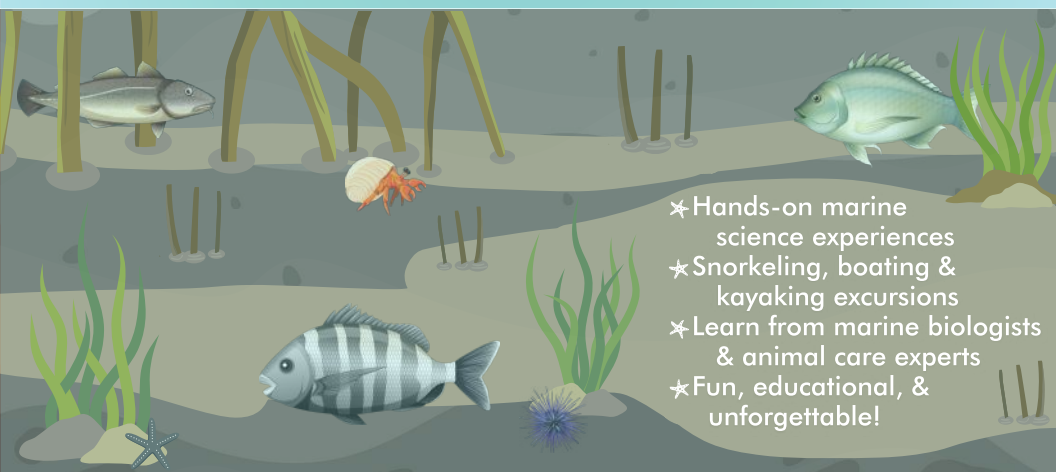

Make a splash this summer with Clearwater Marine Aquarium's Marine Science Summer Camps—where education meets real-world exploration! Each week-long camp is packed with hands-on activities, exciting animal encounters, and unforgettable experiences designed to inspire the next generation of ocean advocates. Campers will explore Florida's coastal ecosystems through activities that may include snorkeling in seagrass beds, kayaking through estuaries, and discovering marine life in its natural habitat—all depending on camp theme and age group. Campers will also get to know our resident animals while learning about marine biology, conservation, and animal care.

All camps are led by trained instructors and supported by college interns. For camps that include snorkeling, boats are supervised by U.S. Coast Guard-certified captains. Snorkeling experience is not required, and all snorkeling occurs in water shallow enough for campers to stand. **Important: All campers must be able to swim to enroll in Clearwater Marine Aquarium camps.**

GENERAL CAMP INFORMATION

CAMP TIMES

- Each camp is a 5-day program, scheduled Monday through Friday of the chosen week.
 - Morning camp sessions operate from 8:30 am to 11:30 am.
 - Afternoon camp sessions run from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm.
- For a full-day camp experience, you have the option to purchase both morning and afternoon sessions in the same week (8:30 am to 4:00 pm).
- Advanced Marine Biology, Ecosystem Advocates, Field Investigation, and Animal Care 101 are full-day camps, running from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm.

CAMP PRICES

Prices vary by camp and can be found under each camp description. Camp discount pricing for active members is not available for the “Ocean Explorer” Membership Level; however, all CMA members are eligible for the early registration period. To receive the camp discount, make sure you are signed into your CMA member account when registering. The discount will automatically apply if your membership level qualifies. Please note that you must be an active member at the time of registration; discounts cannot be applied retroactively if you become a member after registering for camp.

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

- Space is limited, and camps fill up quickly. Register for summer camps online at cmaquarium.org.
 - No email, in-person, or phone reservations will be accepted.
- CMA’s Marine Science Camp and Marine Academy Camp are designed for participants aged 5 to 18. To join, campers must be a minimum of 5 years old, have completed Kindergarten, and be no older than 18—currently in high school or having graduated within the most recent semester when their camp begins.
 - For Advanced Marine Biology, campers must be 15 years old by the day their camp begins.
- Age verification may be requested prior to the first day of camp.
- Campers must be comfortable in the water and possess basic swimming skills; however, they do not need to be advanced swimmers. All campers must also be self-sufficient—able to use the restroom and change their clothing independently.
- Campers must be registered for a camp that aligns with their age. Clearwater Marine Aquarium reserves the right to cancel or modify any registration that does not match the camper’s age and reassign them to the appropriate age group, if space allows.
- During the enrollment process, complete the registration form in full. A receipt will be emailed upon completing your reservation. Save and print the receipt to bring it with you on the first day of camp.

