Illustrious Sir Brandon Gould attended Ebenezer Lodge in Wooster on March 25th to be their guest speaker, talking about the Shrine and the Shriners Children's Hospitals!



Greetings, fellow Nobles:

As a follow-up to my earlier article on Temple and Hospital fundraising, and as most Nobles are aware, we have two distinct kinds of fundraisers within the Shrine.

Charitable fundraisers raise money for Shriners Hospitals for Children. 100% of the net proceeds from charitable fundraisers must be given to the hospital. Shriners Hospitals for Children is a 501(c)(3) corporation. A person donating to a charitable fundraiser is entitled to a charitable tax deduction.

Fraternal fundraisers benefit the Temple, a Club, or a Unit. Shrine Temples are 501(c)(10) domestic fraternal societies, and, with few exceptions, donations to a Fraternal fundraiser are not tax-deductible.

For this reason, and to avoid public confusion regarding the type of fundraiser a person may be asked to support, Shriners International requires "Statements of Purpose and Disclosure" on ALL fundraising promotional materials, raffle tickets, etc. Below are examples of the distinct types of disclosure language required:

Charitable Fundraisers: "Proceeds are for the benefit of Shriners Hospitals for Children."

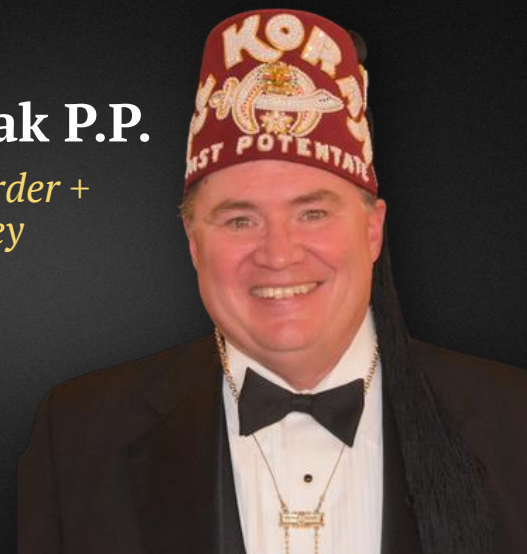
Fraternal Fundraisers: "Proceeds are for the benefit of (Club or Unit name) activities."

The next page has a checklist that the Temple, Clubs, and Units should use when planning their next fundraiser. If in doubt about whether your next Club or Unit fundraiser complies, call or email me in advance, and we will make sure the proper procedures are followed.

Charitable Fundraiser Checklist

- Has written permission been obtained from the Temple Potentate and chairmen of the boards of directors and trustees?
- Has the Temple Potentate reviewed and approved any necessary contracts?
- Has the appropriate insurance been obtained?
- Has the Temple Potentate examined all solicitation and promotional material to assure compliance with Shriners law?
- Have federal, state/province and local laws been complied with?
- Has there been compliance with The Revenue Act of 1987 (if the temple is located in the United States)? (See General Order No. 1)
- Has a "Statement of Purpose" been included on all tickets, solicitation material, programs and all other promotional material?
- Has the charity activity form been completed and returned to Shriners International Headquarters within 60 days of the activity to avoid an interest penalty?

Fraternal Fundraiser Checklist

- Has written permission been obtained from the Temple Potentate?
- Has a copy of the approval been sent to the Executive Vice President – Shriners International?
- Has the Temple Potentate reviewed and approved any necessary contracts?
- Has the appropriate insurance been obtained?

- Have all federal, state/province and local laws been complied with?

- Have a "Statement of Purpose" and "Disclosure" been included on all tickets, solicitation and promotional material, including temple publications?



Prepared for a dues hike?

I bet you are not. Also, it kind of makes you think why didn't I pay for a life membership when they were a lot less expensive.

