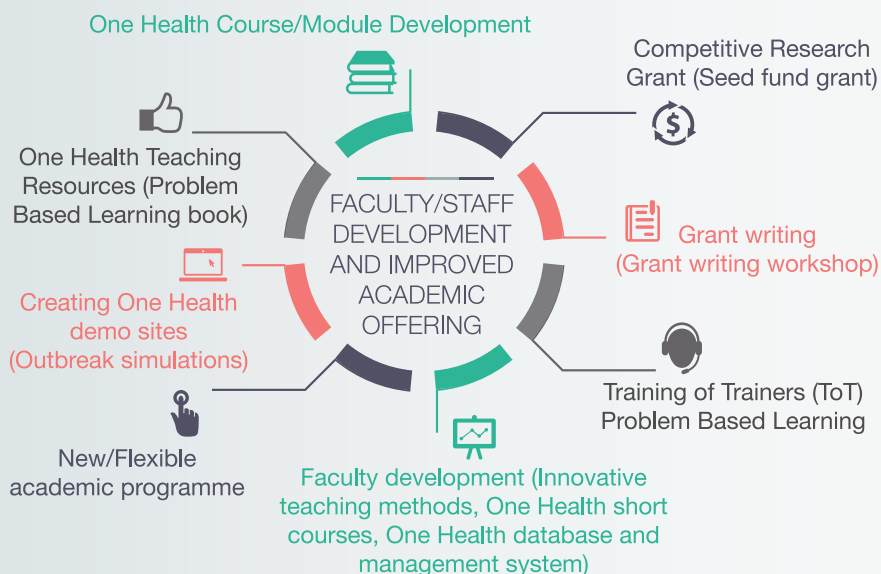

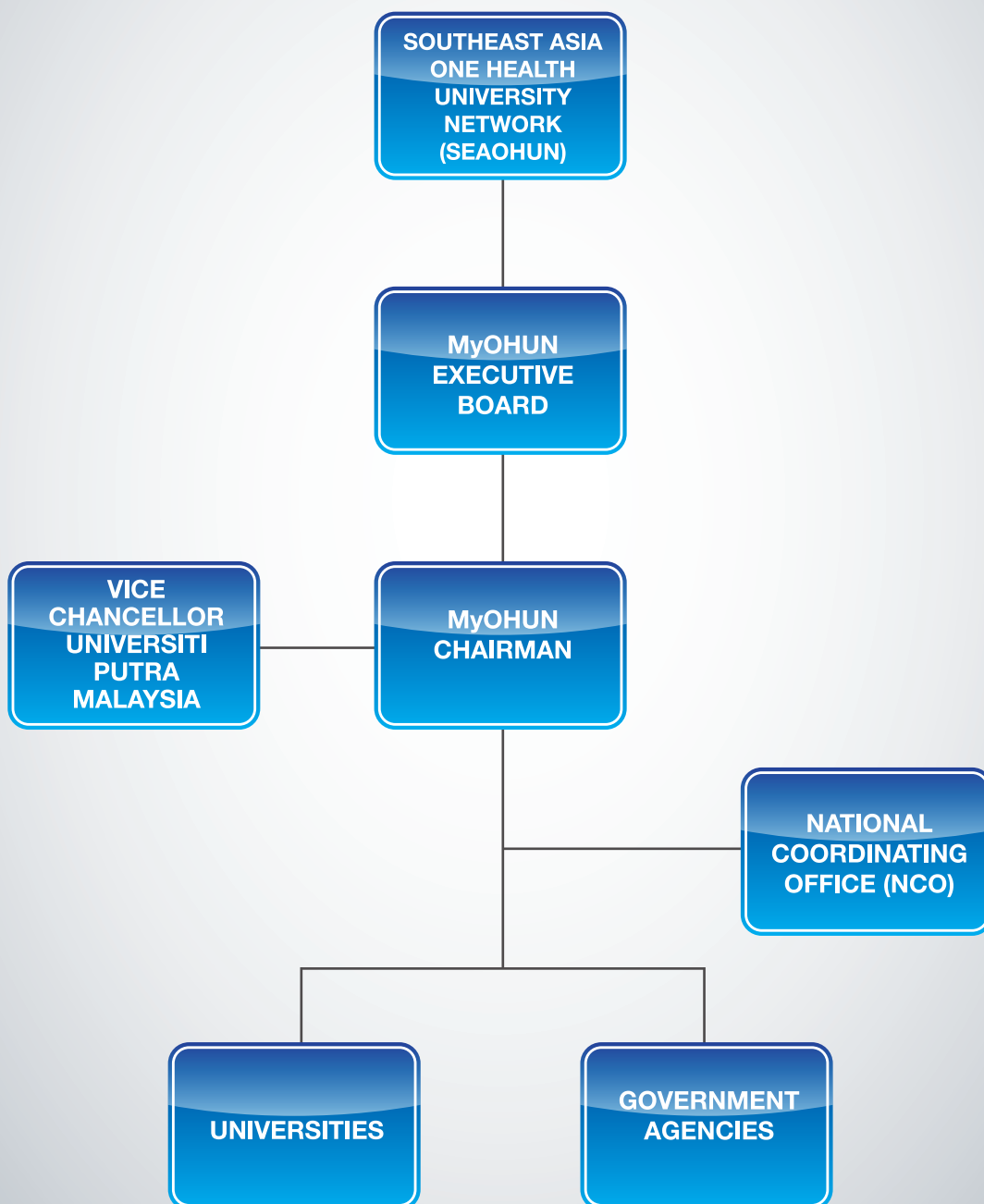