CAMPER AGE GROUP COLOR KEY

Campers who are 18 years old must have completed their senior year of high school in the semester immediately preceding the summer in order to attend camp. Advanced Marine Biology campers **MUST be 15 to participate in the Discover Scuba session at a local dive shop.*



GETTING READY FOR CAMP

WHAT YOU SHOULD PACK

- **Snack & Water Bottle:** Pack a peanut-free & tree-nut-free snack each day. Send a refillable water bottle to keep your camper hydrated. Please avoid soda or carbonated beverages, as they may cause discomfort in the heat. Water or sports drinks are recommended.
- **Lunch:** If your camper is enrolled in Lunch Bunch, both morning and afternoon sessions, or a full-day camp, please send a peanut-free & tree nut-free lunch unless you've purchased a catered lunch. Lunches will be stored at room temperature with no access to refrigeration or microwaves. Please pack non-perishable items.
- **Backpack:** Campers should bring a backpack each day to carry personal items such as:
 - Snorkel gear (mask & snorkel)
 - Towel
 - Closed-toe water shoes (required for water activities)
 - Change of clothes (including undergarments)
 - Sunscreen, hat, and insect repellent
- **Attire:** Campers should arrive dressed in a swimsuit under their camp T-shirt and bottoms each day. While campers may wear any comfortable shoes throughout the day, closed-toe water shoes are required for kayaking, snorkeling, and select field trips. These protect feet from sharp objects under the water.
 - **Campers without closed-toe water shoes will not be allowed in the water. CMA does not sell water shoes—please come prepared.**
- **Optional: Camera or Cell Phone:** Campers are welcome to bring a camera or phone to capture memories. Staff will not take photos during activities like snorkeling, kayaking, or classroom time, as their focus is supervision and safety. Staff may assist campers in taking photos if time and conditions allow.

WHAT WE PROVIDE

Once you've packed the essentials, we'll take care of the rest. We provide:

- One complimentary CMA camp T-shirt per camper
- Snorkel vests for all snorkeling activities
- All kayaking gear (kayaks, paddles, and life jackets)
- Transportation to and from field trip locations*

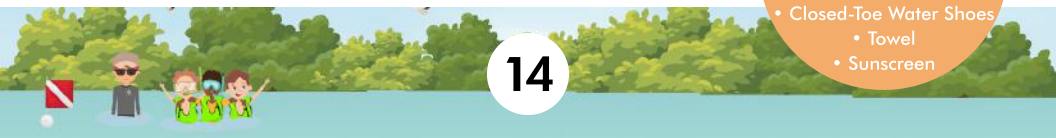

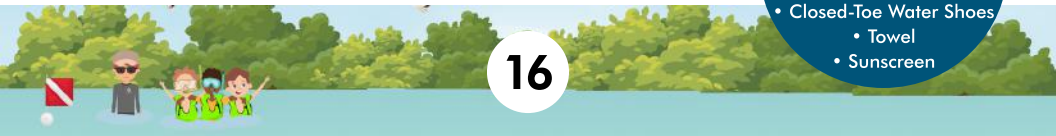

2026 CAMP POLICIES

CANCELATION & REFUND POLICY

Refunds on camp payments will be processed only after written cancellation requests are received via email at camps@cmaquarium.org.

- Cancellations received 15 or more days before the first day of camp: 80% refund of total camp cost.
- Cancellations received 5 to 14 days before the first day of camp: 50% refund of total camp cost.
- Cancellations received 0 to 4 days before the first day of camp: No refund will be issued.

Please note the following important policies:

- Once a cancellation request is received via email, your camper's spot is forfeited. If you change your mind, you must re-register through the regular camp registration process.
- No full or partial refunds, camp credits, make-up days, or discounts will be provided for missed days of camp. This includes absences due to illness, scheduling conflicts, or other personal circumstances.
- Refunds will not be issued for campers who attend one or more days of a program.
- A 100% refund can be issued for any camp add-ons as long as the product has not yet been issued to the camper.
- Clearwater Marine Aquarium also reserves the right to cancel a camp for any reason. If your camp is canceled, you will be contacted a minimum of three (3) days in advance. We require a minimum of three (3) participants per camp session. If we do not meet the minimum required participants by the Wednesday prior to camp, the camp will be canceled, and full refunds or rescheduling will be conducted.

