


Business masterclasses

Key Professions Programme

For students wishing to pursue a degree in a competitive field such as law, finance, medicine, Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Maths (STEAM), or apply to Oxbridge we offer additional tailored support:

Local Lectures - we encourage students to attend lectures at London's universities and other institutions.

Work Experience and volunteering is beneficial to candidates for any degree course as it demonstrates the student's willingness and ability to contribute beyond the school.

University exam preparation– we offer support with specialist classes for UKCAT, LNAT and Oxbridge admissions exams.

Practice Interviews including the multi-mini interview (MMI) format used for medical interviews, to prepare for university selection processes.

Links with external organisations - we have strong links with a range of successful London businesses, allowing students to learn outside the classroom and connect with industry professionals.





University Foundation Programme

Designed specifically for high achieving international students, the University Foundation Programme (UFP) acts as a bridge from students' high school education in their own country to university in the UK.

At Guildhouse School we offer UFP starting in September.

We have a progression agreement with over 40 UK universities

95%

of Russell Group universities which accept our University Foundation Programme have accepted our students.

Overview

The UFP recognises the specific academic challenges that International students face and uses assessment strategies that offer the best opportunities to demonstrate a student's academic level and potential. Students each choose three academic subjects with exams at the end of the qualification. In addition, all students attend English classes designed to develop their English skills for university.

Final UFP grades are determined by exams as well as a significant amount of coursework which simulates the structure of most UK university courses. Students are offered iGCSE Maths to meet university entry requirements if not taking Maths as a UFP subject.

Choosing a subject combination is important as universities look for students that have good grades in the right subjects. We work intensively with each student choose the best combination to help achieve their university and career aspirations.

A Level

A Levels are the classic British path into higher education and offer an excellent route to study at high ranking UK universities. A Levels are a highly regarded qualification and can open the widest choice of UK universities. At Guildhouse School students can join Year 12 in both September and January to study for the A Level qualification.

Overview

A Levels are a focussed qualification of three subjects and English studied over two years, with examinations in the second year. Students are offered iGCSE Maths to meet university entry requirements if not taking Maths as a UFP subject.

At Guildhouse School our A Level delivery is specifically designed for motivated international students, with additional English language support to help them excel in their studies. We offer a wide range of subjects and work with each student to choose the best subject combinations to achieve their university goals.

Pre-A Level

Pre-A Level is designed as an introduction to the UK Further Education system and follows a similar approach to GCSE, but with a duration of one year or less. Students experience a wide range of subjects which prepares them to progress to study A Level, although this programme is also suitable for students wishing to progress to study UFP if they are of the appropriate age.

Pre-A Level offers students the opportunity to improve their English prior to moving to more advanced study and students should expect to take external exams in English and Maths. At Guildhouse School, we offer both September and January starting points for Pre-A Level.

The UAL Foundation Diplomas provide a foundational arts education that opens doors to specialists arts degrees and employment in the creative industries. CSVPA London delivers the UAL Foundation Diploma in studios, equipped with Mac computers, design tables and gallery spaces at the Guildhouse School. Students have a dedicated desk that they can use to study and create within the studio space.

Visual Communication, Advertising, Art Direction and Branding

This course introduces the fundamentals of visual communication and graphic design, including typography, composition and colour. Students are taught the knowledge and skills to become persuasive visual communicators.

Film, Moving Image and Animation

This course teaches both handmade and digital processes used to create moving image. Students cover all elements of film and animation production.


