

## Resurrection 2025 turned the campus into a celebration of creativity and spirit



## A World Championship Moment for India


Another historic sporting milestone for our MBA student, Anish Bhanwala, who etched his name into global shooting history at the ISSF World Championships.




## Where Focus Wins not 1 but 5 Medals

## QS Higher Ed Summit Asia Pacific 2025 marked Manav Rachna's step toward purposeful global collaboration.




## Leadership that Inspires. Education that Endures


## Where Teaching Inspires Research and Innovation Grows

## Exploring Edible Coating Technologies to Reduce Postharvest Losses and Improve Food Safety

Dr. Pandey's study shows how sodium alginate-based edible coatings can control the release of bioactive compounds, retain nutrients and antioxidants, integrate natural antimicrobials, and reduce postharvest losses while maintaining taste and safety. This research offers a practical, science-driven approach to tackling food waste and enhancing nutrition.

## Protein Characterization and Amino Acid Profiles of Various Wheat Varieties and their Effect on Pasting Properties of Starch

Dr. Rakhra's study reviews over a decade of evidence on the low-FODMAP diet for managing Irritable Bowel Syndrome. The findings show significant improvements in bloating and stool frequency, highlighting diet as a key therapeutic tool. The research emphasizes the need for culturally tailored dietary strategies across Asia and reinforces MRIIRS's strength in translational nutrition research.
