




A teaching Script for parents or teachers; You may read this to your learner(s).

God Is One


(S) Did you know we have only one God in the world? Who might that be? That's our God the Lord! Nothing else in the world can be our God. We have just one God for the whole wide world. We may not be able to see Him face to face, but He is right here in our hearts. Now, time for a little finger exercise: "One! God is one!"

Trace Number 1

Trace, say and learn number 1.



A Couple Is Two

(S) When God created man, He created them male and female. The first man in the world was Adam, and the first woman was Eve. They got married and became a husband and wife. Let's count them with our fingers: "One, two!"




(S) Like Adam and Eve, father and mother got married in the past and became husband and wife. We also call them a couple. Let's count them. "One, two!" That's right, there are two of them. God made one man and one woman to be a couple!"



Copy Number 2

(S) Shall we sing the Number Song again? "...mother and the father, two is number two." And let's write the number two again. This time, we will trace number 2. Then, see and copy it on the next line. Don't forget to say "two" as you copy!




It's alright to make a mistake. You're doing great!!

LEARN THE SHAPE AND NAME OF NUMBER '3' WHICH REPRESENTS THE QUANTITY OF 'THREE'


Number 3

How Many Fruits?


S Color the correct number of fruits. After coloring the fruits, say how many and what kind of fruit it is.

(S) Your family were having dinner. First, you took 1 slice of tomato, 1 slice of cucumber, and 2 slices of meat on your plate. Then, you just remembered that your father told you to take some more food for you and your brother.

Look at the numbers in the circles and color the food below to add more slices on the plate to obey your father's instruction.
