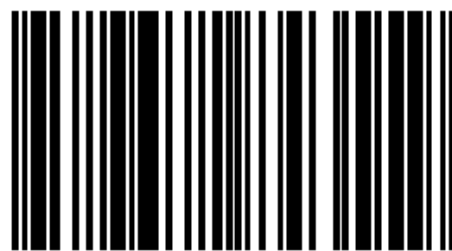

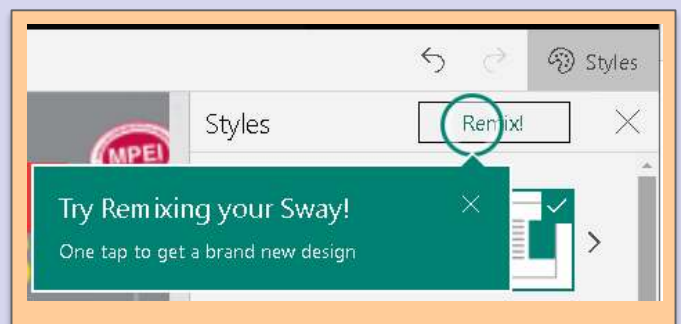

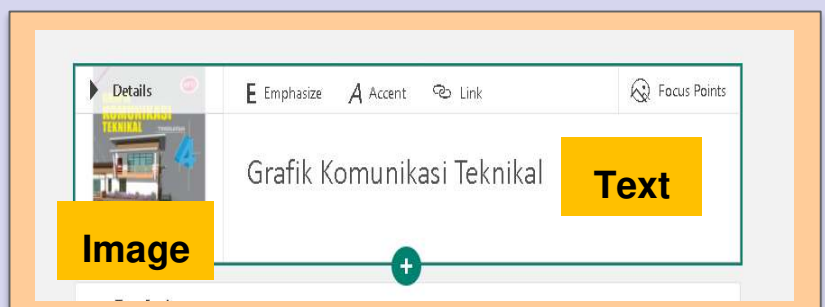

SWAY VS POWERPOINT

SWAY

- Three different layout options for how the content is presented: vertical, horizontal and slideshow.

- Much more limited in available templates.

- There are few different ways you can add content to Sway.

- Can share with individuals, organizations or with anyone on the web.

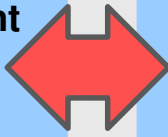
POWERPOINT

- Only can be created in slide show format.

- A lot of templates and also can create our own templates.

- Can manually add a wide variety of content to the presentation.

- Dependent on what version you're using.



BENEFITS OF SWAY

Simple to create effective communication tools

1. Drag and drop style editing system
2. Focuses more on content rather than layout
3. Internal search function to get more imagery content without leave the app

Ease of sharing information

1. Storyline can be accessed anywhere as long as you have internet connection.
2. Audience can access and view without needing to download.

