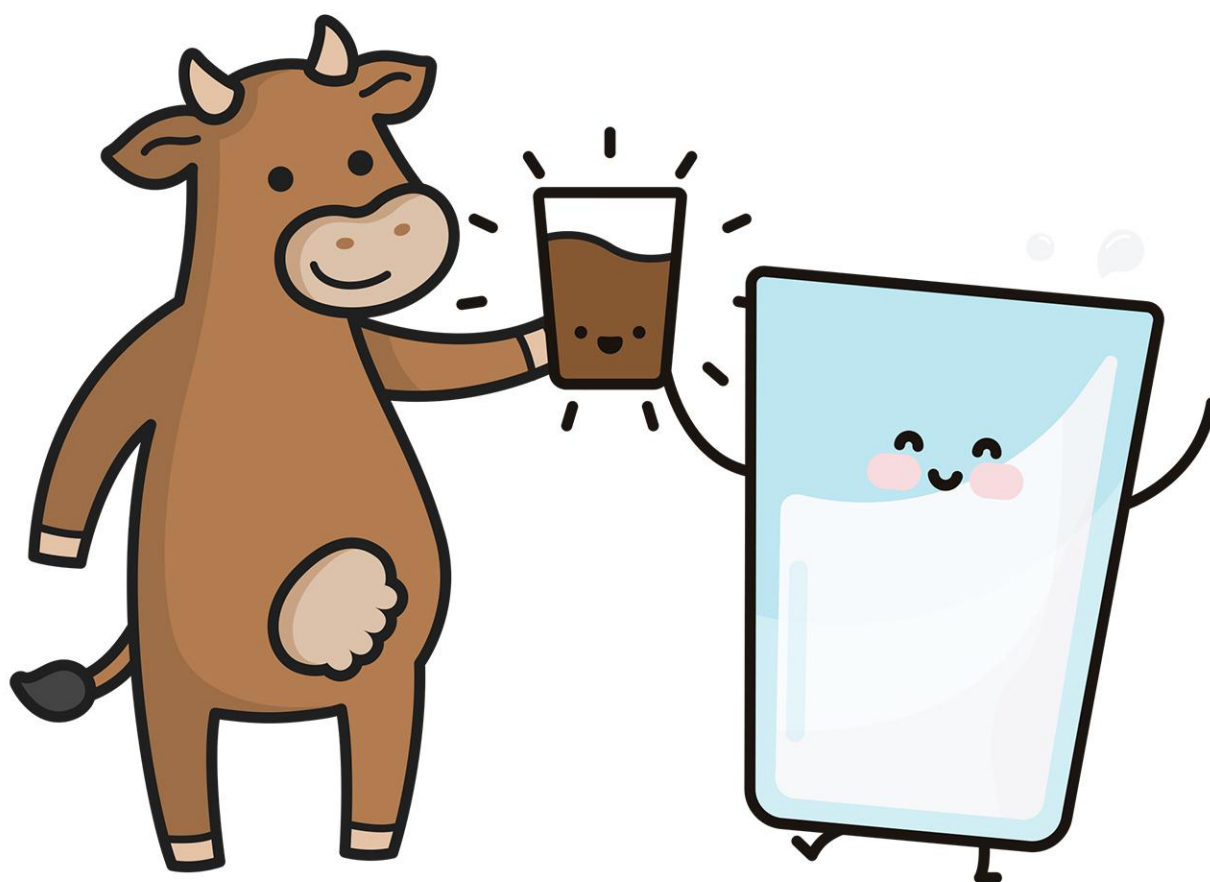

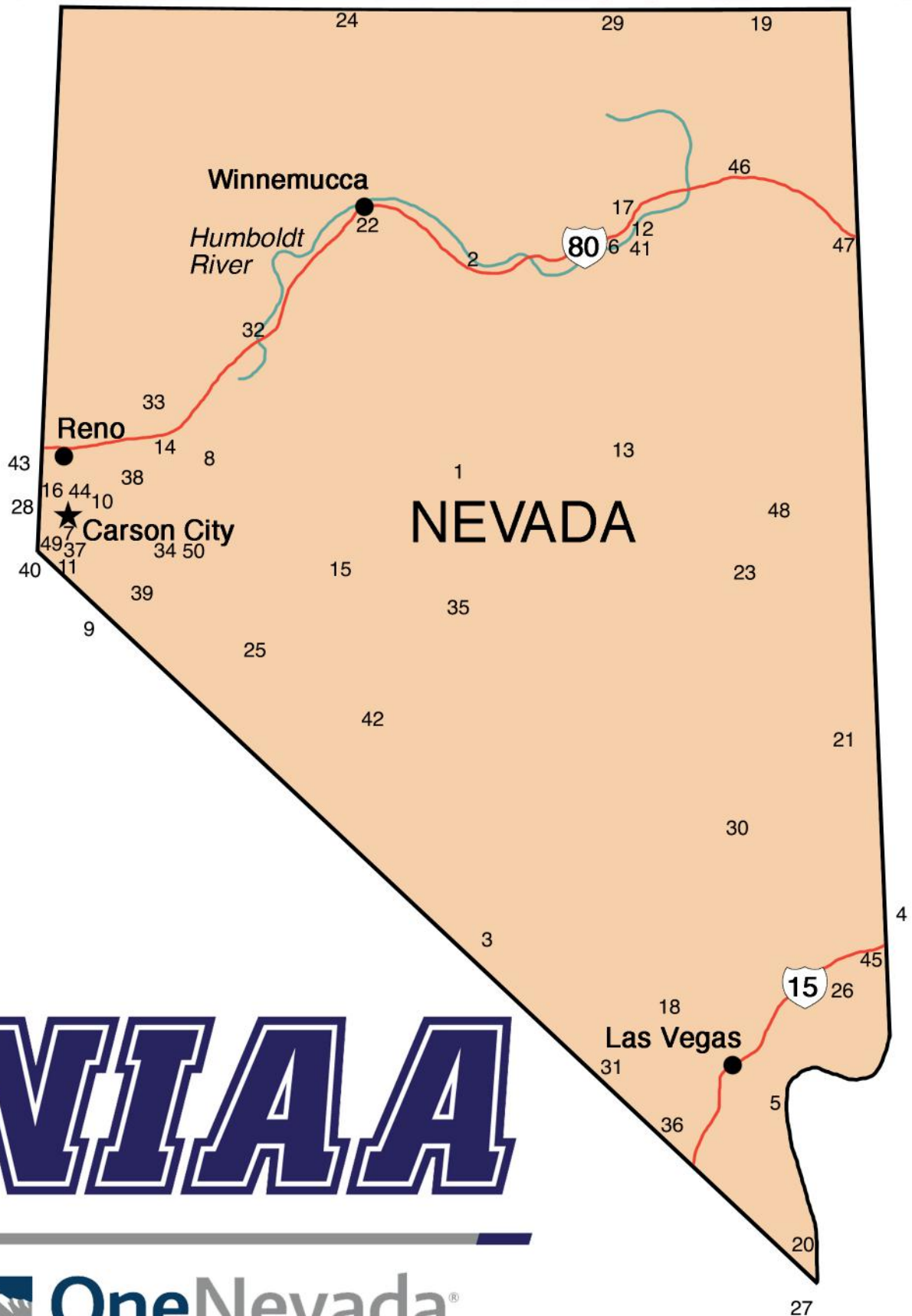

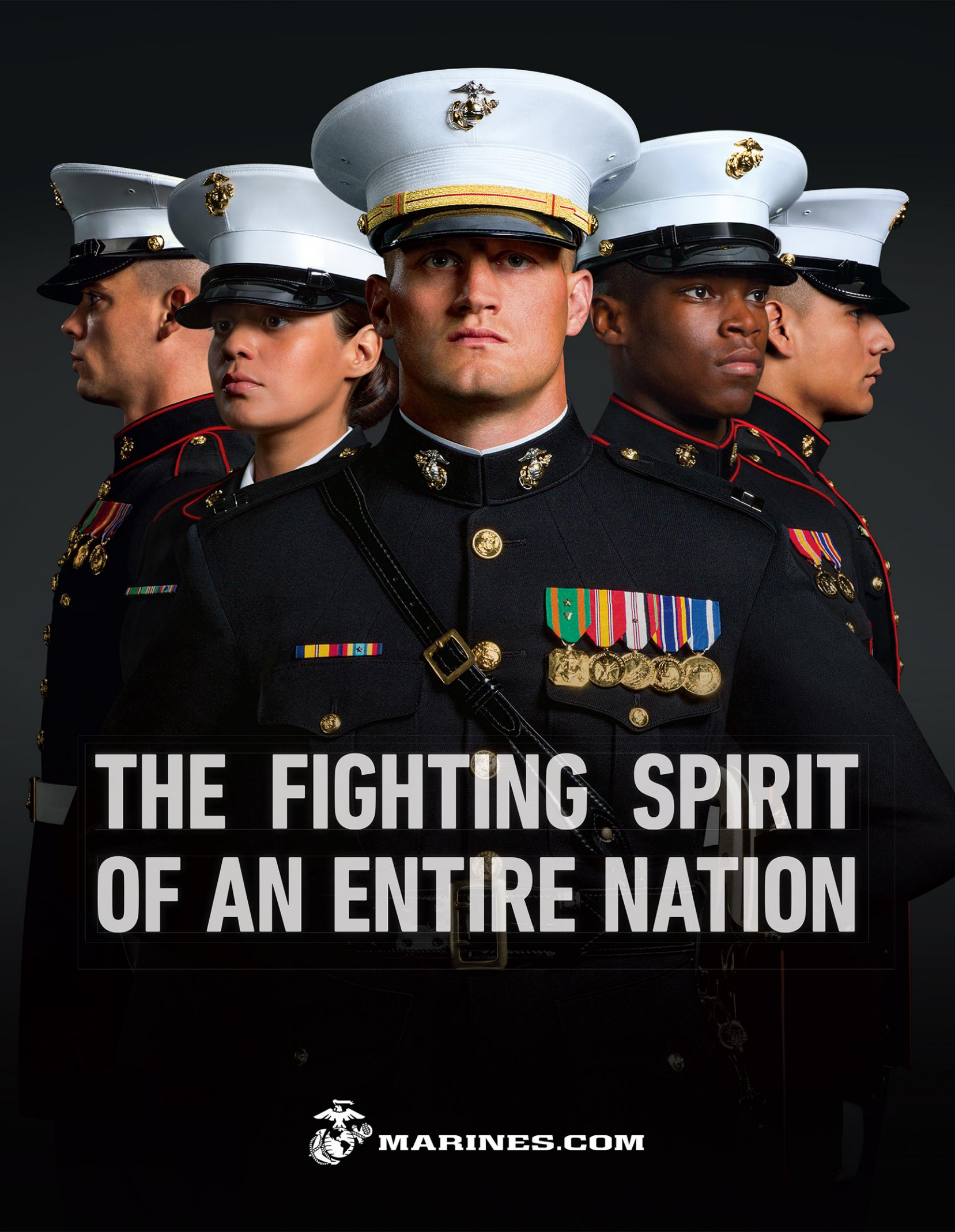

While we're pretty good at checking accounts, money movement, loans, and the like, we do know our limits. So, we'll leave the blocking and tackling to those who wear their courage on their sleeves.
