The Mansfield Philharmonic presents "The Soldier's Tale" by Igor Stravinsky.

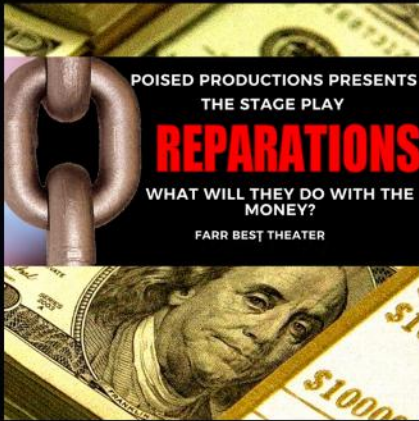

“the wedding singer”



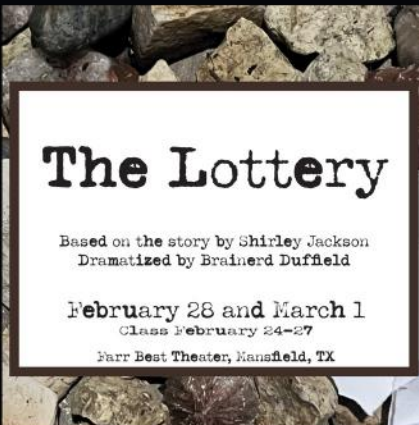
