APPRENTICESHIPS Learn a trade



Apprenticeships are generally completed over a 3 to 4 year period and can be either in automotive servicing or automotive parts.

Thomas Bros employs different Registered Training Organisations to suit the individual needs of the Apprentice or Trainee.

This includes a variety of different delivery methods, including on-site training, attendance at the local TAFE campuses, or at a specialised Toyota campus in Canberra (CIT).

All of our Apprentices and Trainees are supervised, coached, and mentored by our highly experienced and skilled team and paid above-award wages. We also offer a complete toolbox setup to use throughout your apprenticeship, and it's yours to keep when you finish your apprenticeship! An automotive apprenticeship can lead to many different career pathways in a dealership, such as Workshop Controller, Technical Advisor, Service Manager and Parts roles.
