Foundation Apprenticeships

NEW!

Foundation apprenticeships are entry-level, employed positions that offer a blend of practical workplace experience and focused off-the-job training. Unlike traditional apprenticeships that focus on a specific occupational specialism, foundation apprenticeships offer a wider perspective on a field

Benefits for your business

- Introduction of new talent and idea to your business through recruiting new staff
- Training to meet your business needs
- Increased staff loyalty and motivation

Cost

You must pay at least the apprentice minimum wage and you may need to contribute to training costs depending on the size of your business

Time

Duration is currently 8 months but can be extended.

Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are available to anyone over the age of 16 (meeting eligibility criteria). They combine on the job training with study to provide the knowledge, skills and behaviours required to fulfil the job role. You can offer an apprenticeship opportunity to new or existing staff. They are available from Level 2 up to degree level and can be undertaken in a range of business sectors.

Benefits for your business

- Introduction of new talent and ideas to your business through recruiting new staff and upskilling existing staff
- Training to meet your business needs
- Increased staff loyalty and motivation

Cost

You must pay at least the apprentice minimum wage and you may need to contribute to training costs

Time

Duration can vary between 8 months and 5 years

Supported Apprenticeships

The same as an apprenticeship, with added support given to the apprentice and you by your training provider if there are additional special needs required by the apprentice. This may include education or ability needs. They are available from Level 2 up to degree level and can be undertaken in a range of business sectors.

- Training to meet your business needs
- Increased staff loyalty and motivation

Cost

You must pay at least the apprentice minimum wage and you may need to contribute to training costs

Time

Duration can vary between 12 months and 5 years

Supported Internships

Supported internships combine studying with a work placement. They are available for young people, aged 16 to 24, with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND), who have an education health and care (EHC) plan.

Benefits for your business

If you host a work placement, you can:

- Shape a job role for the needs of your business and the supported intern.
- Save on recruitment costs and improve recruitment prospects.
- Hiring your intern at the end of the programme increases your confidence of employing individuals with additional needs and diversifies your workforce.

Cost

A supported internship is a free government scheme, but you may have your own business costs, for example time spent training.

Time

A work placement can range from 6 to 12 months.

T Levels

Short for Technical Levels, T-Levels are for learners aged 16 to 19 in England who have finished their GCSEs. T-Levels combine classroom learning with an industry placement.

Benefits for your business

If you host an industry placement, you can:

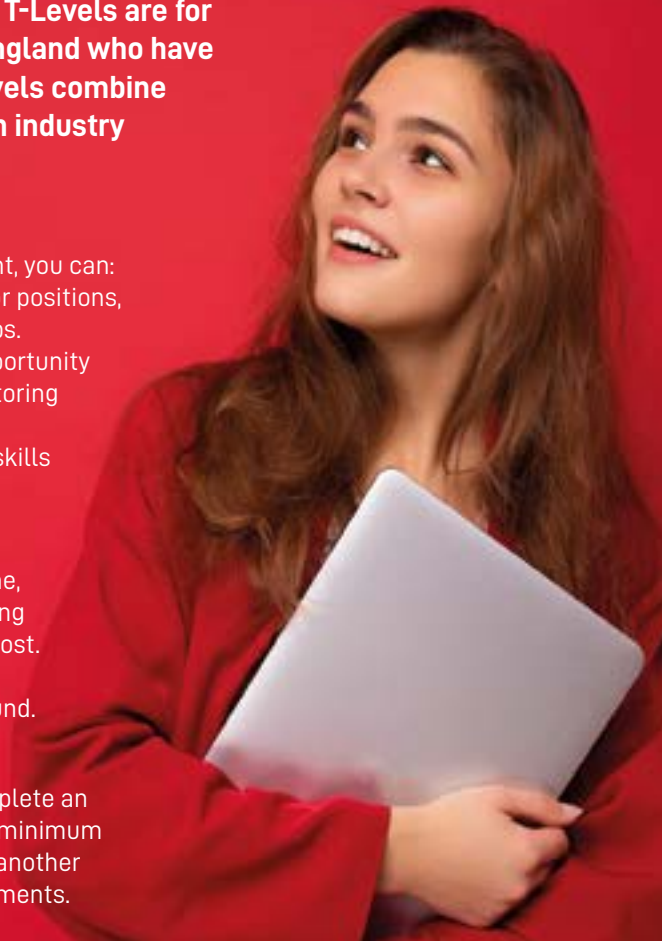
- Build a talent pipeline for junior positions, apprenticeships and internships.
- Give your existing staff the opportunity to gain management and mentoring skills.
- Train a young person with the skills your business needs.

