Vegas, but the casinos are all air-conditioned, and the Grand Canyon, despite being in the desert, gets snow each winter (January to March).

If you are planning to travel in winter, then head to Florida, which experiences the sunniest winter weather on the East Coast.

TIME

California, Nevada, Washington state and Oregon (Pacific Coast Time) are 20–21 hours behind New Zealand, depending on Daylight Saving Time, which is observed from mid-March to early-November. Arizona and Utah follow Mountain Standard Time (1 hour earlier), but do not observe Daylight Saving Time.

The Eastern and Southern states of the USA are 16–18 hours behind New Zealand, depending on Daylight Saving Time, which is observed from mid-March to the beginning of November each year.

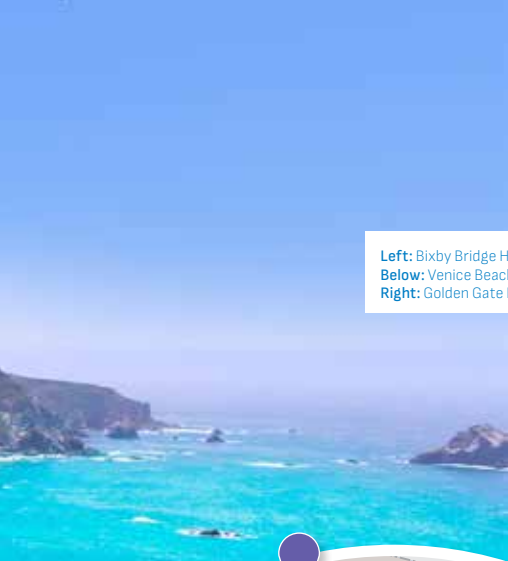
Fortress of Solitude – San Francisco

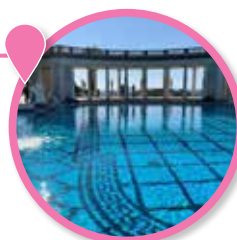


Visit Palm Springs

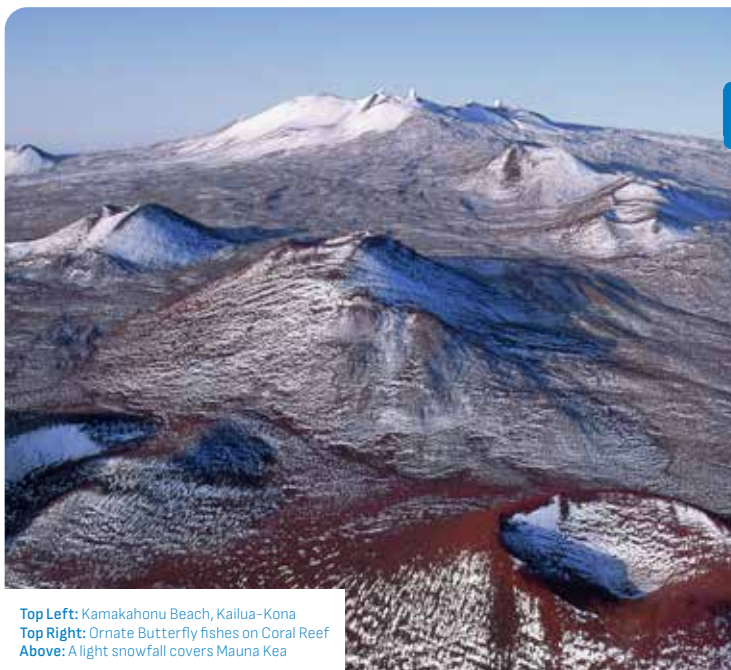

LIABILITY: To the extent permitted by law, neither FCNZ (Company No. 349518) Limited nor any of its related bodies corporate, directors, employees or agents, accept any liability in contract, tort, or otherwise for any injury, damage, loss (including consequential loss), delay, additional expense or inconvenience caused directly or indirectly by the acts, omissions or default, whether negligent or otherwise, of third-party providers over whom we have no direct control, force majeure or any other event which is beyond our control or which is not preventable by reasonable diligence on our part. Our liability will also be limited to the extent that any relevant international conventions, for example the Montreal Convention in respect of travel by air, the Athens Convention in respect of travel by sea, the Beme Convention in respect of travel by rail, and the Paris Convention in respect of the provision of accommodation, limit the amount of compensation which can be claimed for death, injury, or delay to passengers, and loss, damage and delay to luggage. Under circumstances where our liability cannot be excluded and where liability may be lawfully limited, such liability is limited to the remedies required of us under applicable law (including the Consumer Guarantees Act). This liability clause is subject to your rights under the Consumer Guarantees Act and nothing in these terms and conditions is intended to limit any rights you may have under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993.

