

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

Sharing my all year long favorite cross cultural wisdom tool called the Thirteenth Lunar Month Four Rivers Exercise. I am called to share this time honored, cross-cultural divination practice the last full moon month in December into the first full moon in January. This "predictatory" thirteenth lunar month, a time that is open to us to work closely with our spiritual community (visible and invisible) during what is called the "Crack Between the Worlds" period.

As a review of this long time observed practice by many Indigenous Peoples and originally taught to me by Dr. Angeles Arrien, this time of the Crack between the Worlds can offer hints to what the next season of growth or life has to offer. It's a possible preview of our next season/cycle/year of growth, if we can commit to daily review and journal the activities we experienced in the four rivers listed below. Cross culturally, all healing begins with our "waters." The most potent time of the year, the twilight month of the year.

THE FOUR RIVERS OF LIFE ARE:

THE RIVER OF CHALLENGE WEST AUTHENTICITY

THE RIVER OF LOVE SOUTH RELATIONSHIPS

THE RIVER OF INSPIRATION NORTH INTEGRITY

THE RIVER OF MAGIC AND WONDER SAST RIGHT WILL/RIGHT ACTION

One is petitioned to stay in the placement of the witness/observer with a neutral mind and start interpreting their various river's activity-- one's emotions, one's health, one's relations with self and others. Keeping a journal, literally entering the events of our days and nights under the representative river helps keep us honest at the end of the 13th month when we review our lists.


It has been said that since humankind was evicted from the Garden for consuming from the Tree of Knowledge, they were given an assignment to follow, learn, become one with each of the four rivers. Truly learning, mending, enhancing awareness...if a being truly engaged in the "learning of the rivers" in time they will be able to return to the origins of the waters, the Garden, the source.

Once in the center they will stand true, compassionate but detached. In the center one uses their life's journey through the rivers – physical, mental, emotional and spiritual to serve as a wisdom keeper, a peacemaker, a bridge, one with the Great Spirit.... The center is often referred to as the Spirit column, the great Tree of Life, and oneness with the creator and the mystery.

Sleeping Women Wake!

It was 1997. My youngest daughter, Carolyn, has just passed. Her sisters and I were refurbishing a home intended for her recovery from a devastating car accident. Instead, she had left her body. We continued with plans to upgrade a home we had named, Carolyn's Place

By the second day, all kitchen cabinet doors were spread out on the deck, sanded and freshly painted. Before Carolyn's accident, I had spent three years traveling to teach and do personal healing sessions. For the 2 years after the accident, I had been with Carolyn 24/7, discovering the energy components leading to this disaster while working to reverse her traumatic brain injury. I had learned to listen to guidance. Or, I thought I had.

That night, cabinets beautifully painted and drying on the deck, a thought came: "Move the doors inside." It was a soft thought. I looked at the sky, no clouds. July in Washington state,

no chance of rain. I countered with, "It would take a lot of effort to cover floor space for all those doors. No rain. Warm weather. I'll just pass on that idea." I went to bed. In the morning, I saw why bringing in the freshly painted doors would have been the better idea.

A very strong morning dew! The water had gathered and pooled on every cabinet door. By diluting the paint, every one had to be dried and repainted.

The lesson I learned? You may not know why you had a quiet, soft suggestion unless you ignore it.

Have you been taught how unseen voices speak to you? Or taught to find the 'language' of your thoughts, your feelings, and your inner knowing?

These gifts of Female energy sensitivity have been disregarded, discounted, and labeled as an indication of non-health. Your superpowers.

Did you know that? Do you know Why?

It has everything to do with Sophia. And so, who is she?

In 2006, I first heard about Sophia. That is what I want to share with you.

My spiritual quest had unfolded from questions I asked when I saw limits or pains in my clients' lives. Their answers from those asking for the cause and solution showed me how much humanity did not know. Their guidance opened my life path.

The answer came: "Those a male body suit come to nurture, support, and encourage "All Good." That was a shock. Males, the nurturers? All Good? Then I thought of the master teacher, Christ. He, in a male body suit reminding of heart-nurturing Actions.

They continued, "The soul coming into a female body comes prepared to evaluate needs for earth living, to create a design for the family or village, to set policies for the design, and to birth the village. She determines where our ship is going."

rooted in the deeply conservative landscape of Oregon where, until the 1960s, the Ku Klux Klan had a stronghold (and still remains today). My early years were a fight for survival, navigating abuse, neglect, and the rigid constraints of religious indoctrination. My mother was a member of the John Birch Society.

In my world, faith was everything. My childhood was spent immersed in scripture studying the Bible alongside Strong's Concordance, playing Bible trivia, memorizing verses, and attending church, three times a week.

As an eager student, I couldn't help but notice the gaps, the unanswered questions no one wanted to address, remains. Who were the mysterious "sons of God" who took wives from the daughters of men, producing mighty offspring? What about the Nephilim, the giants who walked the earth? Who was Melchizedek?

And what of Wisdom described as a woman with companions named Prudence and Prophecy? Was she truly God's 'consort' (what does that mean?), and why did she love humankind so deeply?

Even the story of Cain puzzled me. If Adam and Eve's family were the first humans, who were the people in the Land of Nod, the artists, musicians, and builders of culture? These questions gnawed at me, demanding answers beyond what my church was willing to provide.

With the rise of the internet, I found a treasure trove of ancient texts on earlychristianwritings.com — the Apocrypha, the Dead Sea Scrolls, and the Nag Hammadi texts. I dug into how the New Testament was assembled, which writings were omitted, and why. I discovered the tension between those who complied with governmental authority and those who resisted, often paying with their lives.

That was when 7 realized 7 had to stop looking outward for truth.

If the Kingdom of God is within, then my journey had to be inward.





The Fourney Within

My search for answers put me at odds with my upbringing, and eventually, my inner turmoil manifested physically. Doctors labeled it fibromyalgia, but I sensed something deeper. Through breathwork and meditation, I discovered that my pain carried messages—each sensation a lesson, a whisper of truth waiting to be understood. So I listened. For up to three hours a day, I tuned in, surrendering to the process of healing.

As my practice deepened, I experienced visions, encounters with angelic guides, and profound moments of knowing. I traveled through wormholes to distant planets, heard voices filled with wisdom, and saw glimpses of realities beyond this one. But amidst the awe, I had to learn discernment —how to distinguish between divine messages and deceptive influences.

