





Invest in a year that invests back in you.

Second year students' practicum builds upon the first year with a greater emphasis on spiritual leadership and activating spiritual gifts. Each student will receive a time equivalent sheet that designates set time portions for each activity.

Track 2-Year 2 is the Practicum for the 2nd year students. The minimum requirement is 80 hours of non-Ministries of Compassion (MOC) practicum experience and 20 hours of MOC practicum experience per school year.

YEAR TWO TRACK 1&2 MINISTRIES OF COMPASSION

ADOPT-A-BLOCK

Students will learn first hand about Adopt-A-Block Inc., a nonprofit coalition of local businesses, churches, city government, police, and community services organizations serving those in need. Students gain direct experience learning how to develop, coordinate and implement and lead Adopt- A-Block programs.

A CAN CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE

Students are introduced to the broad range of services and felt needs of food insecure communities within their city and state. Students will learn how CCMAD has become a leader in food distribution, feeding over 65,000 individuals per month; students learn how to establish a CCMAD ministry in conjunction with local and state requirements, and the importance of leveraging church, retail, and distribution partners.

THE HIDING PLACE

Students will have the opportunity to work alongside program staff in support of women in crisis. The Hiding Place provides women with access to community resources, educational support, job and life skills training, employment resources, and parenting support.

NEHEMIAH HOUSE RE-ENTRY

Nehemiah Ministries is a men's re-entry program helping to break the cycle of recidivism. Established in 1991, Nehemiah House Inc. has aided thousands of homeless men, including veterans, to get back on their feet. Students participate in fundraising and development opportunities to help raise awareness.

MARTHA'S KITCHEN

Martha's Kitchen is a nonprofit that exists to provide our local communities with "Healthy Fast Food". Students have an opportunity serve within this ministry that provides meals to local nonprofits, community and students.




I have created a non-profit organization to start my home for women and children, which I expect to start in January 2025.



My wife and I graduated from the "Intensive Training School" in Kiev, Ukraine. From that we got a strong foundation in Christ, so that we could start a church in Madagascar.

In 1998, Bishop came to Madagascar to set me into ministry, and from that time the church grew step by step in number. In 2006, God through the mother church (Rock City Church of Baltimore), gave us a piece of land, and a metal building for a church building.

Today we have 33 churches. Four of them are in the capital Antananarivo, and God opened doors for us to impact the areas where the churches are located.

We give away food, clothes, and homes. We are working with mayors and a minister of agriculture and livestock of the actual government. Through all the years, we have dedicated several counties and cities for Christ.





This year marks our 30th anniversary convention where my wife Lady Rose Arthur, myself, and the entire Rock City Church International branches in Africa will be coming together at the Rock City Church headquarters, Accra Ghana in celebration of the faithfulness of God. Until my assignment here on earth is over, I'll keep gathering the saints of God till the return of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.