SUPPLIER INSOLVENCY: Without limiting the preceding Liability section, for the avoidance of doubt, in the event of a third party provider being unable to provide you with the product or service you have booked due to that third party provider becoming insolvent or being placed under external administration, subject to your refund and remedy rights under the Consumer Guarantees Act, we have no obligation to reimburse you for the cost of your booking, or for any loss or damage you may otherwise suffer as a result of any such insolvency or external administration.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Travel documents include (without limitation) airline tickets, hotel vouchers, tour vouchers or any other document (whether in electronic form or otherwise) used to confirm an arrangement with a

service provider. Travel documents may be subject to certain conditions and/or restrictions, including (without limitation) being non-refundable, non-date-changeable and subject to cancellation and/or amendment fees. All travel documents are non-transferable. All airline tickets must be issued in the name of the passport/photo identity holder; some carriers will deny carriage if the name varies and the booking may be cancelled. Please review your travel documentation carefully and advise us immediately of any errors in names, dates or timings. It is your responsibility to collect all travel documents prior to travel.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: We strongly recommend that you take-out appropriate comprehensive travel insurance to cover your travel arrangements. Your insurance protection should include cover for cancellation; medical and repatriation expenses; personal injury and accident; death; loss of personal baggage and money; and personal liability insurance. Evidence of such insurances should be produced to Infinity Holidays on request. Travel insurance is strongly recommended by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade for all overseas travel. Your Travel Advisor can provide information to you about travel insurance.

PASSPORTS & VISAS: All travellers must have a valid passport for international travel and many countries require at least six months' validity from the date of return, and some countries require a machine-readable passport. It is important to ensure that you have valid passports, visas and re-entry permits which meet the requirements of immigration and other government authorities. Any fines, penalties, payments or expenditures incurred as a result of such documents not meeting the requirements of those authorities will be your sole responsibility (except to the extent caused by fault on our part). If you need information regarding visa and other travel document requirements for your trip, please ask your Travel Advisor.

TRAVEL ADVICE: Infinity Holidays makes no representations as to the safety, conditions or other issues that may exist at any destination. We recommend that you contact the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, or visit their website at www.safetravel.govt.nz for general travel advice, as well as specific advice (including safety alert levels) relating to the destination you wish to visit. You can also register your travel plans, so that you may be more easily contacted in an emergency.

HEALTH: You must ensure that you are aware of any health requirements and recommended precautions relevant to your travel, and ensure that you carry all necessary vaccination documentation. In some cases, failure to present required vaccination documentation (e.g. proof of Yellow Fever vaccination) may deny you entry into a country. We recommend that you consult with your local doctor, travel medical service or specialist vaccination clinic before commencing your travel. TAXES: Certain taxes are mandatory in various countries. There may also be an additional local tax charged at some airports. All taxes are subject to change without notice.

DEPOSITS & FINAL PAYMENTS: You will be required to pay a deposit or deposits when booking. Your Travel Advisor will advise you of how much that will be. All deposits are non-refundable for changes of mind or cancellations by you (subject to your rights under the Consumer Guarantees Act). Final payment is required no later than 15 days prior to departure, unless otherwise stated. Some airfares or services must be paid in full at the time of booking. If we have to change any part of your booking for reasons beyond our control; for example, if an airline changes its schedules, if a hotelier overbooks hotel accommodation, or if there are any changes in applicable taxes or charges, we will notify you. If any such changes result in your holiday costing more, or otherwise being materially different from that originally booked, then you may cancel the holiday and we will refund any monies already paid, less any charges levied by suppliers.

OUR CHANGE & CANCELLATION FEES: Subject to your refund and remedy rights under the Consumer Guarantees Act, the following fees apply if we change or cancel a booking at your request.

- International: after full payment, the cancellation fee on packages will be \$100 per person plus any supplier fees on the land portion of your booking and any airline cancellation fees on the air portion.
- Domestic: after full payment, the cancellation fee on packages will be \$100 per person plus any supplier fees on the land portion of your booking. Domestic airfares are non-refundable.

SUPPLIER CHANGE & CANCELLATION FEES: Cancelled bookings may also incur supplier fees, which can be up to 100% of the cost of the booking, regardless of whether travel has commenced. Supplier fees may also apply where a booking is changed and when tickets or documents are re-issued. Where we incur any liability for a supplier cancellation fee for any booking which you change or cancel, you agree to indemnify us for the amount of that fee. Where you seek a refund for a cancelled booking for which payment has been made to the supplier, we will not provide a refund to you until we receive the funds from that supplier.

AMENDMENTS: An amendment is a change to an existing booking with the same inclusions. Any supplier or airline amendment fees will be charged. A transfer to another package may be treated as a cancellation and operator cancellation fees may apply. If the new package is of greater value and no operator fees apply, there will be no amendment/reissue fee.

REFUNDS: Subject to your refund and remedy rights under the Consumer Guarantees Act, no refund is available for cancellations after the holiday package has commenced, nor in respect of any tours, accommodation, meals or any other services not utilised. Selected holiday packages consist of a combined airfare and land/tour component which cannot be sold and subsequently cancelled and/or refunded separately. Requests for refunds received more than six months after the departure date for travel will not be accepted.

By providing personal information to us, you agree that our Privacy Policy will apply to how we handle your personal information, and you consent to us collecting, using and disclosing your personal information, as detailed in our Privacy Policy. In particular, you agree that in certain circumstances (such as where you request us to book international travel for you), we are permitted to disclose your personal information to overseas recipients. Such recipients may include the overseas travel service providers (e.g. airlines, accommodation or tour providers) with whom you make a booking. These travel service providers will, in most cases, receive your personal information in the country in which they will provide the services to you, or in which their business is based. We may also disclose your personal information to our overseas-related entities, and to service providers who perform services for us within and outside of New Zealand. GOVERNING LAW: If any dispute arises between you and us, the laws of New Zealand will apply. You irrevocably and unconditionally submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of New Zealand, and waive any right that you may have to object to an action being brought in those courts.