My studies expanded beyond traditional religious texts. Elizabeth Clare Prophet and Saint Germain taught me alchemy. Barbara Marciniak, Barbara Hand Clow, and Barbara Marx Hubbard—"the Barbaras," as I fondly called them—offered new perspectives that shaped my journey.

Through these experiences, I realized something crucial: I was in control of my own spiritual evolution. I learned to navigate mystical experiences while staying anchored in my body. My body is my temple, and I set a sacred rule—I would only allow energies to merge with me if I *knew* and trusted them completely. I required every guide or being to reveal their full intention before I allowed any connection. Those who sought harm were immediately rejected. Those aligned with my highest good became a part of me, and in turn, I became them.

I came to *know*—not just in theory, but in deep, undeniable truth—who I am, where I have been, and where I am meant to go. I am a multidimensional, eternal being, and my purpose is unfolding with every step I take.





The Fourney to Be Free

In 2010, my spiritual awakening became a matter of life and death. Forces beyond my understanding—both seen and unseen—sought to take my life force for their own purposes. Those who opposed my mission knew that eliminating me would grant them immense power in the darker realms. The threat was real, and I had to act quickly.

My inner guidance became my survival tool. Go here now. Leave this place. Move before it's too late. The message was clear: I had to abandon everything—my 31 year marriage, my beloved spiritual community, my home where I hosted sacred ceremonies under the full moon. I obeyed.

Divine forces swept me into a new reality—a new home, new relationships, new work, and a renewed sense of being. It took two years of healing and realignment before my next chapter was revealed.

One fateful day, I collapsed onto the floor, overtaken by an overwhelming force. It felt as if I were being pulled into a black hole, my energy drained beyond resistance. I surrendered, believing this was the end.

I was no longer in darkness but standing mid-air in a radiant, white light. My very being began to transform. I saw the virus of mind control and, in that moment, became the antidote. "It has been the Joy of my Life to do this work with GGCN.



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


More About The Path


Each seed represents a living legacy, carrying the wisdom of our ancestors and holding the potential for a sustainable future. The Path exists to protect these seeds, teach their importance, and build resilience in our communities.



The Importance of Seed Banks for Our Future

- TO preserve crop diversity, Seed banks protect and save plant genetic diversity, which is the most crucial reason for the protection of seeds. Just as human beings and animals are adapted to different conditions for survival, so are our crops. Different types of the same species exist due to this adaptive nature. Therefore, it is of critical necessity that such diversity is preserved
- Adaptation to changes in climate. Climate change is requiring adjustments to agricultural practices and may mean geographical shifts of the areas where specific crops can be grown. A diversity of crop seed kept available in seedbanks can allow the farmers to better adapt to these changes.
- Assurance that seeds continue to be available after natural or man-made disasters. Natural disasters, war, and other calamities cause crop losses and can also destroy seed supplies. Seed banks, along with the help of professional seed growers, can help farmers recover and plant again.
- Providing seed genetic material for scientists and plant
- breeders. Seeds kept in modern seed banks contain a treasure trove of useful genes that plant breeders can use for developing improved varieties of our major food crops, improving resistance to current and emerging plant diseases, insects, and environmental stresses.
 - Ensuring food sovereignty for future generations.
- Many older varieties of crops are no longer being grown due to the standardization of commercial crop

seed and farming practices. Larger seed companies are buying out smaller ones, and are removing many old varieties from circulation, in favor of more profitable strains. Seed banks that preserve the older traditional varieties allow us to continue to choose the seed we can grow to produce our food, the supply.



Why do we need to preserve seeds?

"Simply put, we need to preserve the seeds, as they are a living library. These crops were developed over centuries and millennia by farmers and their stories are woven into the cultural memory of the people that have grown them. Seeds that have been adapted for the different soils and climates of an area, with all their qualities and characteristics, are the result of generations of meticulous care and dedication. If we keep these seeds alive, we are keeping our heritage alive. The lineages of these seeds have a 'soul' in a sense, intimate with the peoples that have planted them. In our current time, modern technology has gone beyond traditional plant breeding into artificial genetic modification, primarily for a profit and control motive, taking out the 'soul' of the seeds. Seed saving and preservation is our defense against this and provides a bridge for us to cross through these challenging times."

My healing path began with an awakening to my Indigenous roots. I was the third of four daughters, raised in a sea of petticoats and the rhythms of Southern Baptist life in Louisiana—church three times a week, choir practice, youth group, and a strong sense of what it meant to be a "good Christian."

But even as a child, I saw through things others didn't. I often left church with more questions than answers, wondering: What does it mean to be good? And where is the deeper truth of God?

Our mother played piano and organ, her voice opening hearts with every solo. We were blessed to have two grandmothers, a great-grandmother, and a grandfather in our lives. My father's mother, Hatty, used to tell us, "You are Choctaw royalty." My parents barely responded, and the subject was quietly buried. But something in me held on.

As a child, I felt my Indigenous soul so deeply I believed I would one day turn red. I cried when I realized that wouldn't happen. How will my people recognize me in this white skin?

Recently, an African-American student told me, "Kelley, you're the only white woman I've met who was sad not to be born dark."

We laughed. And I remembered a Lakota Eagle Dancer I once met. He said, "My mother told me our people would return in white skin. I want your book."

I blinked—What book?

"The one you're going to write. About the truth," he replied.

Now, 30 years later, I'm writing it.

At age four, after a near-death experience, my Indigenous soul fully awakened. The trauma cracked me open, and my grandmother's voice took root in my heart until it blossomed in my thirties. That's when my ancestors came—first a woman who spoke softly, then a Cherokee medicine man who called me home.

"You are Cherokee," he said. "We are Bird Clan. I waited five generations for someone who could hear me."

That was the beginning of everything.

"Your grandmother was right. I married a
Choctaw princess. Your family forgot—but
now it's time to remember."

From then on, every day became a

classroom with my ancestors.

The story I'm about to share is one thread in a vast tapestry of family stories—each holding medicine for our future. One night, I had a vivid dream. My grandparents often visited in dreams, but this one was heavy. It took me back to colonial times, showing a once-loving father twisted by alcohol into cruelty. I saw where the wound of male rage began in our family line, and I knew these were my people.