Efficient and effective collaboration

1. Able work together with colleague on a presentation even if you are not based in the same place.
2. Cloud based.

Autosave your works

It includes Analytics if you have Office 365

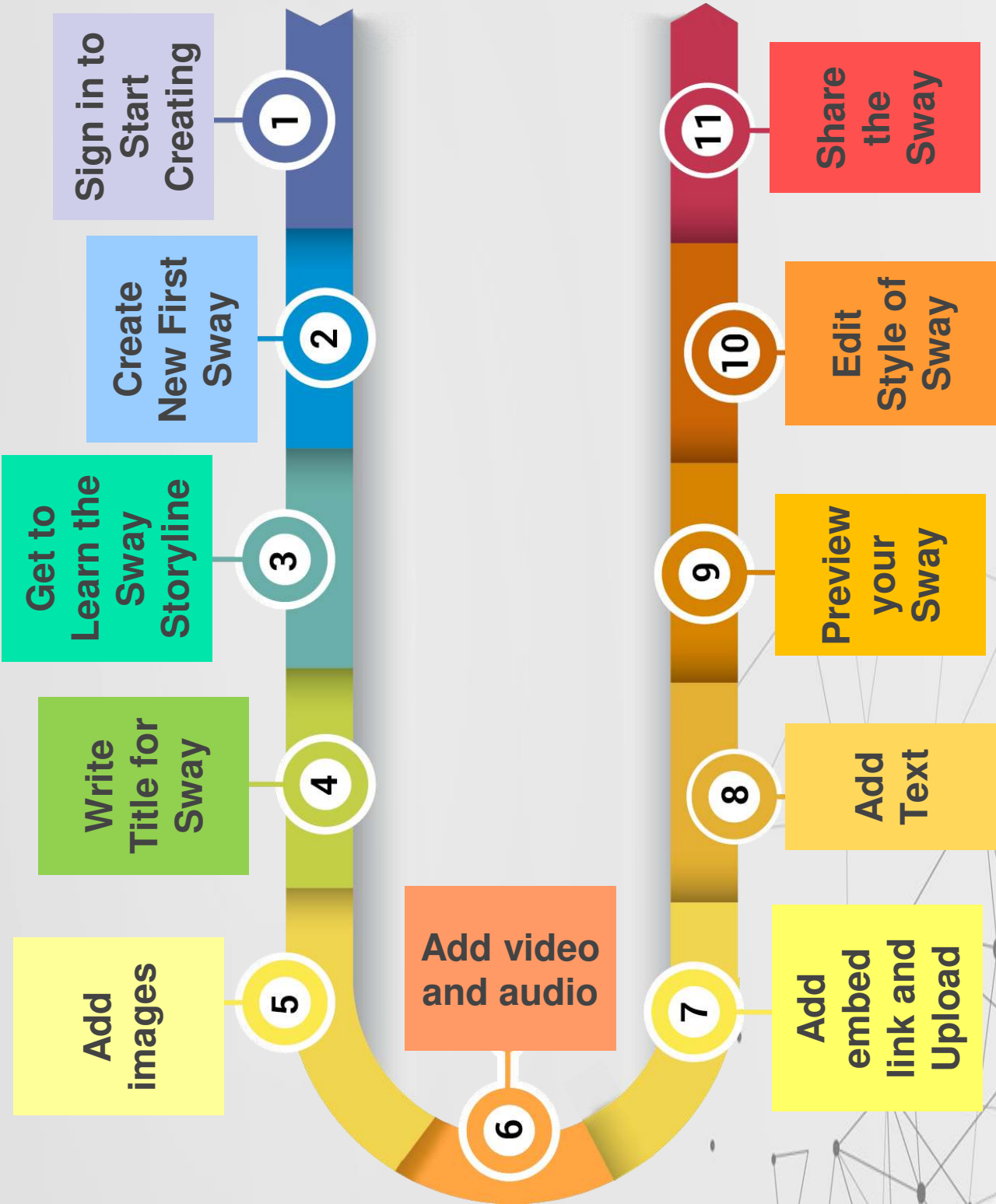

Storyline is a place for **typing, editing and formatting** the content that tells your story.

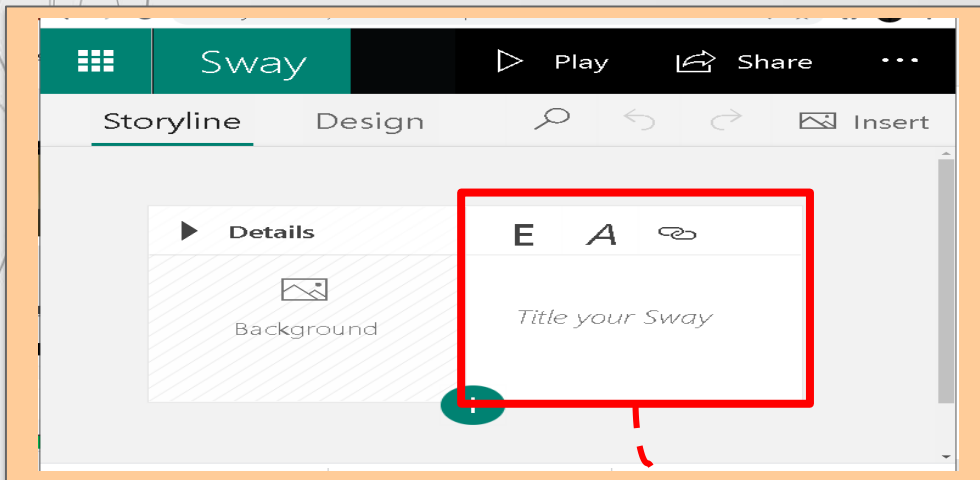

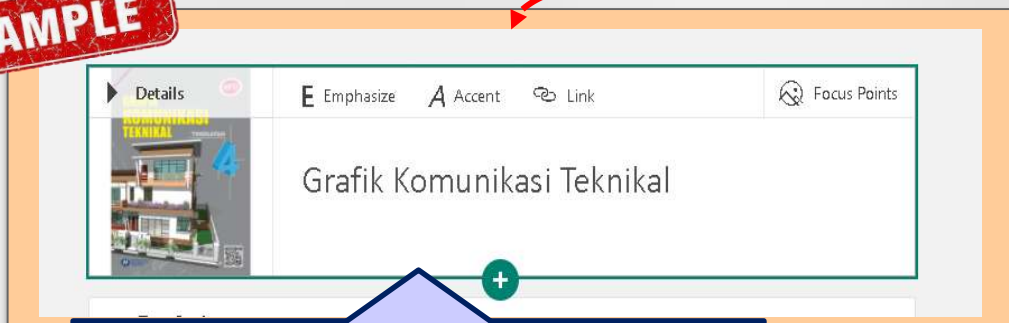
The sequence of cards can be rearranged at any time as your needs.

