

## A Comprehensive Dental Program - A Wonderful Partnership

We all know that teaching children at an early age about the importance of good oral hygiene is essential in promoting healthy teeth throughout their lives. Children who practice good dental habits such as brushing twice a day, flossing between teeth daily, and limiting sugary beverages and snacks will have a lesser chance of developing problems such as plaque, gum disease, and cavities later in life. Educating young children about the importance of good oral hygiene is an essential part of the curriculum at Children's Friend. Through our partnership with Samuels Sinclair, Children's Friend ensures that children receive the critical dental care that is so important for our overall good health.

One way Children's Friend typically promotes good oral health is the continuation of our Dental Sealant Project. Children in Head Start and Pre-K classrooms are screened for sealants. Dental sealants, applied by a licensed dentist, form a protective barrier that helps to prevent bacteria from developing, which causes cavities. Our Dental Team, comprised of our health manager and health project coordinators, continues to promote awareness regarding the benefits of dental sealants. The Health and Nursing Manager at Children's Friend, Lindsey Brannon, RN, BSN, and her nursing team continually focus their efforts to ensure that the number of children who have access to a licensed dentist increases each year.

Our partnership with Samuels Sinclair continues to raise awareness of how critical it is to have dental care provided by a licensed dentist in a comprehensive, accessible, coordinated, and family-centered manner. A successful, positive upward trend within our dental program over the past three years indicates that more families now make dental arrangements with a private dentist. We also see a low percentage of families with no dental home.

## **Key Accomplishments And Continued Progress**

The 2020-2021 school year proved quite a challenge throughout the pandemic. Children's Friend worked diligently to ensure children were able to be seen at their dentist offices and continued to provide education on oral health. Although the numbers reflect the difficulties our families faced, the work was still done to ensure we could help families see the dentist. As mentioned previously, due to the pandemic, no children were seen on-site by Samuels Sinclair.

**53 children** received a cleaning and fluoride treatment from a dental hygienist

**264 Head Start children** have a dental home, with 73 using Samuels Sinclair and 191 using another dental home

With all dental and nursing staff being fully vaccinated and following all recommended protocols to keep children and staff as safe as possible, we have booked our fall schedule and look forward to providing dental care inside our buildings once again.