My parents weren't drinkers. My mother was strictly sober, and though my father occasionally had a beer, it sparked her disapproval, especially on Sundays. Still, there was something deeper: a quiet pain that wanted to be seen. There was a sense of strength in the women of our family, but I came to understand that some of it was shaped by pain and a lack of trust in men. The next day, a woman recently returned from the Himalayas crossed my path. Grandfather whispered, *Go see her*. So I did. Sitting in the waiting room, he came again: *Granddaughter, today you'll learn about Ancestral Thread Healing*.

When I entered, I turned to her and said, "We're going to be working with my ancestors today." She smiled gently. "I know. "From the moment we began, my Temple of Light formed around us. She witnessed me with soul-level presence, this was instant confirmation. The ancestors came, seven generations back, and seven forward, as angels spoke softly to me of the code of healing bloodline threads. They explained what a generation was and how it went beyond one person. First those behind me came in, then those yet to come, including the unborn. The baby souls arrived like tiny spheres of light. We gasped. "Awe," we whispered. And we smiled.

The women gathered in the center. The men formed a circle around them. Angels and guides arrived, casting light through everyone present. The light moved through our lineages, lifting old hatred and replacing it with peace, forgiveness, and grace. A deep calm settled in my heart, for the first time in this life.

But trust wasn't easy for me. Childhood trauma had left its mark. I walked away wondering: Was it real? Did my family really receive this healing? The next day, I called my sisters. All of us, including our mother, had come down with lower-body infections. It felt connected. I meditated and asked Spirit: "Do people usually have physical reactions to ancestral healing"? Spirit replied, "No"

Then I was guided to call my
Auntie, she had been fasting for
three days preparing for
something when I called. We
shared stories and the pieces
fell into place. She did a new
form of healing for our family
and we were all well the next
day. Then what was this all
about?

Spirit said, Your aunt needed practice and you needed proof that it was real.



I laughed. Of course. That was true. Then my mother, who had always felt a little distant, sent me a letter: "Kelley, I feel like God wants me to tell you this. That healing you did on the family, I felt it. It changed me. I don't think I'll ever be the same, in the best way. I'm grateful for this. We are better because of it. This felt powerful. I wanted you to know".

At that moment, I could feel Grandmother and Grandfather smiling behind me. They had been so patient. My gratitude is eternal. Now, as an elder, I hope to share their teachings far and wide.





Becoming an Ancestral Thread Healer

Myancestorstaughtme: *Onceyouknow, you're responsible*. Knowledge becomes wisdom through practice.

As my path deepened, they revealed the *Cosmology of Wholeness*, what it means to be fully human. Integrating Ancestral Thread Healing became foundational. By clearing inherited patterns *before* deep inner child work, my clients began to reach entirely new levels of healing.

Patterns became maps. I could see where wounds lived in the body, understand them across time, and guide people more skillfully. I was taught three levels of Ancestral Healing, and over time, my gifts expanded.

With the voices of my native elders ringing in my ears.

We need to heal seven generations

I worked for 14 years with the "seven and seven," a medicine code given to me in that first ceremony. As my light grew, so did my capacity to hold more generations within the Temple of Light. The Divine Mother became a profound teacher, awakening the feminine aspect of Source within me. She told me:

This work is healing the origin of separation.

A Mother of Souls, she showed me how each healing ripples across billions of generations.

Layer by layer, the work expanded into Elemental and Celestial Dragon fields, the Akashic and quantum realms, and New Earth teachings. The healing deepened for all of us.

Though my work remained mostly outside the mainstream, it was felt. Medicine people I'd never met began to send others my way. They knew. The Temple of Light became a chamber of self-healing, built around each soul who found their way to this inner path of healing. I teach through empowerment and grounded practices. To be whole is to land fully in your foundation, to meet your inner council, your archetypes, and walk the path of heart-based return.





We are all here, alive during Mother Earth's ascension. This is not for the faint of heart. It requires courage. It calls us to transcend our woundedness as a collective humanity.

I invite you: include your ancestors in your healing.

May you know greater peace by doing so. Reach back seven generations, and forward seven more, in your prayers and intentions.

Heafing from the Inside Out: The Sacred Work of Emotional Debridement

There's a term used in wound care: debridement. It refers to the careful removal of damaged tissue so that a wound can heal cleanly, from the inside out. It's the opposite of letting the surface seal over too soon. When we rush the closure, we risk trapping infection beneath the skin, leaving thick, raised scars and often a hidden ache that lingers. But when the wound is carefully opened, cleaned, and supported from its deepest layer, healing can occur in the most natural and seamless way.

As a child, I didn't understand this. I remember the impatience, picking at scabs, hoping to reveal new skin before it was ready. I didn't know that a wound's method of healing mattered. It could affect how I felt in that area for years to come. But the body holds wisdom.


And so does the heart.

Because this, I've come to realize, is exactly how our emotional and spiritual healing works too.

We live in a culture that worships strength, speed, and surface appearances. We are told to get over it, move on, stay positive, keep smiling. And so we soldier on, wearing our pain like invisible armor. But beneath the polished surface, many of us are still wounded. Still raw. Still carrying the silent ache of things that were never given the time or space to heal properly.



The emotional equivalent of a scab is the brave face we put on. The daily functioning. The story we tell ourselves that "It wasn't that bad" or "Everyone has something." But deep down the wound is still alive. Still unresolved. And over time, it becomes part of the lens through which we see the world. It shapes our relationships, our sense of self, even out capacity to love.



When I finally turned inward and allowed myself to revisit a long-buried wound, one I had sealed off in order to survive. I had to go gently, but I had to go doop. It was not a tidy process. There were tears. There was rage. There was grief I didn't know I still carried. But as I worked through the layers, something miraculous began to happen: I began to feel lightness where there had been heaviness. I began to feel clear where I had been confused. I began to feel whole.

This is what I now call emotional debridement: the sacred, courageous act of returning to the root of our pain, not to relive it, but to truly release it.

To let the wound breathe.

To cleanse it with love.

To allow healing to rise naturally from the inside, where it matters most.



And it matters profoundly when we speak of the mother wound, a primal wound, often unspoken, that lives in so many of us. It may stem from absence, neglect, abandonment, over-control, unmet needs, or generations of silence and sacrifice. It is rarely one person's fault. It is a wound passed through lineages, shaped by societal constraints, histories of colonization, patriarchy, and the enforced disconnection of women from their own wisdom.

Healing the nother wound is not about blame. It is about liberation.