Make it short and simple. Describe it with the most meaningful words. So that, it will attract audience and make them more understand the content of Sway is all about.

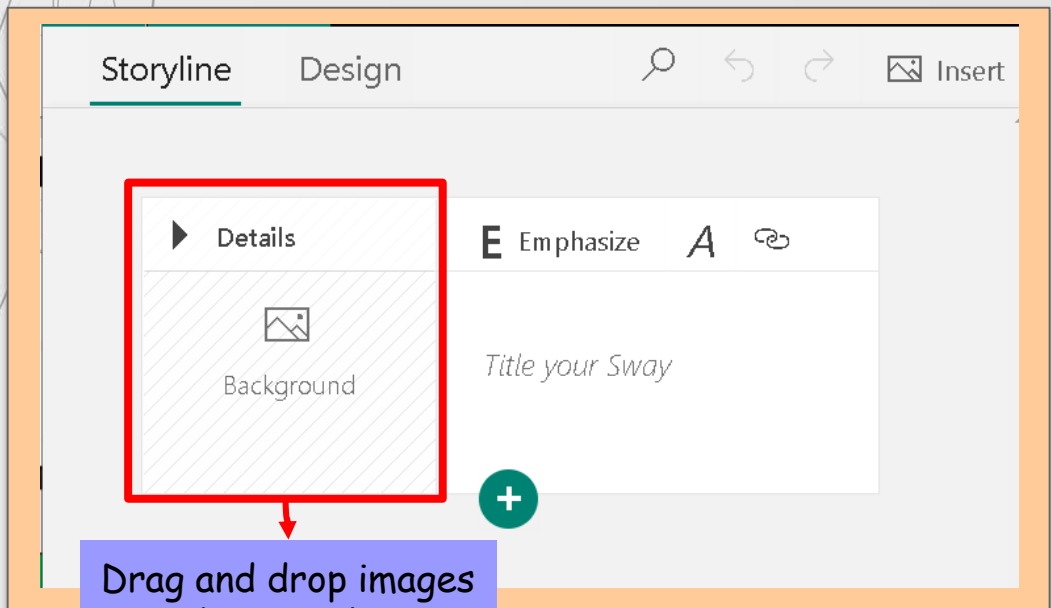

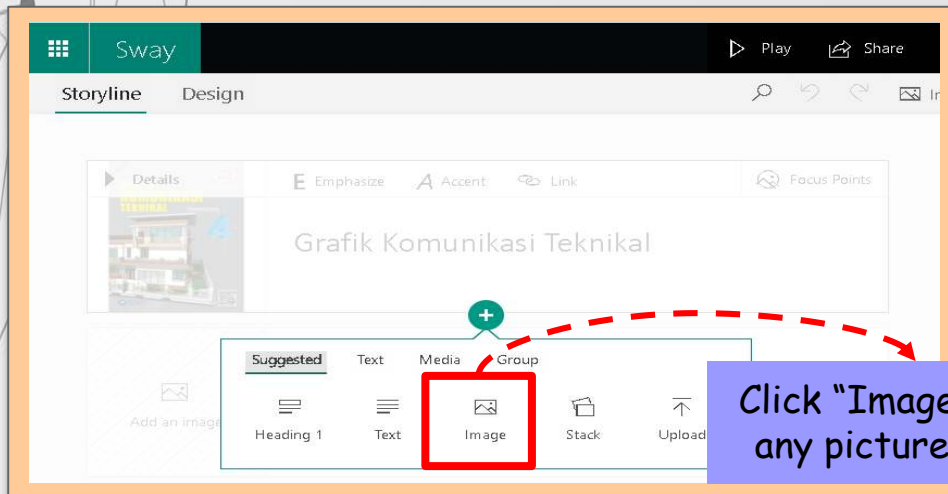

Add audio from your devices 😊

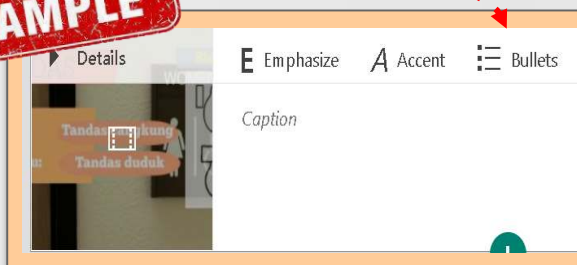
If you want to upload only voice recorded, select **Audio**

Click or Tap the icon  > **Media** at the bottom of any existing card when to add video and audio in your Sway.

If you want to upload a video:
Click **Video**, and then find your video at any resources such as Bing, Youtube

OR

Add existing video from your devices.

