Hebrews 12:18-24 (NKJV) 18 For you have not come to the mountain that may be touched and that burned with fire, and to blackness and darkness and tempest, 19 and the sound of a trumpet and the voice of words, so that those who heard it begged that the word should not be spoken to them anymore. 20 (For they could not endure what was commanded: "And if so much as a beast touches the mountain, it shall be stoned or shot with an arrow." 21 And so terrifying was the sight that Moses said, "I am exceedingly afraid and trembling.") 22 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angels,

23 to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are registered in heaven, to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men made perfect, 24 to Jesus, the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than that of Abel.

WHAT IS GERD (Gastroesophageal Reflux Disease)

GERD occurs when your lower esophageal sphincter (LES) doesn't tighten or close properly allowing excessive digestive juices (acid) and other contents of your stomach to back up to your esophagus. If you experience acid reflux symptoms more than twice per week, you may have GERD. If left untreated, it may lead to serious complications.

SYMPTOMS

- * A burning feeling in your stomach that may rise to your chest, neck and throat
- * A sour or bitter taste at the back of your mouth
- * Regurgitation of food or liquid from your stomach into your mouth
- * Bad breath
- * A hoarse voice or chronic cough

ALARM SYMPTOMS (If you are experiencing any of these, get medical attention)

- * Difficulty swallowing (dysphagia)
- * Pain when swallowing
- * Weight loss
- * Anemia or bleeding

CAUSES

- * Frequent large meals
- * History of hiatal hernia
- * Lying down too soon after meals
- * Bending over too soon after meals (Ex. Bending over to weed the garden)
- * Taking aspirin or ibuprofen too often
- * Drinking alcohol may increase the risk of GERD
- * Obesity or pregnancy
- * High fatty foods such as fried or fast foods
- * Spicy foods
- * Certain fruits and vegetables such as pineapple, tomato and citrus

COMPLICATIONS

- * Esophagitis – inflammation of your esophagus
- * Esophageal stricture – your esophagus narrows or tightens
- * Barrett's esophagus – permanent changes to the lining of your esophagus which can result in esophageal cancer
- * Tooth enamel erosion, gum disease or other dental problems

TREATMENT

- * Lifestyle and dietary changes
- * Medications prescribed by your doctor - proton pump inhibitors, antacids and H2 receptor blockers
- * If these do not work, you may need surgery

The Importance of Humility (part 4)

Ask yourself, how much of the meek and lowly Lamb of God do you see around you, in those who are called by His Name? Think about how many Christians that you know that have a lack of love, that are indifferent to the needs of others or the feelings and weaknesses of others. How many make sharp, hasty judgments and utterances?

All manifestations of temper and irritation, bitterness and estrangement have their root in pride. And pride seeks only itself.

Think of what would happen if Christians were to become permanently guided by the humility of Jesus? If people were only able to keep devilish pride from creeping in.

You need to study the humility of Jesus, for humility is the hidden root of your redemption. Believe with your whole heart that Christ- whom God has given us, will work in us, making us what the Father wants us to be.

Luke 22:27 tells us this about Jesus, "I am among you as he that serveth." In the Gospel of John, much of our Lord's life becomes open to us. He frequently speaks of His relationship with His Father, of the motives by which He is guided, and of His consciousness of the power and spirit in which He acts. Even though the word "humility" is not used, there is no other place in the Bible where His humility is so clearly revealed. In Jesus we will see, how both as the Son of God in heaven and as man on earth, He took the place of entire subordination. He always gave God both the honor and glory that was due to Him, thinking not highly of Himself. Luke 18:14 tells us, "That he who humbles himself shall be exalted." And Philippians 2:8-9 says, "He humbled Himself wherefore God also hath highly exalted Him."

Let's look at some scriptures in John where Jesus uses the words "not" and "nothing" concerning Himself. John 5:19, "The Son can do *nothing* of Himself." John 5:30, "I can of my own self do *nothing*; my judgment is just, because I seek *not* Mine own will." John 5:41, "I receive *not* honor from men." John 6:38, "I came down from heaven, *not* to do Mine own will." John 7:16, "My doctrine is *not* Mine." John 7:28, "I do *nothing* of Myself." John 8:42, "*Neither came I of Myself*, but He sent Me." John 8:50, "I seek *not* My own glory." John 14:10, "The words that I speak to you, I speak *not* from Myself." John 14:24, "The word which ye hear is *not* Mine." These words open to us the deepest roots of Christ's life and work. They tell us how it was that the Almighty God was able to work His mighty redemptive work through Him. They show us how important Christ counted the state of heart which became Him as the Son of the Father. They teach us what the essential nature and life is of that redemption which Christ accomplished and now communicates.