DATE CHANGE POLICY

Requests to change your camper's week of attendance must be submitted in writing to camps@cmaquarium.org at least 5 business days prior to the start of the originally scheduled camp week. You may not request to change camp dates if your camper has already attended one or more days of the original camp week. All date change requests are subject to availability and must be approved by Clearwater Marine Aquarium Education management.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Florida is prone to thunderstorms, tropical storms, red tide, and hurricanes. There may be times when normal camp schedules need to be altered due to inclement weather or unsafe water conditions, such as high winds, heavy rainfall, or extremely high tides rendering the water unsuitable for activities like snorkeling or kayaking. In these instances, Clearwater Marine Aquarium has indoor classroom activities prepared to ensure campers continue to have a fun and educational experience. For camps that include snorkeling, traveling, kayaking, animal encounters, or other outdoor activities, our staff will adjust schedules and programming as needed for the safety of all participants. We will make every effort to resume normal camp schedules as soon as weather or water conditions allow. However, because Clearwater Marine Aquarium does not control the weather, water quality, or sea conditions, we cannot guarantee that all outdoor activities will take place every day. **No full or partial refunds will be issued due to missed outdoor activities caused by inclement weather or poor water conditions.**

In the rare event that Clearwater Marine Aquarium must close due to a hurricane or other emergency situation, please check cmaquarium.org for updates regarding camp operations.



2026 CAMP POLICIES

CAMPER SAFETY

For your camper's safety, Camp Staff will only release your child to an authorized pick-up person with a valid photo ID at sign-out. Authorized pick-ups are designated during registration. If your child will be picked up by someone not listed, you must notify CMA staff either in person during check-in or via email at camps@cmaquarium.org. Failure to notify staff in advance may result in delays while Education staff confirm authorization with the listed parent or guardian. Additionally, all persons, bags, parcels, and personal items may be subject to screening or security checks upon arrival. For the safety of our guests, animals, and staff, no weapons, bicycles, skateboards, scooters, skates, glass containers, or balloons are permitted. We recommend campers bring clear bags to help reduce check-in times. For a full list of prohibited items, please refer to our Aquarium Rules page.

All CMA camp staff are trained in First Aid and CPR. Additionally, all staff undergo background checks through the Florida Department of Children and Families to ensure the safety of every camper. We continue to evolve our protocols and procedure as we receive guidance and recommendations from government agencies, including the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Pinellas County Government, and the Florida Department of Health. Protocols and planned camp schedules are subject to change based on current guidance to ensure the safety and well-being of all participants. We appreciate your flexibility and understanding as we adapt to current conditions.

CAMPER ALLERGIES

Peanut and tree nut products are not permitted in camp. Please ensure all lunches and snacks are nut-free. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us keep all campers safe and healthy.

Please note: Clearwater Marine Aquarium is not a nut-free facility, and we cannot guarantee the absence of allergens. However, we make every reasonable effort to reduce the risk to campers with severe allergies or anaphylaxis. It is the parent's responsibility to notify the Camp Supervisor both verbally and in writing if their child has an allergy, is anaphylactic, or potentially anaphylactic. Allergies must also be clearly listed on the camp registration form.

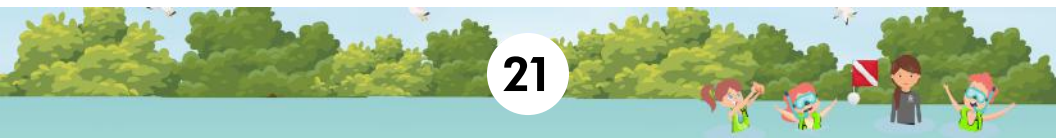
BOATING & SNORKELING SAFETY

Clearwater Marine Aquarium is committed to providing a safe and supportive experience for all campers during all activities. In accordance with U.S. Coast Guard regulations, life jackets are not required to be worn on CMA vessels; however, life jackets are available for camps that include boating and snorkeling. Our camp boats are U.S. Coast Guard-certified and equipped with railings and essential safety features.

Campers participating in snorkeling will be provided with a snorkeling vest. If you would prefer your camper to wear a life jacket instead, please inform Camp Staff during morning sign-in. Snorkeling activities take place in shallow, standing-depth water, and no prior snorkeling experience is required. However, all campers must be able to swim in order to participate. By registering, you confirm that your camper is in good physical condition and can adapt to the challenges snorkeling can present.

KAYAKING SAFETY

Before kayaking sessions, Camp Teachers will provide instruction on basic paddling techniques and proper equipment use. Per U.S. Coast Guard regulations, life jackets are required for all kayaking participants—no exceptions. Kayaking is a physically active experience, and campers must be able to paddle, sit for extended periods, and adapt to the physical challenges kayaking may present.

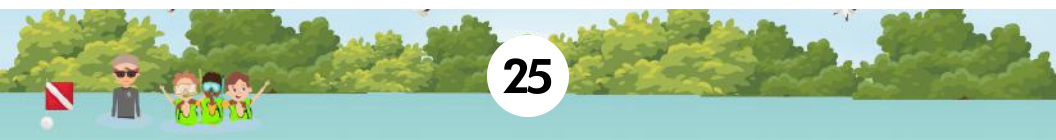
