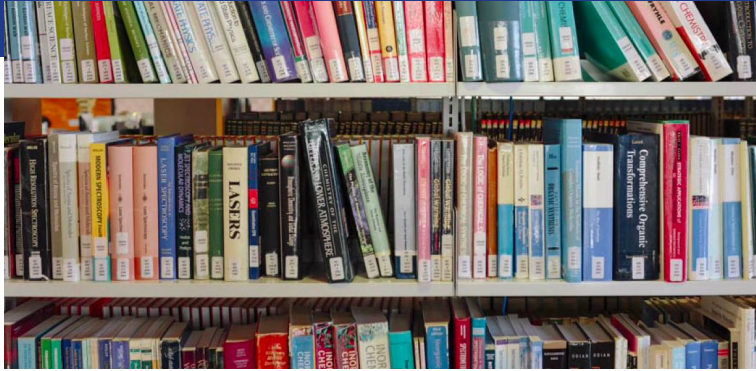

Extra-curricular

'Extra-curricular' describes any activities, clubs or groups that students undertake outside of their school learning or classroom studies. They are unrelated to their chosen area of study

Super-curricular

'Super-curricular' refers specifically to activities that students do outside the classroom that take them beyond their school learning. They are related to their chosen academic or career path





Why super-curricular?

- Universities are still interested in extracurricular activities as these provide the evidence for those all important ‘soft skills’ e.g. teamwork and communication
- However, you also need to demonstrate engagement in super-curricular activities to show your passion for the subject and going above and beyond the taught syllabus

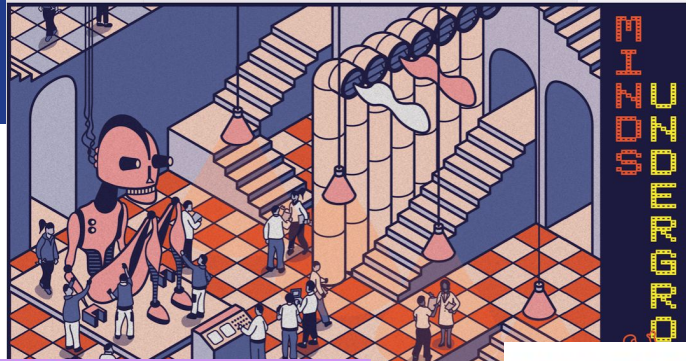

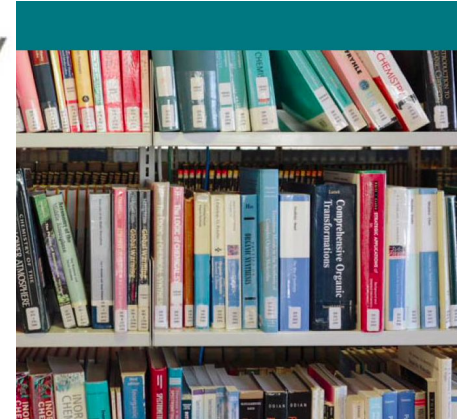

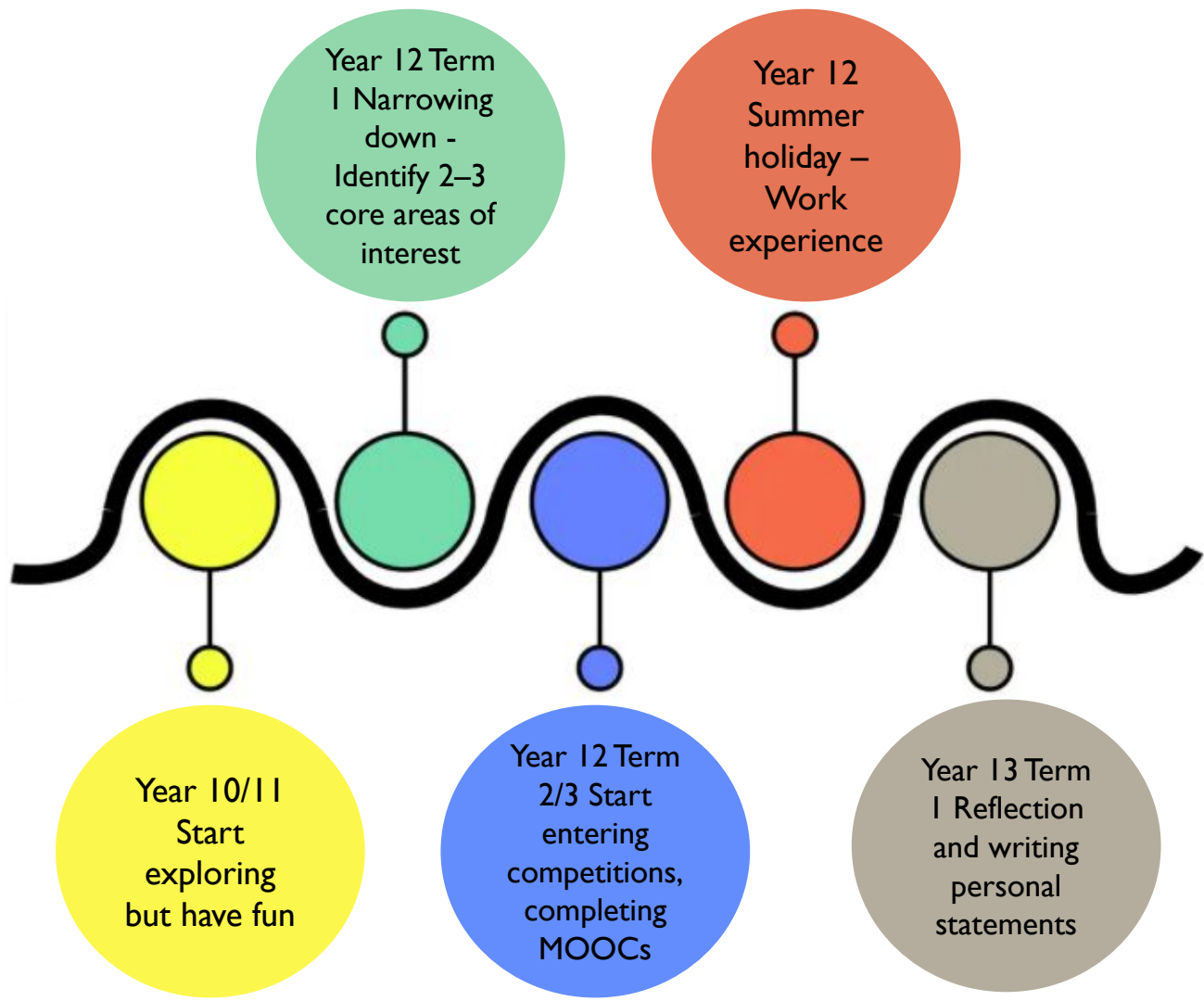
