Lemonade on the Lawn



Book Club


We have such a good time discussing books and sharing life. Come join us in Room 4 at 7:00.

One change of venue during a summer month is that we will be meeting in Val Boyer's beautiful garden.






We're heading for Lancaster, PA, to catch Sight and Sounds' Production of Noah.


Vacation Bible School July 21 — July 25, 2025 5:30pm — 8:00pm