It is about stepping outside of the original pain and choosing not to carry it forward. It is about facing the places in us that ache, not to shame ourselves—or our mothers but to break the cycle. To create a new foundation of care, sovereignty, and truth.

Webecome the turning point in the story. This is the invitation for us now, as women, as elders, as nurturers, as leaders. To tend our emotional wounds with the same sacred respect a healer gives to the skin. To take the time. To sit with the pain. To unlearn the habit of rushing past it.


Let us normalize the slow, sacred work of real healing. Let us debride our wounds gently, with truth and tenderness. Let us make it safe again to feel.

The Time Is Now: A Grandmother's Call to Reclaim Wisdom, Love, and the Future

We are living in a time of great social evolution torevolution. A time when the voices of guidance are
needed —The wisdom distilled in a grandmothers heart is

We, the Grand Mothers are remembering who we are, reclaiming our instinctual wisdom, and rising into global leadership rooted in wisdom, insight, experience, love, energy, truth, and a fierce devotion to life, wellbeing and a future here on our beautiful planet Earth.

My own journey has been long and textured. I've lived across continents, raised three extraordinary daughters through messy, unstructured years of motherhood, battled with addiction, failed at three marriages, and endured the raw cost of living out of alignment with myself. And yet, even in my lowest moments, the pulse of love remained steady. It was always there. It saved me.

And it continues to lead me.

The pandemic years became a crucible of awakening. I turned inward—and backward—to research my roots. Through familysearch.org, I discovered the vast lineage of my Tongan and Irish ancestry, stretching back centuries. I reconnected with family, in Tonga I stood on the shores of Vava'u where my grandmother was born, and felt the sacredness of home pulsing through the island. I also reawakened the Irish lines of my greatgrandfather and uncovered stories long buried—stories of resilience, brilliance, and devotion, and endurance.

Dreams became messengers. I received a call from a dear family friend Charles Collins, from his home in St Juste Cornwall. My Father appeared to him in a dream with a message for me. It was that I was to embrace change until I resonated with my happiness.

This was an extraordinary request, but one I was very grateful for. The opportunity was obviously a gift I wasn't expecting, but was so grateful to receive...

I started to change my life, and the advice and dreams keep coming from various courses of my family.

My late mother appeared in them, as did my grandmothers, offering guidance, clarity, and sometimes, fierce instruction. Many messages rang clear, in particular from my Grandmother, "Grab the world by the throat and shake it."

That was the moment I knew. I couldn't keep quiet anymore.

I had always been seeking meaning, truth, and reason at heart. In my youth, I led discussion groups at school, questioned the system, and rejected conformity. I saw through the facade of domination and materialism. Now, the rebellion had matured—it had become a return. A return to essence. A remembering that we, the women, must clean up ourselves first if we are to help heal the planet.

In 2023, I discovered a Facebook platform of grandmothers. I reached out and connected with Suzanne Lewis. We shared a vision: a truly global network, not just American-centered. She welcomed me warmly and asked me to become an admin. That was the first step up, and in.

I joined the Global Grandmothers Council Network Forum, and within three months, we grew from 1,000 to 34,000 members. One night, a dream woke me and instructed me to open YouTube. There, I found Mayana, glowing with insight, speaking on children, divine connection, and self-worth. Spirit confirmed: this was why I'd been led to open the page.

I reached out to Mayana, and she said yes. She joined us. She and Suzanne had known each other through previous projects, another divine reunion. Together, we led the group through global Zoom gatherings that reached 54,000 members across 46 countries.

Eventually, I stepped back to tend to my inner world again. But the Grandmothers never left my heart. And now, I return as Outreach Ambassador, with a deepened sense of purpose and vision.

My work now is to travel on behalf of this movement, to share the Gifting Meridian Healing from the Global Wellness Academy, and co-create workshops, retreats, and gatherings that will heal, uplift, and unite. We will bring women together, in spirit, in wisdom, in action.

This movement is in our time as we welcome the new generational transformation and overthrow the past, every grandmother throwing off her shackles, grandmother, mother, daughter, sister who hears the call. To render peace, well-being, community and vision. Whether you are experienced or just awakening, whether you are weary or inspired, we welcome you.

Join us.

Bring your voice.

Bring your wounds and your wisdom.

Bring your courage and your joy.

Together, we are creating something luminous:

A new society rooted in truth, love, energy, and deep feminine wisdom.



For in truth, I would not be who I am today - a writer, activist, organizer, then gardener, herbalist, and natural perfumer (and mother/ grandmother too!) if it wasn't for my rather feral childhood, and a father who spent so much time in the woods it was a family joke that he had a mistress out there!



The taught me that love is the most powerful heafer, and that God, rather than a stern man in the sky like the nuns taught, was love.

She was fascinated with Edgar Cayce and reincarnation and we'd spend hours talking about spirit, Love, and life after death.

The taught me that prayer isn't about being grateful.

I was very fortunate to have Nanny in my life. She gave me a firm foundation in the truth of Love, God, Prayer, Gratitude . . .

I was an only child for the first seven years of my life, then my sister, MaryJean, was born in 1959. In the mid-1970s, I met Peter, who would be the father of my three sons, and we moved from NH to Central Vermont, as part of the "back to the land movement". We had chickens, turkeys, geese, and even a cow for a short period of time. Our first two boys, Jason and Ethan, were born at home. A tiny, ramshackle "cabin" that was all we could afford.

In 1981, Peter's family purchased a farmhouse in Worcester, VT, and we moved into it while I was pregnant with Colin, our third (and last) son. That same year, my sister was in a tragic car accident, suffered a severe brain injury, and lay in a coma for eight weeks, and my mother, who had been diagnosed with gall bladder cancer, died while MaryJean was still in the coma. Colin was born the day after MaryJean went to the rehabilitation hospital. 1981 was a painful and also seminal year for me.

I learned what it feels like to trust my deep inner knowing even when (especially when!) it is counter to what the professionals say. I'm currently writing a memoir, some of which is being shared on my Substack, that tells this story as part of the journey of my life.



After Colin was born, Peter and his father, Richie Lowry started the first newsletter for Social Investors, GOOD MONEY, out of the house in Worcester. I was encouraged to participate and created Catalyst, a newsletter focusing on "investing in social change." My work resonated, and I was invited to speak on panels and teach workshops on alternative economics with a focus on new models and structures offering grassroots, community-based options to the status quo.

GOOD MONEY was about avoiding, for example, corporations doing business in South Africa or with nuclear weapons or energy, while directing investment money towards publicly traded companies that were "better". That was not enough for me!

