Croc! at Queensland Museum

Dig It Tamborine Mountain



Queensland's first mini excavator park!

Dig It Tamborine Mountain is Queensland's first mini excavator park for kids big and small! Here, you will sit in the drivers seat of real excavator machinery and participate in construction-inspired activities. It's fully instructed fun for kids and their parents too! You don't need any experience, just a willingness to give it a go,

Dig It is split into four zones, with each zone having 3 mini excavators (aside from the RC Zone). After listening to your safety briefing, you get to head out to the Dig Zone and work your way around the four zones during your 2 hour session. At each zone, 3 participants will be on machinery at a time, meaning it rotates through participants pretty quickly and you never have to wait too long for a turn. Once you've marked off all four zones on your Induction Card, you're welcome to revisit any of the zones if you still have some time left over. There are also 2 free play areas that you can use at any time: a large sandpit filled with trucks and mini excavators, and a gravel digging area with shovels, wheelbarrows, gravel and foam building blocks.

Children aged 5 years and over can participate on their own, while children under the age of 5 must participate on the lap of a parent. For the children operating solo, parents are welcome to stand on a special platform right beside the machinery, but you are not allowed to touch the machinery – your job is to talk to them and give verbal guidance if needed.

\$65 per participant. Children 4 years and under must participate in the lap of an adult, there is no charge for that adult.
