### DAY 1 - Monday | 29th September 2025 MALTA - SARRIA

- 04:00hrs Meeting at MIA departures hall

The Camino Francés walk from Sarria to Santiago de Compostela covers the final and most traveled 115 kilometers of the Camino de Santiago. Starting in Sarria, pilgrims pass through idyllic Galician countryside, quaint hamlets, and eucalyptus forests. Key stops include Portomarín, with its historic church of San Nicolás, Palas de Rei, and the charming town of Arzúa, known for its cheese. The route is well-marked, offering a mix of peaceful rural paths and small village hospitality. The journey concludes at the magnificent Cathedral of Santiago, where pilgrims celebrate completing this spiritually enriching and culturally immersive adventure.

## DAY 2 - Tuesday | 30th September 2025 SARRIA - PORTOMARIN

- 08:00hrs Start trekking 22km to Portomarin
- 16:00hrs Check-in at accommodation

The Camino walk from Sarria to Portomarín is one of the most popular stages of the Camino de Santiago, spanning approximately 22 kilometers.

Starting in the charming town of Sarria, this route takes pilgrims through lush Galician countryside, picturesque villages, and ancient chestnut groves. Key highlights include crossing the iconic medieval bridge of Ponte da Áspera and enjoying scenic rural landscapes.

The journey culminates in Portomarín, a historic village known for its relocated Igrexa de San Nicolás, a fortified church moved stone-by-stone to higher ground due to river flooding. This stage offers a serene and culturally rich experience for both seasoned pilgrims and newcomers.









### DAY 3 - Wednesday | 1st October 2025 PORTOMARIN - PALAS DE REI

- 08:00hrs Start trekking 25km to Palas de Rei
- 16:45hrs Check-in at accommodation

The Camino walk from Portomarín to Palas de Rei is a scenic 25-kilometer stretch of the Camino Francés. Leaving Portomarín, the trail ascends gently through rolling hills, peaceful forests, and lush Galician farmlands. Pilgrims pass small villages and landmarks such as Gonzar and Castromaior, where they can explore ancient ruins and traditional stone churches.

This stage offers tranquil countryside views, rustic charm, and a satisfying day's journey toward the vibrant town of Palas de Rei, known for its historical significance and welcoming pilgrim atmosphere.









#### DAY 4 - Thursday | 2nd October 2025 PALAS DE REI - ARZUA

- 08:00hrs Start trekking 29km to Arzua
- 17:30hrs Check-in at accommodation

The Camino walk from Palas de Rei to Arzúa is a beautiful and varied 29-kilometer stage of the Camino Francés. Pilgrims traverse charming villages, serene woodlands, and ancient Roman roads. Highlights include crossing the iconic medieval bridge of Furelos near Melide, a town famous for its delicious pulpo a la gallega (octopus).

The route winds through scenic countryside and small hamlets, offering a peaceful journey before arriving in Arzúa, known for its traditional Arzúa-Ulloa cheese and welcoming pilgrim atmosphere.

This stage combines cultural experiences with natural beauty, making it a memorable part of the Camino.









## DAY 5 - Friday | 3rd October 2025 ARZUA - PEDROUZO

- 08:00hrs Start trekking 19km to Pedrouzo
- 16:15hrs Check-in at accommodation


The Camino walk from Arzúa to Pedrouzo is a pleasant and relatively easy 19-kilometer stage through the heart of Galicia's lush countryside.

The Camino walk from Pedrouzo to Santiago de Compostela is an exhilarating final stage of the Camino Francés, covering approximately 20 kilometers.

The path leads pilgrims through serene eucalyptus groves and quiet rural landscapes before ascending to the summit of Monte do Gozo, where the first glimpse of the iconic spires of Santiago's cathedral awaits.