Right from the beginning, I integrated Earth with economics, and I was the first person to do so in a public way. I was also the first person in the US to use the term "Gaian Economics". Even "Ecological economics" was unheard of back then. It was an exciting time! I met and worked with many brilliant, creative people who respected me despite the lack of letters after my name.


I was creating a whole new framework and perspective for economics!

In 1986, I met David Albert, the founder of New Society Publishers, at a bioregional gathering on the shores of Lake Michigan. These magical gatherings took place in different bioregions every other year.

My work in Gaian Economics became an important part of the bioregional movement. One afternoon, David came to me and said, "we're going to publish your book". "What book?" I asked. "The book you're going to write for us," he replied. And so it came to be!

That book, Economics as if the Earth Really Mattered, 1988, was one of "the first full-length treatments of how individuals could have an impact on global ecology through impact investing and social enterprise. This was followed by a later book, Invested in the Common Good (1995) that included many case studies of the potential effectiveness of these approaches."

(From New Society Publisher's website in its history section). I dedicated both books, "To Daddy, Who Understands", and both had forewords by Thomas Berry.



After Economics as if . . . was published, my work really took off. I keynoted conferences, spoke on panels, and taught workshops. My marriage, however, did not survive. Peter and I divorced (it was hard, messy, painful). Catalyst was separated legally from GOOD MONEY, and papers were filed with the IRS to incorporate Catalyst as a 501 c 3. We rented an office on Main Street in Montpelier to work out of, with an extensive resource room, and many projects, including conferences and events, a community currency, a national coalition to stop clearcutting of old-growth forests, All-Species, corporate research, and so much more! And, of course, continued publishing the newsletter, Catalyst: Creating an Economy for the Living Earth.

In 1996, Daddy had a stroke and shortly after, had to move to a nursing home. Since MaryJean could not live alone, Colin and I moved to Maine (his brothers were already on their own), to live with and care for my sister. I published a journal called <u>Gaian Voices</u> for nine years, and also started a large, magical garden with over 60 different herbs, as well as flowers and some veggies. After learning to make herbal skin care goodies and medicine cabinet staples, <u>Gaia's Garden Herbals</u> was created to sell them. I became fascinated with natural perfumery and shifted towards creating my own blends in 2012.



Then, in 2013, Jason, my oldest, a month after he turned 36, died of an opioid overdose, leaving two young sons, Nick and Sylas. His struggle with addiction had been an on and off again affair for a while, but the last year of his life was especially hard on all of us. Jason was the best man, father, son. I know this may sound strange given how he died, but it's the truth. I did not want to survive. The pain was so intense it felt like my limbs were being torn from my body. I remember the summer evening a couple of weeks after his death when I went to the garden and leaned against the potting bench he had built for me, and keened. The sounds that came out of me were unrecognizable. Karen, an elder woman who lived in her trailer on our land for a few years, came out and stood, witnessing. After I was done, and turned to walk back into the house, she asked,

"Ne you okay" ! replied,
"O. But will be.

It took almost 3 years (and lots of ice cream and weight gain) before I felt like I was going to live. And then I stopped eating ice cream, lost the weight (most of it anyway), and...

As luck or grace would have it, a new friend came knocking on my door who knew of my activist history. She pulled me, kicking and screaming, to a meeting at her house to discuss how to stop Nestle from building a water bottling plant in our town. I was not ready. I resisted. I felt weak, like I had

lost my voice. But . . . I knew I had skills that were needed. And Earth, right?



Jason's death, like my sister's accident and recovery, was another seminal time in my life. I learned about grief. The pain of it and the gifts it brings. And I also learned firsthand that there is WAY more to life than meets the eye. In fact, Jason, his spirit, is who guided me through. I miss his hugs, his voice, his sparkling eyes, and his crooked smile. But his heart and his spirit are strong and always here when I need them.

In 2018, MaryJean and I sold the house in Maine and moved to NY. Almost three years ago, we found a nice senior community where MaryJean has her apartment with her kitty, Dash, and the active social life she craves (but that I don't). For the first time since before the boys were born, I am on my own!

No matter what form my work has taken, Earth has always been my first love and focus. I knew from an early age that I was born with a very specific purpose: "Listen to Earth, write what she tells me, and share it with others". It would take

different forms, but the "bottom line" is Earth.

I have never questioned the reality that Earth is a living being, and that humans have the ability, the responsibility, to be active participants WITH Earth. We are, in fact, living within the living body of Earth, like our cells live within our bodies. I insisted in integrating this reality into all my projects, books, articles, and presentations.

In the 1980s and 1990s, my message was "We need to fall in love with Earth like we love our friends, our lovers, our families". Because when we love someone, we don't deliberately set out to cause them harm. And if we blow it, and we're humans, so we do blow it sometimes, we make amends and try to do better in the future. Guided by the love in our hearts, we will know what to do and when to do it. I would also share that each one of us was born with gifts, and our purpose in this life is to find them and share them with others. We are living in frightening, concerning times. Yet, we still have the power to transform. And Love is the key.

My grandmother taught me that Love is the most powerful heafer.

When my sister lay in a coma, and we were told that she would die or be a vegetable, I chose to trust the power of Love to keep us connected and to heal her. When she was in the coma, I talked with her every day, and at night I'd ask her to send me a dream. And she did. Each step she made, each tiny bit of progress fed my knowing, though there were dark days and times when I questioned whether I was just being delusional. But then my inner voice said, "No, Susan. You are just tired." After all, I was pregnant too! Eventually, even her doctors pronounced her life a miracle.

How could I have any doubt about the power of love after such an experience


Certainly, our current reality is bigger than anything in my little life. But the energy, the process, the truth of it is real, and applies to all situations.



Grandmother Gayle-Black Bear is a storyteller and inspirational speaker who encourages others by sharing her transformation through a lifetime of challenges and trauma. She began her neurodivergent lifepath with her first of several near-death experiences at birth, which affected her perceptions of life. Living in a small town in rural Ontario, Canada, Gayle has had to put her own words into action. She no longer wanted to work behind the scenes, anonymously fearful of judgment.

Gayle accepted an invitation speak about her journey to mental health for her local Wellness Centre's tenth-anniversary celebrations. She sat on the Wellness Centre hospital board as a client representative and became Chair of Public soon Relations for the Wellness Centre. where she was also appointed editor of their newsletter. The hospital board of directors later nominated her for the "Courage to Come Back' award, which was designated by the "Centre for Addiction and Mental Health Foundation" in Toronto.

