

Two new funding opportunities are now available through the Muskoka Affordable Housing Initiatives Program (MAHIP) to help create more affordable housing in our community!

The funding opportunities are as follows:

1. MAHIP Capital Incentive Program: Multi-Residential Rental Units

Builders and developers can receive up to \$100,000 per unit to create affordable rental housing through new construction or by converting existing buildings—such as schools, churches, or retail spaces—into multi-unit housing.

2. MAHIP Capital Incentive Program: Additional Residential Units (ARUs)

Homeowners and property owners can receive up to \$50,000 per unit to create ARUs (also known as secondary suites), such as basement apartments or garden suites, offering flexible housing options and potential rental income. A step-by-step guide to building ARUs and a list of frequently asked questions are available on the District website to help get you started.

Preparing for U.S. tariffs can be challenging for small and medium-sized businesses in **Dutarith**, the right strategies, you can mitigate the impact. Here are ten steps you can take:

Understand Tariff **Implications**

Review

Contracts

Familiarize yourself with how tariffs work and their potential impact on your business.

Pricing and

Evaluate your contracts and communications with vendors and customers to understand your rights and obligations under any tariff conditions.

Optimize Inventory Management Implement strategies and scenario planning to manage inventory more efficiently, minimizing the need for goods subject to tariffs.

Investigate if your products qualify for any tariff exclusions or reductions.

2025 Muskoka Community Grant Program - Now Open and Accepting Applications

The Community Grant Program funds local projects that strengthen the community and support Muskoka's most vulnerable residents.

Two grant opportunities are available in 2025:

Pay It Forward - Up to \$2,500 for community members or grassroots groups that support projects that bring people together, fill a community need and create positive change.

Community Enhancement Fund - Up to \$10,000 for non-profit community organizations and registered charities to fund projects that address poverty reduction, food security, housing, education and other community support programs.