Cost

This is a free government scheme, but you may have costs depending on the industry placement you host. Some costs may be reimbursed through the employer support fund.

Time

Every T Level student must complete an industry placement that lasts a minimum of 315 hours. You can work with another employer to host industry placements.

Skills Bootcamps

Skills Bootcamps are flexible training courses for adults aged 19 or over, and are available in a range of sectors such as digital, engineering or green skills. They can help you upskill your existing workforce or recruit new talent. Skills Bootcamps are developed and delivered in partnership with your business and can be offered full or part-time.

Benefits for your business

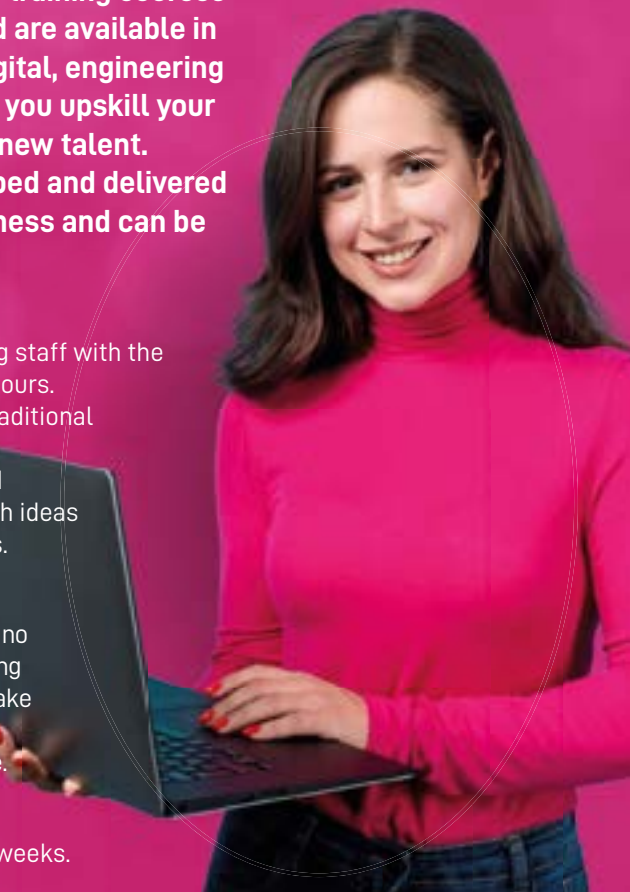
- Quickly recruit and upskill existing staff with the right knowledge, skills and behaviours.
- Reduced costs associated with traditional recruitment processes.
- Boost productivity with motivated attendees who can introduce fresh ideas and perspectives to your business.

Cost

You can recruit potential new staff at no cost to your business. If you are training your existing staff, you will need to make a training cost contribution of 10% or 30%, depending on your business size.

Time

Skills Bootcamps can last up to 16 weeks.

Continuous Professional Development Courses

CPD Short for Continuous Professional Development Course. They can either be nationally recognised qualifications or bespoke courses designed and tailored to your business need. These are, in the main, funded by you the employer.

