

JUNE / JULY SPEEDWATCH REPORT

From this month onwards the Speed Report will cover the two speed monitors owned and deployed by the Great Ellingham Parish Council.

The first part of the traffic speed analysis Report has been derived from the SID as positioned on the 30mph sign outside the entrance to Great Ellingham Recreation Ground on Watton Road, where it has been set up to monitor the traffic approaching Great Ellingham from Watton This month a total of 52,522 vehicles passed and one in five vehicles is entering the village at a speed above 35mph.

The second part of the traffic speed analysis Report has been derived from the SAM as positioned on the 20mph School Warning sign near to Great Ellingham Primary School on Hingham Road, where it has been set up to monitor the traffic approaching Great Ellingham from Hingham. This month, 52,522 vehicles passed through and one in ten vehicles is entering the village at a speed above 35mph.
