PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

We congratulate the Class of 2025 for their outstanding performance in the Higher School Certificate. Each student has demonstrated commendable academic achievement and resilience in pursuing their personal objectives.

As a comprehensive school, we take great pride in the seven students (4% of the cohort) who successfully completed their HSC without aiming for an ATAR. Instead, they have chosen to follow their passion in trades, further industry studies at an RTO, or direct employment. The variety of post-school pathways our students take is a testament to our success.

Around 60% of this cohort received early university offers from UAC. Despite these early offers, our students remained committed to their studies, striving to reach their full potential. As a result, many surpassed their expectations, opting for courses with higher cut-offs instead of their early offers. The wide range of their aspirations, the diversity of courses they are undertaking and their plans for work and travel underscore that traditional expectations never bound this cohort.

St Patrick's College consistently ranks among the top 150 schools in NSW, achieving the 67th position in the 2025 HSC School Ranking, an improvement from 89th in 2024. St Patrick's College is the 4th ranked Catholic school for boys in NSW and the 11th ranked Catholic school overall.

As a non-selective school in the EREA tradition, we are thrilled that 17% of our cohort achieved an ATAR above 95, 34% an ATAR above 90, and 58% an ATAR above 80. Our students achieved a median ATAR of 82, meaning 50% of the cohort achieved an ATAR of 82 or higher.

We extend special recognition to our Dux for 2025, Lucas Martin (99.35), and our Proxime Accessit, Christopher Costa (99.2), as well as our eight All-Round Achievers: Michael Atra, Christopher Costa, Awtel Haddad, Joshua Malone, Lucas Martin, Joseph Rigon, Dominic Short and Daniel Terrone. In total, we had 248 mentions in the Distinguished Achievers' List (Band 6 or E4), marking a considerable improvement from the previous year.

We also celebrate our Top Achievers in the State: Joseph Rigon, who ranked 10th in Business Studies, Nicholas Macher who ranked 6th in Industrial Technology and Ethan Aflak, who placed 3rd in Information and Digital Technology examination.

Our students have showcased a broad spectrum of skills and talents, with exceptional results across numerous subjects. We are proud of the many subjects in which 100% of candidates achieved a Band 5 or 6, E3 or E4: Drama, Economics, English Extension 1, Mathematics Extension 2, Music 1, Music 2, and Visual Arts. It was wonderful to be recognised by the Sydney Morning Herald as one of the top 20 schools for HSC Mathematics 1 and 2; in fact, we were ranked 17th, a remarkable feat for our comprehensive school.

These achievements are a testament to the unwavering dedication of our talented teachers, who are a credit to St Patrick's College. We also express our gratitude to the parents and guardians of the Class of 2025 for their partnership in their sons' education and their enduring support of the school.

We extend our best wishes to this remarkable and driven cohort and look forward to following their future endeavours. We present this publication as a record of our impressive HSC results for 2025.

FROM THE DIRECTOR OF CURRICULUM

As the recently appointed Director of Curriculum, I am proud to commend the graduating Class of 2025 and to congratulate them on their outstanding success in the Higher School Certificate (HSC). As the College's largest graduating HSC cohort, they have not only upheld, but further enhanced the strong academic results of recent cohorts, performing with distinction across a broad range of subjects. These results stand as a testament to the sustained hard work and commitment of our students, as well as the dedication and expertise of their teachers over many years, and all involved should take great pride in these achievements.

In total, one hundred and eighty-seven Year 12 students sat the HSC examinations across thirty-four courses, while twenty-one Year 11 students accelerated in HSC Mathematics Advanced 2 unit and one Year 11 student accelerated in Italian Continuers 2 unit. As Dr Lavorato has recognised, the Class of 2025 achieved an impressive 248 mentions on the Distinguished Achievers' List. This represents a 27% improvement on last year's already strong results and was driven by 48% of Year 12 students and an outstanding 90% of accelerating Year 11 Mathematics students achieving the highest band attainable in their respective subjects. There were many notable highlights and exceptional outcomes for the Class of 2025, including significant

improvements in Modern History, Mathematics Extension 2 and Drama. The following examples illustrate just some of the cohort's many accomplishments.

This year, eight students were recognised for their academic excellence across the breadth of their programs of study through inclusion in the State's All-Round Achievers' List, having achieved the highest band attainable in ten units or more. In addition, three students were named in the Top Achievers' List, having recorded one of the highest marks in the state for an individual subject. Special recognition must be given to Joseph Rigon, who was honoured as both an All-Rounder and a Top Achiever at State level. These outstanding top end results demonstrate that our programs of study continue to challenge students and foster excellence at the highest levels.

In 32 of the 34 courses undertaken (94%), the College examination average exceeded the State examination average. Courses with the greatest school-to-state variation included Legal Studies (11.67 marks above the state average), Physics (11.15 marks above), Business Studies (10.83 marks above), Economics (10.57 marks above), Modern History (9.94 marks above), Mathematics Advanced (9.83 marks above), Mathematics Extension 2 (7.78 marks above), Drama (7.46 marks above), Personal Development, Health and

Physical Education (7.32 marks above), and Music 1 (7.21 marks above). These results highlight not only the strength of our highest achieving students but also the depth and consistency of academic performance across a wide range of disciplines.

Additionally, there were twenty-four courses (71% of those sat) in which the proportion of students achieving a mark of 90% or above (Band 6 or E4) exceeded the State average. Among these, the courses with a cohort of 10 students or more that had the highest proportion of students achieving these results were Drama (60%), Mathematics Extension 1 (57%), Mathematics Advanced (56%), Economics (54%), and Visual Arts (44%). While these courses represent only a snapshot of our overall success, they further underscore the breadth and consistency of academic excellence across the College.

Moreover, in 97% of the courses sat by St Patrick's College students, the percentage of students achieving results in the two highest performance bands exceeded that of the State. Notably, there were eleven courses (33% of courses sat) in which the entire College cohort achieved results exclusively within the two highest performance bands. These courses included Italian Extension 1, Music 2, Mathematics Extension 2, English Extension 1, Drama, Economics, Visual Arts, Music 1, History Extension, Music Extension and Science Extension. While some, but not all, of these subjects had smaller cohorts, these results nonetheless reinforce the importance of student agency and the role it plays in motivating students to achieve their full potential within their chosen areas of interest.

Given that St Patrick's College is an academically non-selective, comprehensive boys' school, the 2025 HSC results are, once again, exceptional. St Patrick's College is a place where ordinary boys achieve extraordinary things through pursuing their passions. This publication serves as a lasting testament to the consistently strong academic performance of our senior students year after year in the Higher School Certificate, and I commend it to you.