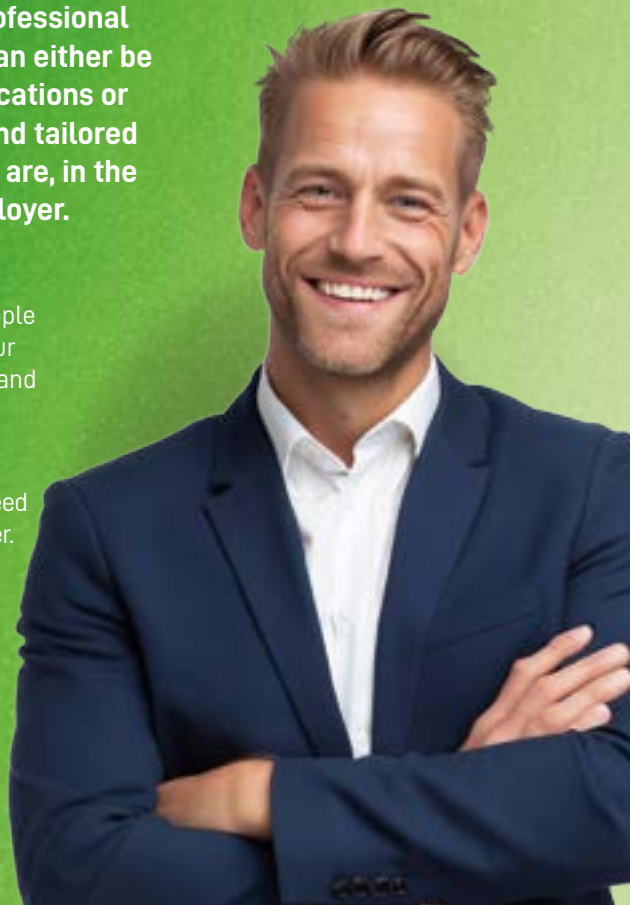

The cost of courses varies and is agreed between you and the Training Provider.

Course durations can vary widely depending on what you have commissioned your Training Provider to deliver.

Sector-based Work Academy Programme (SWAP)

A sector-based work academy programme (SWAP) offers jobseekers the opportunity to train and work with your business. You can offer a SWAP to individuals 16 and over who are claiming benefits.

The programme includes pre-employment training, a short work placement, and a job interview or help with the application process.

Benefits for your business

If you offer a SWAP, you can:

- Recruit staff with the right skills.
- Meet immediate and future recruitment needs.
- Access a large pool of candidates.

Cost

Free through government funding, but you may have business costs, such as time spent training.

Time

A SWAP can last up to 6 weeks.

Adult and Community Learning

There are a range of courses available, including:

- English and Maths courses (including qualifications such as GCSEs and Functional Skills)
- Digital Skills & IT
- Skills & Development
- English for Speakers of Other Languages

By offering your staff courses or additional training, you can:

- Promote learning culture and upskill your employees in their current role or support them to progress into higher skilled roles.

Higher Technical Qualifications

Higher Technical Qualifications (HTQs) are high-quality and job focused level 4 and level 5 qualifications, such as Foundation Degrees, Higher National Certificates and Higher National Diplomas that have been tested against standards

Benefits for your business

By offering a HTQ to your existing employees, you can:

- Support your employees to upskill, retrain and improve their skills.
- Create an environment that promotes learning and development.
- Make your business more competitive

You can also recruit specialist and skilled individuals that already have HTQs.

Cost

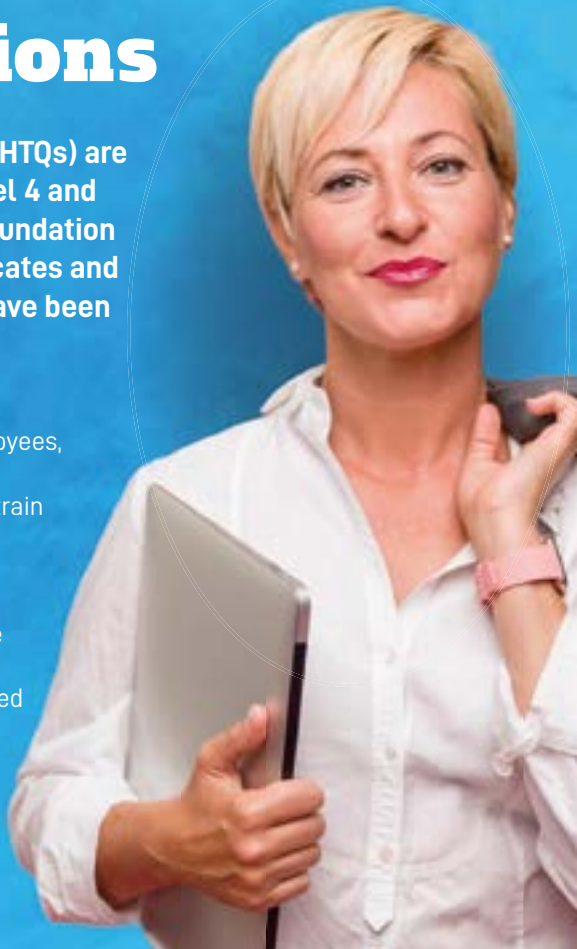
HTQs are eligible for the same student finance offer as a degree, but you can choose to pay for HTQs for your current employees.

Time

Range from 1 to 2 years full-time study, with part-time and distance learning options also available. Most HTQs do not require a work placement except when this is mandated by the professional and statutory regulatory requirement.
