

At Faith Comes By Hearing, we believe there is no better time to take part in Vision 2033 fulfillment. Your sacrifice propelled the mission forward so that FY 2026 achievements quickened the spread of Scripture like never before. Together, we unchained the Word in new languages and formats at a remarkable rate.

Our staff diligently employed new tools such as artificial intelligence. Use of this advanced technology allows audible New Testaments to be ready for distribution in less time—just weeks instead of months after arriving in our studio for editing, audio processing, and finalization. This new pace provided the leverage to surpass an all-time total of 2,600 language communities served with Scripture recordings. Dozens of Oral Bible Translations launched, including some in new regions. We exceeded our distribution goals as Audio Bibles proclaimed the Word through Bible listening and watching groups in person and online. And speaking of watching, beside you and our partner, Bible Media Group, we adapted Gospel Films, The Covenant, and Acts of the Apostles in hundreds more languages as well.

As Vision 2033 progressed, Bible listeners experienced meaningful Scripture engagement. You made their testimonies possible.

OBT and the Render software launched their first projects in 2018. In July 2022, Faith Comes By Hearing crossed the historic milestone of 100 languages to receive God's Word through OBT. Today, nearly 600 languages have employed OBT and the Render software to translate Scripture. But this is only the start. The world has embraced OBT, and Faith Comes By Hearing commits to come alongside oral people in training, equipping, and facilitation.

Last year, we celebrated with the Senga community as they finished the first full New Testament completed in Render. Now we celebrate alongside three more communities who have orally translated New Testaments in their languages: Ludadiri, Nikaraj, and SAUJI.*

New doors continue to open for the global work. In past years, Nigeria was known as one of the top five countries with the highest needs for Bible translation. Through partnership in OBT, we met this need; 225 projects are active in Nigeria.

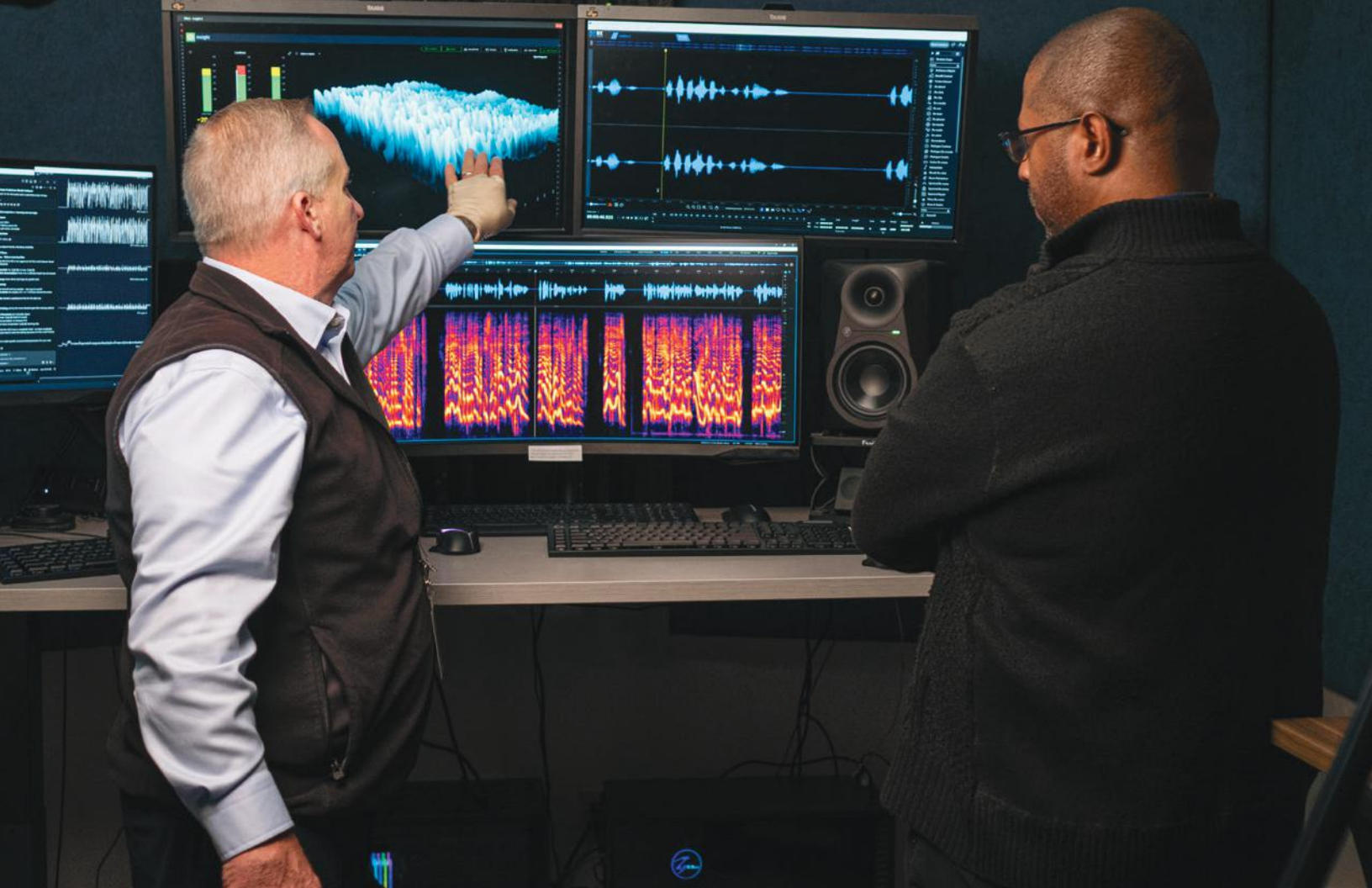
Now, our focus moves to two key countries: Indonesia and Brazil. Indonesia is home to more than 700 living indigenous languages. Many of these are oral communities, best served through OBT. In the coming months, we anticipate many projects will begin in the country. Recent meetings and partnerships in Brazil have solidified trust in OBT and Render as means for Bible translation in South America. This step now paves the way for projects in country and beyond.

