Our main Building is located at 235 Queens Quay West, on the south side of Queens Quay West, where Lower Simcoe Street ends. Our campus extends from York Street all the way to Bathurst Street with many venues (indoor and outdoor) and places to gather with loved ones for a great time by the water.



TAKE PUBLIC TRANSIT

The closest accessible subway station is **Union Station**. Harbourfront Centre is the nearest streetcar stop. From Union Station, take the **510 streetcar** and get off two stops later at the Harbourfront Centre stop.



BIKE ALONG THE QUEENS QUAY WATERFRONT TRAIL

Jump on your bike or explore the city with Bike Share Toronto as you pedal down to our concerts, festivals or to catch the panoramic skyline. There's something about a lakeside cycle that will keep you coming down for more.



ARRIVE BY PLANE

Toronto's Billy Bishop City Airport is only a few blocks away and a convenient way to travel. Hit the ground running to Toronto's beloved destination, Harbourfront Centre, to enjoy a rich offering of art, culture and community recreation.



WATER TAXIS

Harbourfront Centre has three approved Water Taxi companies operating from locations between York Street and Lower Spadina Avenue. These operators can take you to the Toronto Islands and other approved locations within Toronto Harbour, and back to Harbourfront Centre.



PARKING

Access P2 Parking on-site at 235 Queens Quay West and the Rees Street Parking lot at the North West corner of Rees Street and Queens Quay West. Make a full day of your stay and enjoy the best that the waterfront has to offer. (P.S.: We are also one of the cheaper lots around for sports events in the neighbourhood.)