This award recognizes individuals who overcome mental illness and then proceed into the community to aid others experiencing the same hardships. Chosen by the Wellness Centre (2004), she represented the organization at the local board of education. She spoke in high schools throughout the County about the stigma of mental illness.

Her physical, emotional, and cognitive limitations have not prevented her from having adventures around the world.

From personal experiences, growth, and cellular memories, Grandmother Gayle shares her insights on overcoming trauma. Her wisdom, rooted in the primordial knowledge of the ancients, was gleaned from her ancestral DNA, which spanned many cultures of Mother Earth. The ancient ancestors that she taps into are Pagan, Viking, Celtic, Shamanistic Mongolian, Siberian, Ukrainian, and Tribal knowledge. These ancestors have helped her share stories of healing and challenges.

These stories are available in three languages in her book, "Challenges of Awakening – Living Parables." The English and German versions will be used in her upcoming online school called "Academy of Timeless Wisdom", Wisdom from the Beginning of Time. The soon-to-bepublished Greenlandic version has been donated to the libraries of Greenland.

Gayle's ceremonial drums, shipped to 12 countries around the world, are each one-of-a-kind, personalized drums. Using the vibration of the drum and her ancestral stories, Gayle helps others awaken to self-awareness. These special and magical drums not only promote healing but also guide and teach the client, raising their vibration and aiding in a deep meditative journey.



In the fall of 2024, just before my 70th birthday, I had a regression session with a trusted friend and energy practitioner. One of his instructions was to travel into the future to see what I could see. As I fell deep into my subconscious, I found myself walking through a long stone tunnel. It felt like Pele's lava tunnel that I had visited in Hawaii a few months earlier. I could see in the dark as I journeyed toward a black hole far off in the distance. The long tunnel wound and curved, but the black hole did not seem to get any closer.

Finally, I reached a Y in the tunnel with a rock wall directly in front of me. I have been on similar vision journeys before, where a decision has been made to take one path or the other. Sometimes, I am forced to go back and take the other path instead, which we often do in life. I stood in front of the rock wall, wondering which path was the correct path for me to follow. After a few seconds, the rock wall in front of me began to shape-shift, and as it shifted, I realized it had become a giant head of a stone dragon. Even though it was made of stone, the dragon was alive, and as the dragon's eyes moved, it looked me straight into my soul.

The dragon slowly began to open its mouth wide, as wide as the tunnel I was standing in. Revealing another tunnel, it energetically encouraged me to step into its mouth and follow the path straight ahead. I was not to veer off to the right or the left but to keep going straight ahead.

It was not long before I could see the light coming from a bend in the tunnel, which inspired me to keep going. I reached the end of the tunnel, where an opening revealed a beautiful landscape with a view overlooking the valley below and clear blue skies above.





Suddenly, written across the sky were the wo A NEW WORLD.

The dragon is a sign of growth, transformation, and renewal. They are leaders who inspire others to pursue their dreams and make a positive impact. They are also adventurers who love to explore and learn new things. The dragon symbolizes power, transformation, and spirituality, and also represents good luck, fortune, and prosperity. In some cultures, the dragon is a protector and is often associated with royalty. The dragon spirit animal can also symbolize self-love and empowerment. I was encouraged to take the path straight ahead, without fear, and step into the mouth of the dragon, following the path to a new world. A new world within my self-awareness. This was the vision that appeared to me several months previously and reappeared when my thoughts pondered the message from the newly commissioned drum I was working on.

I had set the vision aside for several months until I was to create a drum for my Icelandic Soul Sister. When I asked the ancestors what messages and confirmations they wanted to share with her, this vision kept reappearing. It was an incredibly fitting message, as we were planning a powerful caravan tour with women from around the world to create powerful ceremonies across Iceland.


Spirit had guided the creation of this special drum to shift vital energies during our ceremony on the Summer Solstice at Demsey Island, located at Iceland's Arctic Circle.

We set up the opening ceremonial altar with 9 of us in attendance. Nine is the number of completions. Our group's first sharing circle together revealed much wisdom for each of us to combine and grow with. These masterful women were all called here to create and explore the new world of energy within. The next day, we hit the road, stopping first at the geyser. We viewed the geyser steam vents, then we drove across the country into Iceland's wilderness; it was quite a bumpy ride on the rough gravel road. We camped overnight at the glacier in the mountains, where several of the women went for a swim in the thermal hot pond. There were a couple of ceremonies performed at the base of the glacier before we moved on to our next location.

Summer Solstice Ceremony Arctic Circle, Iceland

Nine women, nine Masters of Service, gathered on Grimsey Island, Iceland, at the Arctic Circle. The tentative intention for each of us was to step through the mouth of the dragon into a new world within. We would achieve this through the challenges we faced and overcame on this journey of a lifetime. It felt like we each came on this adventure with no agenda other than to surrender to life's unfolding events. The bigger purpose of a ceremony for world peace and healing Mother Earth was still a mystery.

I was kept awake all night as I received download transmissions the night before our gathering on the beach on the North Atlantic Ocean. As I lay in my bed in the caravan, I could feel the entire island swaying beneath me. I could not believe what I was experiencing and wondered what it all meant. I visualized the island protruding up from the ocean floor like a stubby finger pointing skyward.

I was aware of the geographical split across Iceland, separating the North American and European continents. I wondered if that split also cut Grimsey Island in half, creating two fingers side by side. If so, that could explain the movement I was feeling as the two continents drifted and moved next to each other.

The visual of a rocky protrusion jutting up out of the ocean floor reminded me of Centre Mountain at Machu Picchu. During my visit there in 2013, the ancients showed me what life was like in ancient times. I was shown 1000 priestesses chanting into the many alcoves sprinkled around the spiral temple built into the side of the mountain. These alcoves faced Centre Mountain, and as they chanted into the alcoves, their sound frequency vibrated the stand-alone mountain, which in turn vibrated the entire mountain range. The range stretches from the southern tip of South America up to Alaska.

We each returned to our homes and our lives around the world, contemplating all that we had experienced, and all that was yet to come.





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Kintsugi Woman Rituals & Reflections

Kintsugi Woman Rituals & Reflections is an offering of healing, remembrance, and reclamation. Each day invites you to celebrate, pause, and reflect on the cracks that shaped you. Through simple rituals and soulful prompts, we RISE together.