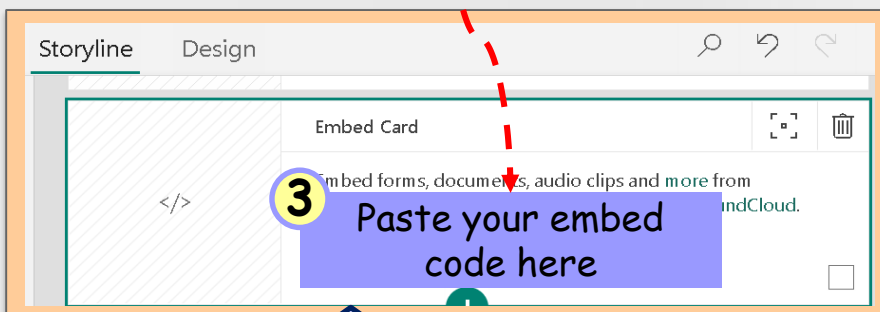
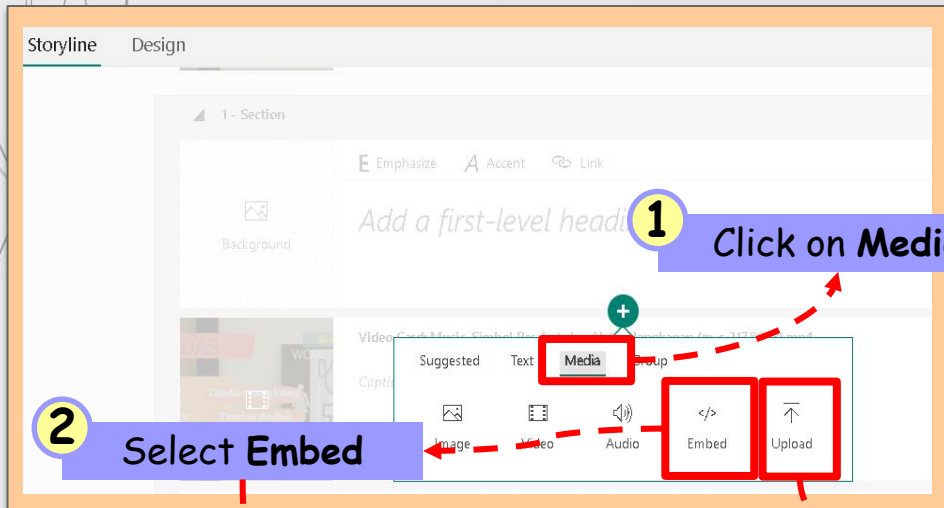

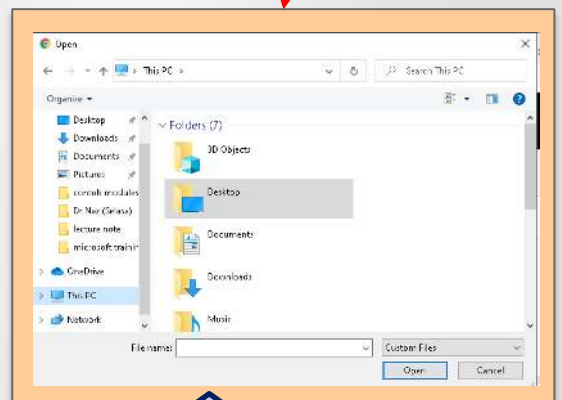
Record directly your voice by click on **Record** button.

7. Add embed link and Upload

Click **Embed**, and then paste your embed code.
Embed card could be: Embed forms, documents, audio clips and more from sources like Microsoft Forms, SharePoint and SoundCloud

If you want to upload any documents:
Click **Upload**, and then upload documents from your devices