With the worldwide rise in OBT project numbers, we work hard to establish and maintain partnerships with like-minded organizations and ministry friends. Our co-laborers come alongside us as we equip, train, and support language communities to translate God's Word. With Wycliffe, Seed Company, Biblica, The Word for the World, and others, we provide God's Word to more communities than we could ever reach alone.

RENDER AND AI USAGE





As Render hosts more OBT projects, we search for tools to aid our teams in their work. Accuracy in Scripture is always our highest priority. Many steps in a traditional Scripture recording now use a specialized software-assisted process. This technology is now being updated for use in OBT. With each Render update and new AI program, we aim to increase the speed, quality, and security of every project.

During the training workshop for each project, the team records a sample set—a portion of verses—to learn and practice the OBT method. Once completed, they send the set to our Albuquerque office, where our Audio Processors review the audio for clarity and consistency.

A new AI tool is in development for automated audio quality assessments. The field team can employ this tool to review audio quality issues in the field as they occur. Reduction in recording issues allows the Albuquerque team to review samples faster and projects begin work sooner.

For some, the use of their voice in Scripture makes them a target for persecution. In restricted regions where Christians face danger, recording participants risk their safety to complete these projects. Through voice protection technology, a voice can be changed so it does not sound like the original speaker. This protects the identity of the speakers while still providing a human voice behind the recording.

One substantial internal project is experimenting with an AI model trained to effectively assist in the internal drafting portion of an OBT project. The Senga project team—the first language to complete a full New Testament using Render—is testing this process for the book of Exodus.

Using their completed New Testament as a base, the model creates a first draft of each passage. These drafts are used to assist the team in their translation and recording work before being sent for peer review, community checking, and final consultant approval. If this project succeeds, it will be key in providing communities faster access to the full Bible in their language.



Every innovation brings us closer to Vision 2033. Within our Language Recording Department (LRD), each new tool and procedure improves the momentum, accuracy, and scalability of global Audio Bible production.

Vessel

Vessel, a custom suite of in-house applications, hosts the LRD process. Through this software, each step, while part of its own application, communicates with the others, creating an information-sharing ecosystem.