1: Cracked Open

Ritual: Light a candle and name one crack you carry with love.

Reflection: The breaking wasn't the end. It was the beginning of your becoming.

CTA: Share your crack story or journal it privately. Your truth is sacred.

2: Golden Threads

Ritual: Write down three moments where pain led to beauty.

Reflection: The gold isn't what you lost, it's what you found inside the loss.

CTA: List three things you're ready to release. Let them go.

3: Reclamation

Ritual: Speak aloud one truth you were once afraid to say.

Reflection: This is not just remembrance. It's reclamation. You are allowed to rise.

CTA: Tag a sistar who's reclaiming her voice. Let her know she's not alone.

4: Legacy Rising

Ritual: Place your hand over your heart and whisper the name of a woman who shaped you.

Reflection: Her story lives in you. Her strength pulses through your veins.

CTA: Honour her in your journal or share her name in the comments. Let her light rise.

5: Presence Over Perfection

Ritual: Sit in silence for 3 minutes. Let the cracks breathe.

Reflection: Healing isn't about being flawless. It's about being fully here.

CTA: Place your hand over your heart. Feel your becoming.

Let this be your reminder: You are not stuck. You are shifting. You are not broken. You are becoming! You are not small. You are rising. The clay chrysalis was your sacred shelter. And now, as it splits, you SHINE!.

Walk alongside me for a while...

The labyrinth of my life curves, turns, and twists, but it always leads me deeper, cracking me open.
Each curve, and unexpected turn brought me closer, not to perfection, but to the woman I was becoming, not despite the breaking, but because of it. To self. There comes a moment when the path no longer leads outward, but inward, and the whispers of the soul grow louder.

This is the beginning of the labyrinth, not a place of confusion, but of initiation guided by passion and spirit, our internal GPS. Here, I meet myself. Wounded. Wise. Whole.

Each twist and turn is a conversation with my past, each pause a whispering of my truths. I entered not to escape life, but to reclaim it. I have stumbled. I have knelt. I have wept. RISING!



I was born into a conservative Mennonite family. The first of eight siblings. Epilepsy, grand mal seizures, until I was 18. I dropped out of high school. I rebelled. I was the <u>purple sheep</u>, different. than others. Leaving the community, naive, finding myself.

I continued the labyrinth, another corner in my life to turn.

I worked retail. I married a Punjabi man. We had two children. Later, after having my children, I returned to college as a mature student, worked in offices as an Admin. Life was busy. We built a life. Became a grandmother.

And then, turning another corner, I broke.

A car accident. Divorce after thirty years. Daughter with squamous cell carcinoma and thyroid cancer and so much more.

The labyrinth twisted again.

I didn't know where I was. What to do. But I kept walking. Step by step. Shedding the old self, breaking through. I started over. On my own. No map. No guarantees. Just faith, trusting myself, I was ENOUGH. I stepped into healing. Not the kind that promises quick fixes, but the kind that asks you to sit with your soul and listen. INHEALING, EXHEALING. I entered a coaching program. Not just to learn, but to unlearn. To peel back the layers. To love myself again, to reinvent myself. I believed I was enough.

Another corner turned

I found love again. A new life partner. Someone who saw the gold in my cracks. Not the polished version, one, but the woman still chose to let go and speak the words that needed to be heard.

Continuing the journey with me

In the summer of 2024, I went to the cottage on vacation, but bronchitis had other plans. Stuck inside, I found GGCN on Facebook and connected with Mayana. That conversation led to a newsletter, and then I said, "I could make a magazine." I'd never made one before. Finding purpose to share stories, empower women grandmothers, and create a space where our voices would be heard. I am here. Not where I expected to be, but exactly where I'm meant to become. With a magazine born from a movement sparked by connection, and a heart wide open to the stories still unfolding. Each step is becoming. Each turn, a reminder: creation doesn't need credentials, just courage. And so it began and continues. I am Kintsugi Woman. I am the gold. I am the story still unfolding and we are just beginning. Bolder, Braver Boomers with a gray tsunami of grandmothers.

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Fractured we Flourished


Together, we create atapestry ofhealing.

I was with you through the tears, I read your stories, I saw you break through the "WHAT IF'S" and let go of another layer of FEAR. YOU let go and stopped listening to what your grandparents said, your parents said, your religion said, your culture said, your friends said. YOU started listening to your heart, the innate whispers of self that loved you and believed in you. YOU began trusting yourself and didn't care what others thought.

The betrayal, lies, of self to our bodies, minds, and lives of nothingness, forgetting we deserved more, needed, and wanted more? Broken, we are beautiful. Fragmented, we have f lourished.

Weaving Connection with The Kinship Way

Throughout human history, people have connected with each otherin

many formsofKinship or clan council inrelationship with water & governing lunar cycles. In more recent times, with the quest for so-called 'progress', humans have shifted away from living in alignment with natural law while moving toward extractive practices. Much of this shift is the result of colonization which has been destructive to all forms of Kinship separating & isolating us while disconnecting us from nature.

Extractive colonized choices have led to our current predicament, where we have reached or exceeded 6 or 7 of 9 planetary tipping points. Exceeding just one of these tipping points is a disaster, but exceeding 6 or 7?

Are we able to recognize the urgency for Kinship & identify the current state of planetary collapse we are living in?

Many people are feeling overwhelmed, isolated, frustrated & traumatized. To continue without changing course would be to choose the charred path that is expressed in Indigenous prophecies & teachings. If humans

in Indigenous prophecies & teachings. If humans are to survive, it is urgent to choose another path, one that reconnects us with our gifts & responsibilities.



This vision is inspired by the teachings & wisdom of Indigenous community members, the way of water & how Mother Earth humbly regenerates herself.

Can we remember that, like Mother Earth, we are 70% Water, we are all Water beings? Can we create water cultures of care that reconnect us to sacred sovereignty? Can we share our gifts generously, identify our responsibility to Water by re-adopting her sovereignty model in a Kinship commons to heal & regenerate our broken water cycle?



Designing new practices invites us to live into our gifts, listen, witness, feed, nourish, tend, teach, share & care for ourselves and all beings in reciprocity.