## ORGANIZATION STRUCTURES

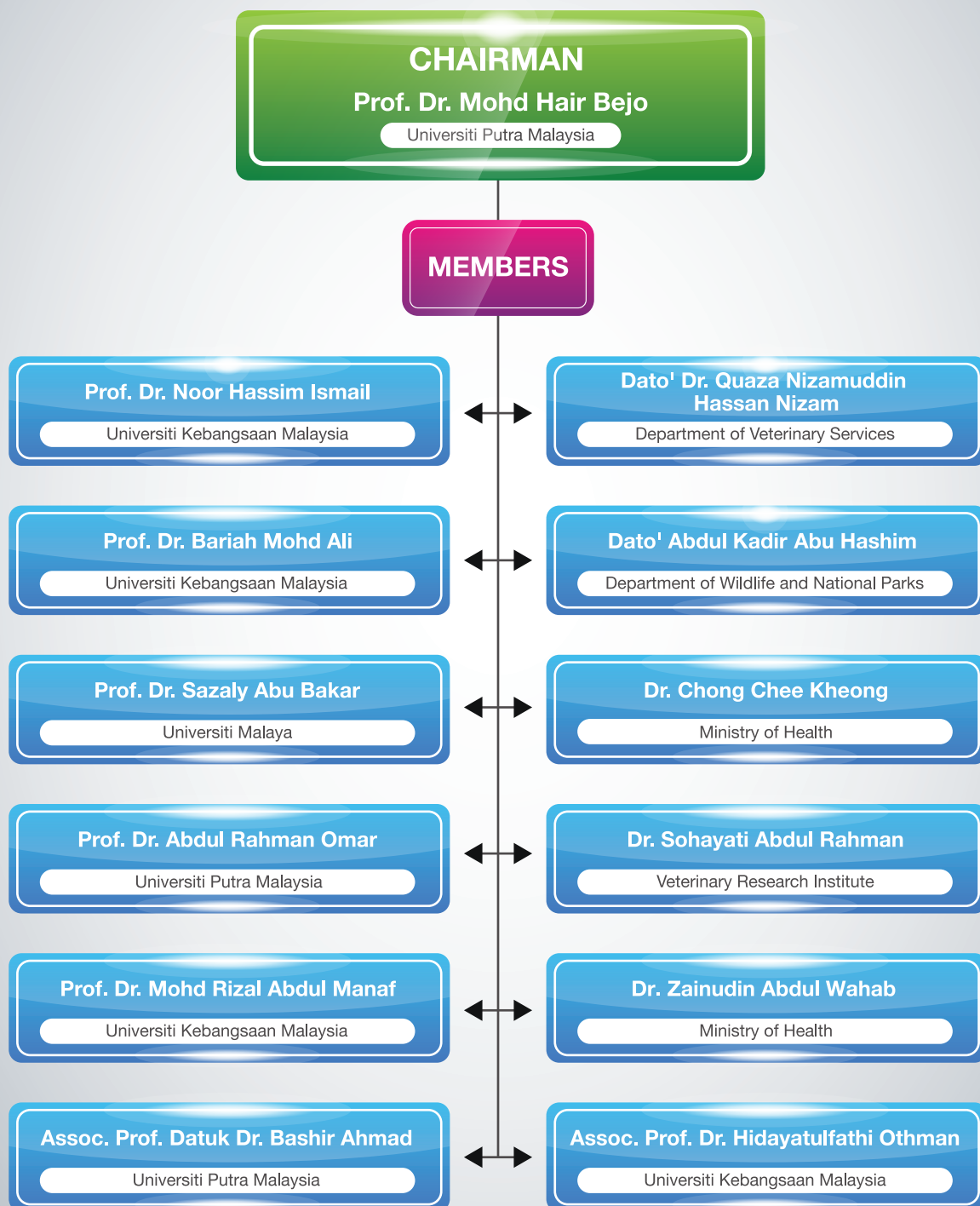