Each part of Vessel serves a unique team, from in-house scripting to our field recording teams. As the software sees greater use, specialized updates afford continued improvements to the user interface. AI-assisted audio quality checking, in-app error flagging, and smarter script preparation streamline team workflows. A more stable application results in fewer program restarts, improved accuracy, and more projects completed.



Virtual Recording

Created in 2012, Virtual Recording (VR) is a flexible, web-based method which facilitates Scripture recordings that cannot be accomplished through our traditional method. Participants record separately in their own locations and upload their audio files to a secure database for editing and mastering at the Faith Comes By Hearing office. After serving the ministry for 13 years, the old VR software required a major update, as its instability could not support the growing need.

On January 20, 2025, we released new VR software for global use. Updated login procedures now provide easier access for users with multiple roles within one project. Project participants can work simultaneously or asynchronously from anywhere they have internet access. Updated servers deliver a more secure storage space for all Virtual Recording audio files, and added software stability means this new program is set to serve communities for years to come.





The first Proclaimer was developed in 2004. Since then, Faith Comes By Hearing never stopped innovating. Spanning new digital initiatives to the introduction of the Acclaimer in 2018, better tools mean a greater reach and more opportunities for individuals to hear God speak their language.



Smaller Devices, Bigger Impacts

Continuing toward the last regions untouched by Scripture—remote islands and closed off communities—each trip and every device needs to make the maximum impact possible. When a field agent only has one backpack, they face a choice: bring six mid-sized Proclaimers or one large one. By focusing on smaller Audio Bibles, workers can bring more Proclaimers in one trip, increasing distribution and the number of individuals served.



The Audio Bible Ecosystem

With every new invention comes a greater opportunity for impact. With our manufacturer, Faith Comes By Hearing developed simultaneous playback across all our devices. Now, devices in an area can synchronize with one another, each one becoming a speaker that amplifies God's Word across larger group meetings. Many units also feature a printed QR code that, when scanned, connects the listener to a digital Audio Bible in their language. With all language QR codes, one tailored for every country, individuals can engage with God's Word on their phone, even after they leave their listening group.

AFRICA



Across Africa's diverse cultures, God's Word is heard and seen in new languages. Scripture reaches communities with little to no previous access via Gospel Films and Audio Bible resources, engaging listeners in the language and format they understand best.

Through your partnership, faithful local teams carry these resources into villages and towns, where people gather with curiosity and openness. As they encounter the Gospel, hearts are changing, and the presence of the Church is beginning to grow in places it has not been before.

The Word came alive in Ghana through a community-wide Gospel Film campaign. A local ministry team began their journey in Ghana's Upper West Region and completed their outreach trip in a community in Kong. Fifty people attended, including children. Kong and the surrounding communities follow the predominant local religion, with no known Christian presence or established church.

Despite this, the people showed great interest in the film because it was presented in their heart language. Many were deeply moved, and lives turned toward Christ through the viewing of the Gospel.

AMERICAS

From jungle-enveloped villages to growing cities, people across the Americas turn to God's Word for daily hope and healing. New technology-assisted processes help Scripture move more quickly from preparation to recording and distribution, making it possible to reach diverse language communities with greater clarity and care.

Local teams expand listening groups and place Audio Bibles where they are needed most thanks to your partnership. Day by day, Scripture becomes a steady source of peace, anchoring lives, families, and communities in Christ.



Fernando's first marriage ended after his Parkinson's diagnosis. During treatment, he met Alice, who also lives with the disease. Their shared struggle united them. The two began a life together, resolved to face every limitation with strength and hope.

In Asia's diverse and often hard-to-reach communities, access to God's Word expands through Oral Bible Translation (OBT)—an approach that allows Scripture to be translated and shared without the need for text. Local teams faithfully translate and test recordings within their communities. The Word of God is heard clearly, often for the very first time.

Your support opens doors where understanding was once a barrier. What begins with listening leads to lasting change, as more souls respond to the voice of Jesus in their language.

Gino gave his life to Christ while working on the Sumadel OBT project in the Philippines. When he shared this news with his father, Basilio, the man berated his son. Basilio's harsh treatment persisted in every conversation; he had no interest in Christianity because every resource was in a language he could not understand. When Gino invited him to take part in community checks, Basilio agreed, only because he could understand the recordings.

