How it works

Funding is available on a rolling basis to all Sustainable CT-registered communities statewide. No deadlines, no long application, and no lengthy review period. To be eligible, projects must:



Be located in a Sustainable CT-registered town



Align with Sustainable CT's mission of creating equitable, sustainable communities

** Be publicly accessible and have a clear public benefit






