TRIDUUM REFLECTION

Passion, Death and Resurrection in Christ!

Peace and Good in Christ!

May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Fesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. Galatians 6:14

Holy Week and Easter come late in 2025, so the beauty of spring is already "springing" at Little Portion Hermitage and Monastery. It seems a bit out of sync with what we are going through liturgically. But we have had a very tough winter, so it is a welcome relief as we move into this most holy week of our Christian liturgical year. It allows us to really focus on the meaning of this liturgical journey with Jesus.

Holy week began with Passion/Palm Sunday beginning with the triumph, full entry of Jesus into Jerusalem and concludes with the Passion, and crucifixion of Christ. It was a for taste of all that comes in the week ahead.

The Triduum is the holiest three days of Holy Week. It begins with the institution of the Lord's Supper,



the agony of Christ in the Garden of Gethsemani, and the betrayal of Jesus by Judas and the denial of Christ by all but one of the apostles on Maunday Thursday.

On Good Friday we continue the journey with the trial and crucifixion of Jesus. It is called "good" because He completes His mission then and bears the sins of all humanity on that cross to set us free from sin and death.

Holy Saturday is a profoundly silent day after Jesus is laid in the tomb. But He isn't silent. He is preaching to the all souls who have died and calling the holy ones to Himself.

And after sundown as the third day begins in the ancient calendar Jesus rises from the dead and leaves the tomb empty, only to be discovered by the women come to anointed His body after the Sabbath. This becomes the holiest day for Christians forever, the Lord's Day, the day of resurrection where all who believe in Him may rise from all sin, pain and sorrow and live forever in Christ.

This is what we celebrate every year to remind us of the essential core of our faith. We are all like the apostles who deny Him. But we can all be saved through His cross and resurrection if we simply turn to Him sincerely.

I pray we all have a good Holy Week this year.


The beginning of a vocation to our community starts the same way.

VOCATION and DISCERNMENT


The word vocation comes from the Latin word, vocare, which means "to call." Jesus calls and we answer. That is the way it has usually been from the beginning. (See Romans 10:14–15) But we must respond with discernment. The word for discernment is diakria in Greek, and means to rightly divide good and evil, or truth from error. So we must discern our vocation, our call from Christ. And that takes prayer and loving help from others to be done well.