Hearing Jesus speak Sumadel shattered his resistance to the Gospel. After the community check, Basilio asked for copies of the audio files to continue listening. Gino praised God for the work He is accomplishing through this project.



ASIA



Throughout Eurasia, the Middle East, and North Africa, access to God's Word often requires tactful new approaches. Virtual Recording and carefully managed digital distribution afford Scripture engagement in ways that protect those involved while reaching communities with limited or restricted access.

You make it possible for local believers to participate safely, even at great personal risk. Though access may be limited, God's Word continues to advance—discreetly but powerfully—into the lives of those ready to hear.

Virtual Recording serves language communities in areas where traditional recordings are impossible. Recently, a recording team utilized the software to record the book of Luke for a language community in a secure Middle Eastern country. The language received the first written translation of Luke only a few months prior; however, low literacy rates necessitated an audio version. The participants traveled long distances and passed through heavily guarded checkpoints each week to record in safety. Due to the enormous risk, readers agreed to voice the project only if Faith Comes By Hearing could change their voices enough to hide their identities.

Today, the recording sections are complete and in studio. Our Audio Processing department and new machine-assisted technology ensure that voices are disguised and readers are protected as they bring Scripture to their people.

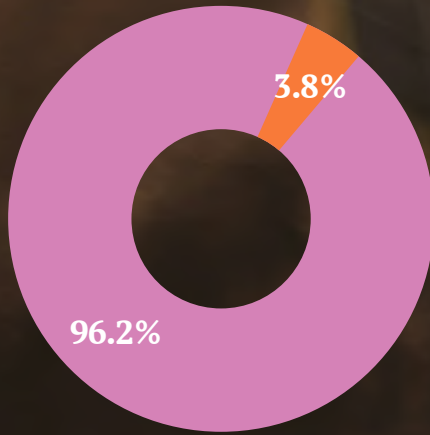
More than 50 church leaders gathered in Suva, Fiji, for a three-day training focused on a Scripture Immersion approach to Bible engagement. Participants experienced Mark 8 in three ways—they listened to the Proclaimer, read from printed Scripture, and watched the Gospel Film. This multi-modal technique yielded a deeper and more engaged awareness of God's Word.

During the week, additional outreach included a Gospel Film presentation and a listening group at a local church, where many young people responded to the Good News. After the training, local pastors committed to launch new Bible study groups using this approach in their communities.

Many shared that this method was transformative, strengthening both personal faith and practical ministry. Leaders expressed new confidence in Audio Scripture integration into their sermons and assemblies, especially within Fiji's storytelling "Talanoa" culture.

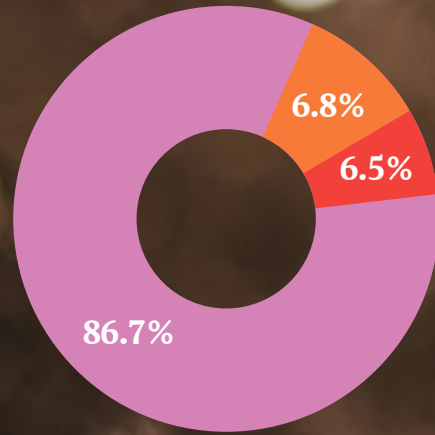

Scripture Recordings

- Expand Virtual Recording initiatives to allow language communities in restricted or hard-to-reach regions to record Scripture where traditional field recording is not possible.
- Support momentum in South Asia, where emerging partnerships and strengthened national teams create opportunities for multiple language communities to launch new projects.



Oral Bible Translation

- Increase the speed, quality, and security of OBТ projects through AI-assisted technology in the field.
- Strategize around the start of 200 new OBТ projects, a large number of which will target Indonesia, an area of great need for Bible translation.
- Launch the First Scripture Project in 240 OBТ languages, bringing Bible engagement to new oral communities.



Programs

- Employ enhanced Proclaimer devices that connect with each other to serve both large and small groups in a community simultaneously.



Gospel Films

- See adaptations of Gospel Films accelerated by Scripture translated through OBТ.



Partnership

- Expand reach and provision within more than 100 Bible-impoveryshed countries this year through partnership.