Christ was nothing, that God might be all. He resigned Himself with His will and His powers entirely for the Father to work in Him. Of His own power, His own will, and His own glory, of His whole mission with all His works and His teaching, He said, "It is *not* I; I am *nothing*; I have given Myself to the Father to work. I am *nothing*, the Father is all."

If only we all had that same attitude, and would give ourselves to the Father to work, how much better would the world be? And how much more joy would be in the world if we could?

Kingdoms of Glory

Three Kingdoms of Glory exist: the Celestial Kingdom, the Terrestrial Kingdom, and the Telestial realm. The glory we attain depends on the magnitude of our conversion, as expressed by our obedience to God's commandments. It will depend on the extent to which we have received "the testimony of Jesus."

Each of us will correspondingly receive an eternal dwelling place in a specific Kingdom of Glory. The Lord taught this principle when He said, "In my Father's house there are many mansions" (John 14:2). Jesus has taught us that there are "many mansions" in heaven: "In my Father's house there are many mansions; If it were not so, I would have told you; So, I am going to prepare a place for you." (John 14:2). And there are heavenly bodies and earthly bodies, but the glory of the heavenly is one, and the glory of the earthly is another. One is the glory of the sun, another the glory of the moon, and another the glory of the stars, for one star is different from another in glory.

So is the resurrection of the dead. (1 Corinthians 15:40-42). Paul wrote that at the judgment, a person's works might be added to his reward or consumed in flames, but either way, he can still be saved: "If what anyone has built remains [on the foundation of Jesus Christ], he will receive his reward, but if the flames consume his work, he will suffer loss. He shall be saved, but as one passeth through fire" (1 Corinthians 3:14-15 -NIV).

Paul also noted that he had seen a vision of the "Third Heaven." (2 Corinthians 12:2). Consequently, one might logically conclude from these passages that the recipients of salvation will be assigned to different rewards within at least three different "heavens" or "degrees of glory." Our understanding of the passage is that the Apostle, desiring to describe the significant difference between those who rise again in Glory, that is, of the saints, borrows a comparison from the heavenly bodies, saying, "One is the glory of the sun, another the glory of the moon, another the glory of the stars."

2 Corinthians 12:2-4 I am compelled to boast, though nothing is gained by it. I pass to refer to the visions and revelations of the Lord. 2 I know a follower of Christ who, fourteen years ago, was taken to the third heaven. I don't know if it's in or out of the body; God knows. 3 And I know that this man—I don't know whether in the body or apart from the body, God knows—4 was taken to paradise and heard unspeakable things that we humans are not allowed to express.

Psalms 148:4 Praise him, ye most high heavens, and ye the waters that are above the heavens. So, we can say that any ancient Jew believed in a hierarchical series of heavens, and a visionary journey through them was a common theme in Jewish (and even Christian) apocalyptic scriptures, or like Paul who was using the "third heaven" as the epitome of the highest degree of exaltation, personal presence, and greater joy. The Lord revealed to the prophet that those who deny the Holy Spirit thus commit an unforgivable sin, giving Him an inglorious kingdom called "outer darkness."

A rattlesnake bit one of my sheep in the face about a week ago. Deadliest snake that lives around here. The sheep's face swelled up and hurt her terribly. But the old rattlesnake didn't know the kind of blood that flows through the sheep.

Access to the Throne

Matthew 27: 50-51 [BSB] When Jesus had cried out again in a loud voice, He yielded up His spirit. At that moment the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. The earth quaked and the rocks were split. The tombs broke open, and the bodies of many saints who had fallen asleep were raised.

At the very moment that Jesus yielded up His spirit to death, the veil of the temple was torn; no time was wasted as the perfect work was accomplished. As the veil was torn, the spiritual division between God and man was destroyed.