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Waterloom is an ongoing immersion that weaves water consciousness & connection to create & demonstrate new ways of thriving with the Kinship Way. We are weaving the teachings of The Kinship Way (Becky Big Canoe), The Way of Water (Bree **Leggett) & The Creative** Way (13 Moons by Jennifer Luxmore-Begin) to design & create Kinship commons frameworks to responsibly care for each other at all stages of life alongside Water & all beings.

Through The Way of Water, we weave new fabric with water, our common thread, to create tapestries that connect & heal our broken water cycle in harmony with Grandmother Moon & her gracious governance. Participate in immersions or arts in action installations to lift water & create a heathy circulatory system with Kin so we can weave in & honour our gifts with reciprocity.

Through The Creative Way, we are inspired by Anishinaabe moon teachings, ways to be together creatively with invites to find your way to ceremony & celebration where we flow with art, music, dance, feasts, fashion & fun. We follow fun to create healthy cycles within our watersheds. This is a culture of care where we thrive, recognize & celebrate Water as Kin within Kinship clans created according to the The Kinship Way.

The Design School for Regenerating the

Earth is a wonderful place & platform
where we can connect with people who
understand the urgent need for change
from all over the world & find inspiration,
teachings, resources and courses to assist
and support us in our regenerative efforts
to create this new culture of care. We

In many Indigenous cultures, being a member of a kin group confers certain privileges, such as being in council with other members to inform the Headman and/or Headwoman of the kin group about the state of wellbeing within the group and about measures needed to enhance the wellbeing of the group as a whole. It would also include the right to assistance with matters such as housing and food, as well as medical and spiritual care.

The Kinship Way embraces a new way of introducing ourselves,

a practice that honors and deepens our connection to place and our vital role in restoring the relationship with the land. As a member taking part in council, you will rise and share:

- Your name.
- Your kinship group.
- Your watershed and bioregion, acknowledging the land you belong to.
- Your age advisory council designation (youth, adult, middle, senior, or elder).

A statement about your relationship to your bioregion, articulating your commitment to representing and stewarding a chosen species or element of the ecosystem.

This act of sharing underscores our belonging to our kin, establishes our connection to the land, and reinforces our commitment to being mindful and responsible stewards of the earth and all its relations. Finally, every community that becomes a Community of Care and has all 12 kinship groups in operation, if it has an opportunity to choose a name, should make reference to the watershed it is in, in its name.

Johal Grandmathers Council

I've been working in the trenches, mostly outside of public view, on many areas of a good life. My first passion is natural building, mostly because I built a straw bale house to live in, and I'm well aware of the despicable housing conditions a great many of my people live in. So I involve myself with other women and grandmothers who are trying to create some assistance to those who need homes and housing.

At this time, I formally work for the Ecological Farmers Association of Ontario as the Indigenous Outreach and Engagement person, and I find this work so rewarding. As our people reclaim food sovereignty, we have so much to relearn about gardening, farming, ranching, and wild harvesting. This wonderful organization is so helpful and supportive to both new and experienced farmers in Indigenous communities. We have our 2nd Annual Indigenous Growers Gathering coming up in December in London, Ontario, and we have a full roster of interesting presentations, keynotes, and workshops.

I'm also a founding member of the Mno Aki Land Trust, which seeks donated lands for the benefit of our people to have spaces to reconnect to Mama Aki (Earth) and practice many forms of land-based learning and cultural revitalization. The idea with Mno Aki is to bring Grandmothers into the stewardship role by determining what the donated lands will be used for, as it is possible that grandmothers know best what is needed by the people of their communities.



Born out of Indigenouslifeways, this vision emerged during a time of global pause and personal healing. It carries the medicine of circles, councils, and storie s that have long toward humanity balance. This idea was born from several inspirations but is mostly attributable to 'spirit', that mysterious force in our lives that we should listen to with humility.

It also comesfrommyloveof and respectformypeople, the Anishinaabeg of the Great Lakes regionofNorthAmerica, and our doodemagsystemthat pre-dates colonialism. Also known as aclansystem, it provided guidanceandstability our everyday lives to helped all ofustoknowour roles and responsibilitiesaswe moved through life. It helped all clanmembersknow


the parts of society to which they are meant to contribute to the best of their ability, building on their strengths and talents.

As I waslistening to conference presenters at the 7th Generation Bioregional Earth Summit 2024, I heard various speakers talk about how we need to put lots of effort towards stewarding and healing large parts of our ecosystem that have been damaged by industrialism and colonialism. The speakers were both Indigenous and non, and as I heard theIndigenous presenters speak, eachone began their presentationby givingtheir name, their place of originand their clan affiliation.



ARE ALL RELATED

Kinship begins with the principle that all life is related. It is not a metaphor, it is a worldview. Each action, decision, and relationship in The Kinship Way is guided by values such as respect, reciprocity, humility, accountability, and equity. Humanity can draw upon the enduring legacy of indigenous peoples worldwide, who masterfully employed such systems to organize themselves and to disseminate knowledge, standards, stories, observances, responsibilities, and protocols. One of the main features of a kinship system is the creation of relationships among members and in relation to members of other kinship groups. All members of the same kin group, no matter where they are in the world, are 'kin' to one another. The relationship of brotherhood and sisterhood is promoted as the ideal because it is important that everyone experiences a feeling of belonging and connection in the world. However, personal autonomy and personal boundaries are always respected because each being is naturally endowed with a sense of sovereign-self and the right to personal self-actualization within mutually agreed upon societal boundaries, such as "do as thou wilt and harm none".



When I heard the main presenter stating that we needed a way to help connect people to the land and restoration work, it occured to me that the answer had already been spoken by the Indigenous presenters - the best way forward is the clan system! Clans effectively tie you to family, land and your specific role. This includes the natural world as the inspiration to help humans understand their connection to the web of life.

This need for connection was heightened by the pandemic. With people everywhere feeling so disconnected, isolated and lonely. With so many people suffering, it occurred to me that we needed an antidote that connected us into a community of caring and peer support. Most of all, I was totally convinced that we need to co-create a self-governing society that is prosperous and stable for the wellbeing of the children of the world and the next seven generations to come

Becky Big Canoe is an accomplished **AnishinaabeKwe** mother, sustainable housing proponent, writer, artist, activist and powwow dancer. She lives on Georgina Island. She is actively involved in the Mno Aki Land **Trust. Becky works** with EFAO's Indigenous **Outreach** and **Engagement Steering Committee** to support knowledge sharing events, mentorship and soil testing for **Indigenous** growers and communities.











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