8. Add Text

Click any Text Card to use the formatting toolbar

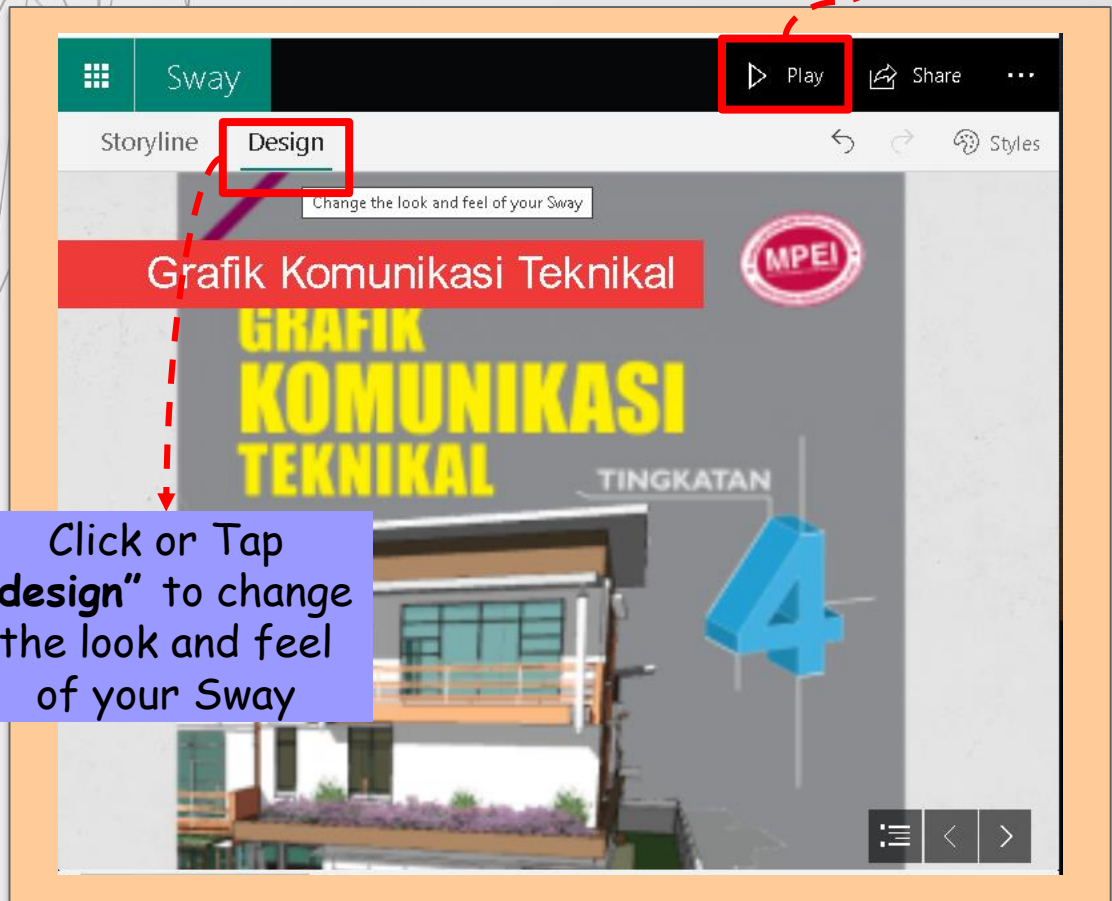

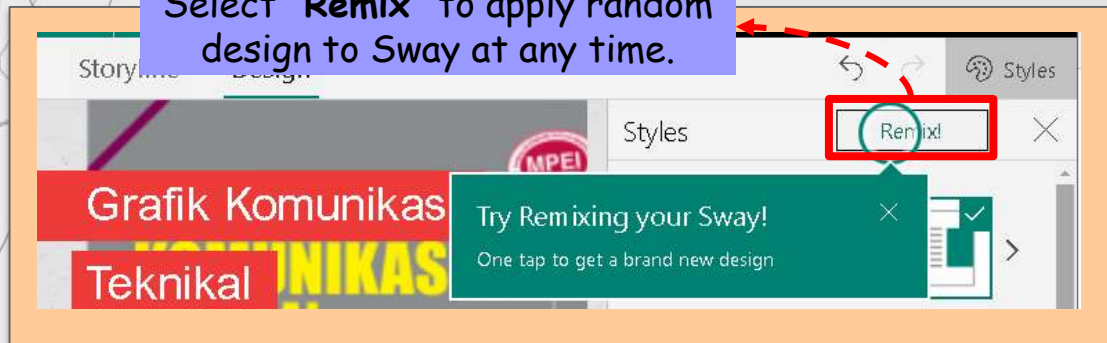

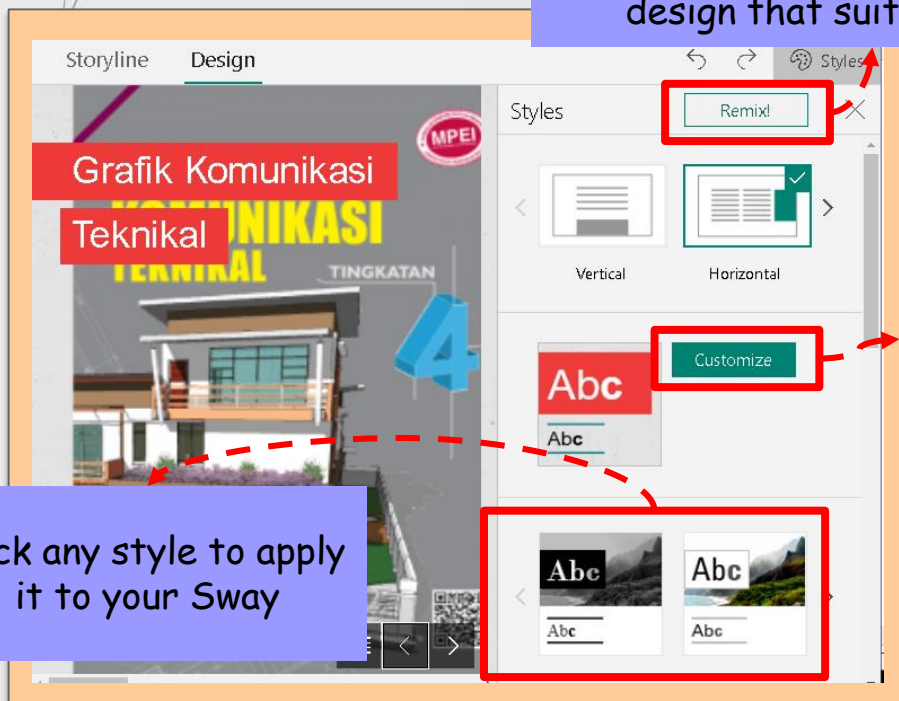

Select **"Remix"** to apply random design to Sway at any time.



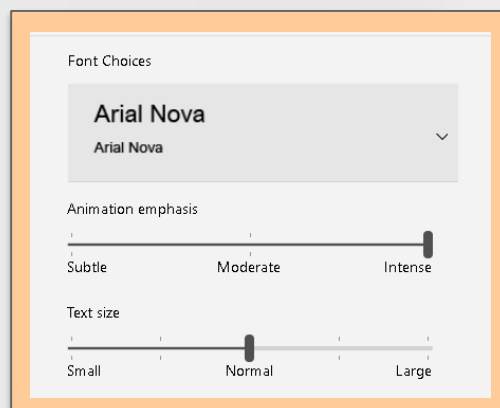
Click **"Remix"** repeatedly until find a design that suits your taste.

For random style, Click **Remix** repeatedly until you get a design and layout as your preferences.