NO, Al Koran is not requesting an increase in members dues, currently. We are, however, considering one for the future. Don't get all excited, changing your dues amount would require us to go to Imperial for a change to our bylaws, and we are just about out of time for 2026. The soonest we could do so would be 2027. By the way you, the Nobility, would also have to approve the change before we sent it on to Imperial.

So, what am I talking about. Well, there will be a concerted effort on the part of Shriners International to increase the per capita. They tried and failed last year and they will try again this year. Remember, that per capita was \$15 in 2000. It was raised to \$30 in 2015 and raised again in 2023 to \$50. They are looking at increasing the cost once again, by at least \$20, and preferably \$25-\$30. By the way, the hospitals, whose budget for 2025 was \$1.1 Billion, yes Billion, was fully funded last year through earnings from the endowment, third party pay, and donations to Shriners Hospitals for Children.

Why does Imperial want so dramatic and increase. The major costs are the travel and lodging reimbursements for the delegates and their legal spouses. We now have temples in Lebanon, Europe, Central and South America, the Philippines and Australia. Think about that airfare. While I have heard delegates claim that there is a lot of fat in the international budget, it simply is not true. I have seen the details for their budget and travel and lodging are the largest costs to hold an Imperial session.

International bylaws require that these costs be paid to those who attend. What the bylaws do not require is an Imperial session to be held every year. Think about that.

Now how about here at the local level. We are in decent shape. Yes, we have \$3 million dollars. Most of that is in a diverse portfolio, which started out as just under \$1 million in 2015. When we sold our building in 2015 and had no rental or utility cost, until 2018, we also saved some money. You may remember that for a significant stretch there was no money to be made in savings accounts or even certificates of deposit.

The Divan is looking at ways to earn money on our capital. While its unofficial name is the building fund, which is the money we took from the sale of the building, we have not taken any of that money out of that fund, just let it grow.

Additionally, we have been the recipient of a couple of sizable bequests. Those bequests we have placed into annuities, each earning approximately 4%.

What all that really means is that we have no income (essentially) other than dues and fundraising. In 2025 income from dues was approximately \$60K. Additional income may account for another \$10K. In 2025 Fundraising efforts amounted to approximately \$5,000.00, so we took in roughly \$75,000.00 and we passed a spending budget of approximately \$150,000.00. Things will not get any better unless we do some work.

Yes, we are exploring options to earn money from the 'building fund' to bolster the budget. Yes, we trimmed the fat from the budget. Take the magazine/newsletter which was costing us over \$30K a year to get out to you, with crazy mailing delays, and such, and now costs us less than \$2500.00. But we may still fall short. How much? We are still working on that.

While not the easiest way to bolster the income, fundraising is better (maybe?) option than raising the dues. It is not as easy; I can tell you that. It is a whole lot easier for me just to raise all your dues. Yes, that also comes with significant consequences, and I also spoke about that earlier in this article.

So here is the crux of the matter. There could be a dues increase if Imperial passes an increase to the per capita, Al Koran is in no position to absorb that increase. Additionally, we need help from the Nobility in our fundraising efforts.

Somewhere around 2012 we sold around 3600 bags of onions and made \$3 to \$5 a bag. Not Bad. Last year's was around 500 bags. We made a bit more per bag \$5-\$8, but quite the drop. The 2025 Sportsman's Raffle lost money. We have made improvements for 2026, which we hope will make it a significant money maker, otherwise it is just not worth the effort. Which is really a shame as several nearby Temples make \$50 to \$100K on their raffles. If we could make \$75K we wouldn't need to even consider an increase in dues and could consider subsidizing more events for the benefit of the Nobility.

For those of you who are not fans of Sportsman's Raffles, the Festival of Trees has some exciting prospects. Organizational and informational meetings are currently taking place.

The bottom line is we need your help. Human help. We need Nobles selling Raffle tickets and we will need considerable help from the Noble and their significant others if we are even to attempt a Festival of Trees.

As a side note by Ohio law, half of our profits must go to charity. Can anyone think of one?

We need your help. It is Your Temple. Please get involved.
