Our project was shortlisted for the Community Care Initiative of the Year award at this year's HSJ Patient Safety





Our CEO, Volt Sacco, said: "This project demonstrates how collaboration, integration, technology and innovation can make a huge positive impact on people's lives. Given the financial pressures and the recruitment crisis across the health and social care system, the early detection of deterioration project showcases place-based delivery in action, through multi-disciplinary partnerships across domiciliary care and primary care."
