Damian takes well to his newfound responsibilities and starts taking ownership of his learning, as well as helping his classmates with theirs. ## Top 3 Frequently Asked Questions:

#### How safe are these events given the pandemic?

The organising committee has been working closely with the authorities on these events to ensure both a safe and meaningful Festival.

Security and safe management measures (SMM) have been planned, approved and would be implemented in conformance with the prevailing regulations. In some instances, we have gone beyond what is required by governmental requirements. There will be the usual entry and exit checks for safe entry, vaccination checks or PET, as well as crowd management to ensure appropriate safe distancing within the venues. There will also be deep cleaning and disinfecting of the premises before, during and after the Festival.

As the regulatory requirements change, we will update this FAQ and provide advisories as needed.

#### Do I have to be fully vaccinated?

To enter the venues, you must either:

- (1) have received your 2nd dose of MOH approved vaccines at least 14 days before the event (MOH approved vaccines are currently Pfizer-BioNTech/Comirnaty, Moderna and those on the WHO Emergency Use Listing which includes Sinovac), OR
- (2) be a child under 12 years of age and not require vaccination to attend, OR
- (3) have gone for pre-event testing (PET) at an <u>approved provider</u> within 24 hours of the event. Please note that there will not be PET testing on site. Read more on PET here.

#### If I am not vaccinated, is there any way that I can attend?

Yes, you can with Pre-Event Testing (PET). Please refer to the prevailing PET requirements at MOH's website.