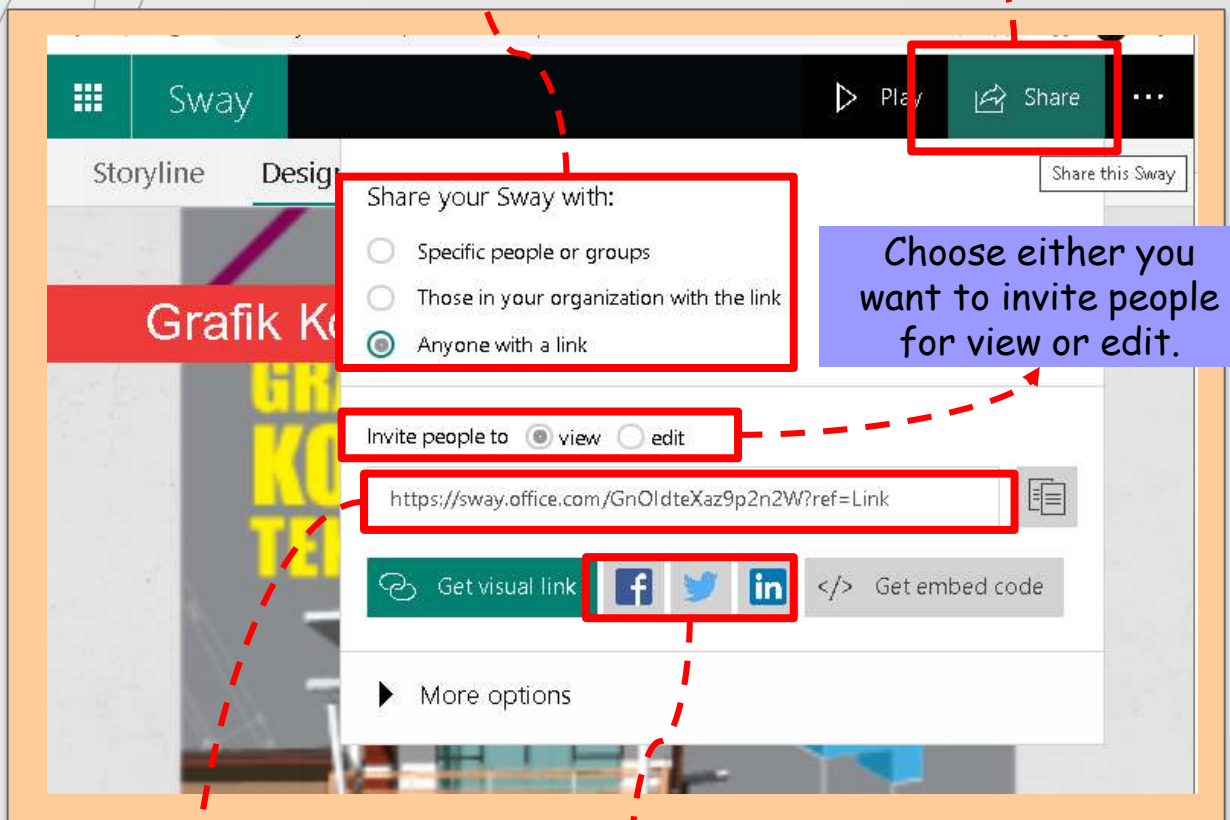

ADDITION SWAY IN TEAMS

STEP 1: Get Embed Code

1. Open document/Slide in Microsoft Sway
2. Click “Share” > Get Embed Code > Copy

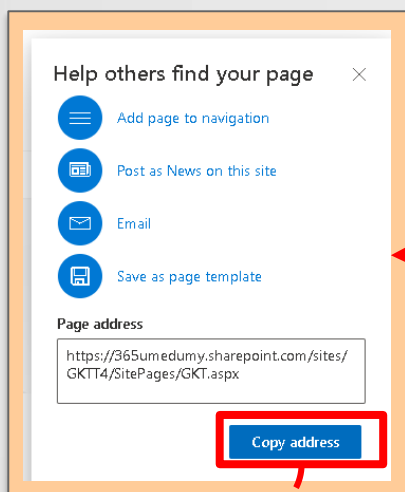
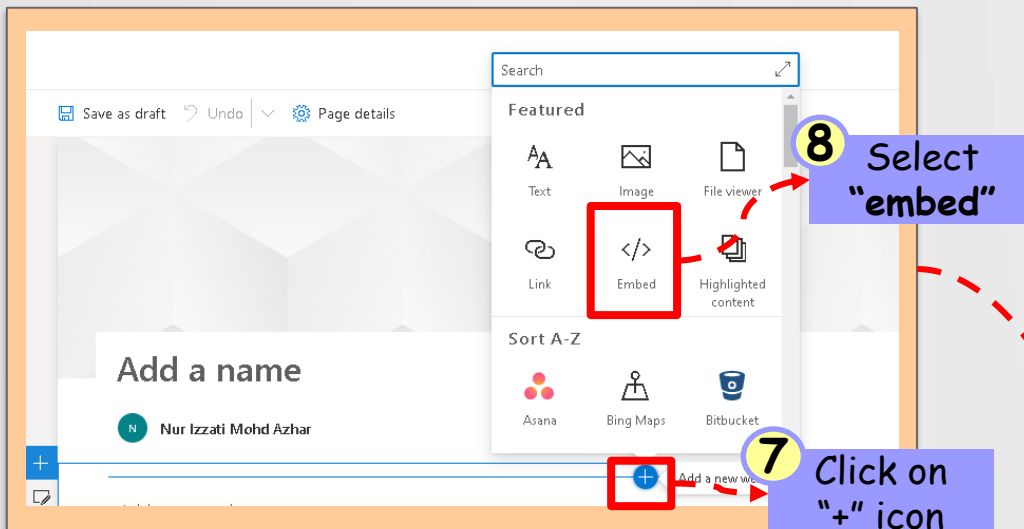

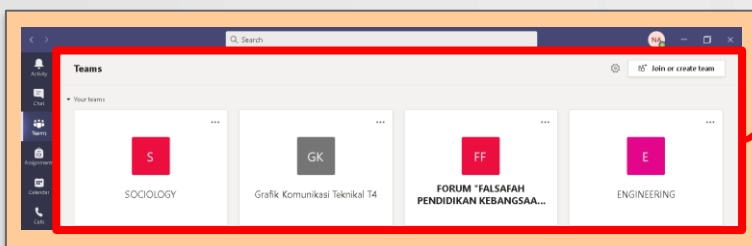
STEP 2: Open SharePoint in Microsoft 365.

1. Open Microsoft Office Home > Choose "SharePoint" > "New Page" > Add "Embed" > Paste Link (Sway) > Click Publish > Copy Link Address.