The veil in the temple separated the outer room (Holy Place) from the inner room (the Holy of Holies). The Holy of Holies housed the ark of the covenant which is symbolic of the Throne of God. In the Old Testament times, only the High Priest could enter the Holy of Holies. Even then, he could only do so on Yom Kippur, the holiest day of the year. The veil was said to be as thick as the size of a human hand, perhaps showing that man's ability to seek God by his own strength was not possible. The veil tearing ends the striving and allows us the clear path to seek and know God without limitation.

The work of the cross allowed for man and God to be totally reconciled into a place of supreme intimacy. This was the joy that strengthened Jesus to endure his great trial.

Hebrews 12:2 Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Ephesians 2: 6 And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus.

We now have access to the very Throne of God, where every good thing is. Instead of seeking after these things, we can enter into a place of peace and rest, where these things will simply come to us as we fellowship with the Godhead.

Matthew 11: 27-28 All things have been entrusted to Me by My Father. No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and those to whom the Son chooses to reveal Him. Come to Me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.



THE THRONE OF GOD

[Isaiah 55:8-9] 8 “For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways,” declares the Lord. 9 “As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts. (NIV)

It’s easy to get wrapped up in our own logic and thinking. Sometimes, we might feel we can guess what is going to happen next because of our experience in a given situation. This might be useful on the job while utilizing our expertise in various situations – but it doesn’t work very well with God.

We don’t fully understand God, and often times what we think is going to ‘happen next’ can turn out to be something different altogether. I am fond of a particular Scripture that highlights this concept. You may read Matthew chapter 16 for the full context. Jesus encourages Peter that it is God who revealed to him that Jesus is the Christ.

In Matthew 16:17-19, Jesus encourages Peter for having the revelation from God that He (Jesus) is the Christ.

Jesus then explains that He must go to Jerusalem to suffer and be crucified. Peter exclaims that such a thing shall never happen to Him! In the next breath, Jesus rebukes Peter by addressing Satan within him. I wonder how Peter might have felt, going from high praise to a sharp rebuke in a matter of a few verses.

Sometimes we get a really good prophetic word and it might go to our head. Its intention is to encourage us to keep going forward and not give up – but we don’t always see God’s intention. Like Peter, we might become a little too bold after a good word. It doesn’t mean there isn’t some evil lurking within us. It doesn’t mean we aren’t currently doing anything wrong. God still sees our sin and shortcomings. The truth is never ‘on pause’ it’s just not being brought out at the moment.

Too many times we ride the roller coaster of prophetic glory. We listen to other people’s words and condemn them, or grow jealous of them. This shouldn’t be so, and there could be a strong rebuke right around the corner.

We should take everything God says and discern His truth that He is speaking to us. Let’s be encouraged by His goodness, but not get lost in it. We can fall and stumble as easily as the other person, but if we’re working on our own problems with God and praying for others struggling there is less room for the enemy to come in and work.

Part 3 Other Stains You May Encounter – Easy Ways To Remove Them

OTHERS

BLOOD – lemon juice, baking soda or hydrogen peroxide

Rinse the stain with cold water then dab the stain with hydrogen peroxide, leave it on for few mins until the stain disappears. Rinse it off and repeat until the stain disappears. You can also try lemon juice in substitute to hydrogen peroxide or also make a paste out of baking soda and cold water and apply it on the stain.

Once the stain is gone, laundry the cloth as usual.

Paint – nail polish remover

Scrap the excess paint using a blunt knife and then use a nail polish remover or just soak the cloth with some detergent.

Ink stain – Milk


Place a clean cloth underneath the stain so that it doesn't seep through to any other layers and spray the ink with hair spray or use a hand sanitizer until saturated. Let it soak for several seconds then blot ink stain with another clean cloth.

Repeat this process until gone. You may also soak the stain in milk overnight then wash as usual

All stain removal methods mentioned above should be applied prior to washing the garments. Stains that have been laundered and dried are very difficult to remove.

There are times when some of us can be really clumsy and drop on our clothes and stain them. Or maybe you're cooking in the kitchen and you drop some turmeric powder on your top!

Well, it can be quite a nuisance to get rid of these stains, right? Or maybe it needn't be, if you use the right method to get rid of these stains!