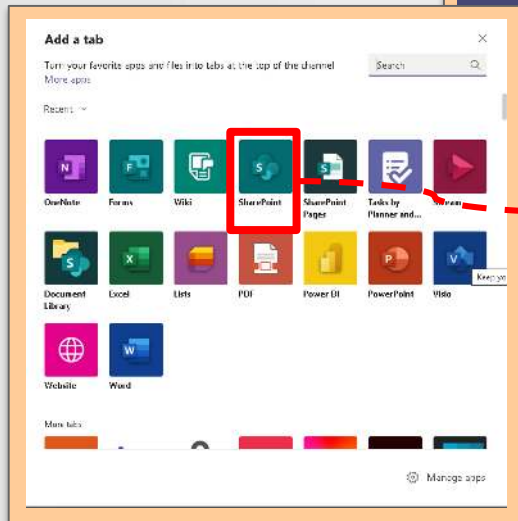


STEP 3: Add Sway to Teams

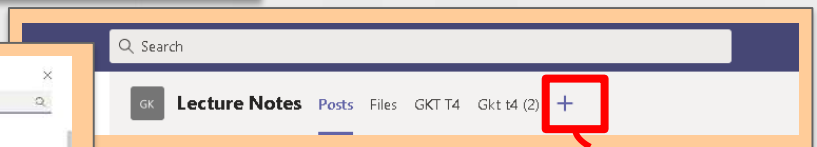
1. Go to the Microsoft Teams > Class > Subchannel > Click “+” to add New Task > Click SharePoint > Add page or list from any SharePoint > Paste the Link (SharePoint) > Click “Save”.



1 Select on your Teams

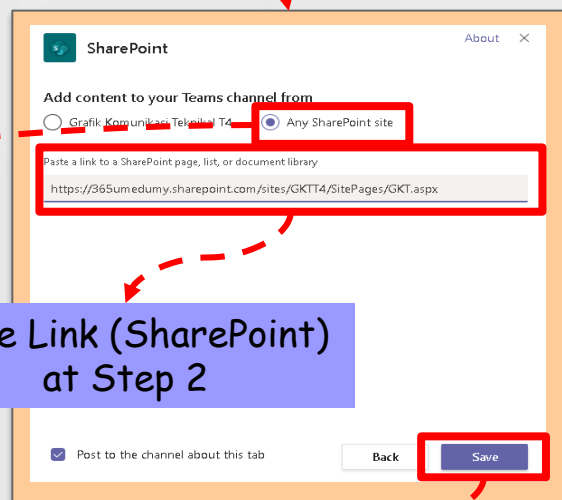


4 Select Any SharePoint site

3 Select SharePoint

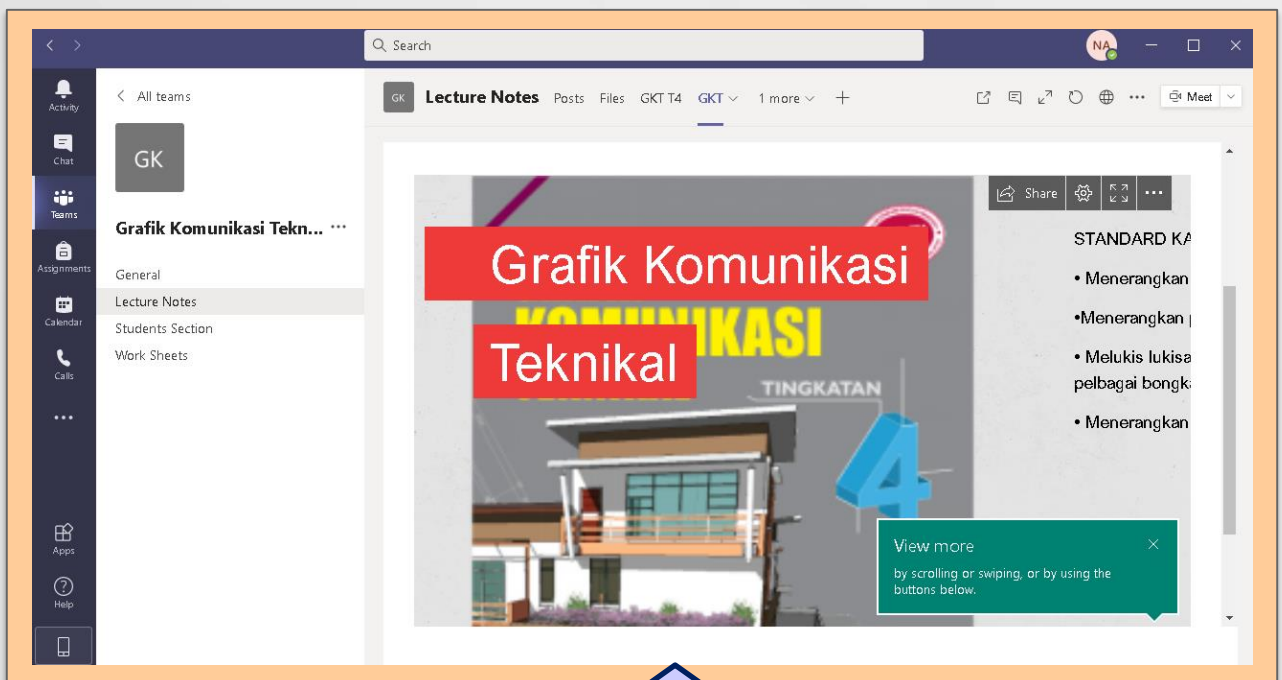


5 Paste Link (SharePoint) at Step 2
