I was recently watching a news story entitled, “It is the way the game is supposed to be played so, why is it such a big deal?” The story took place in June of 2016 at the Indiana State Baseball Championships, during which a player from the winning team went onto the mound to console the losing pitcher, who was laying on the ground visibly upset, rather than embarking in a celebration with his teammates.

At the end of the story, the newscaster made a point to say, “The actions of the player reflected on the coaches and the parents of the kid. Somebody is doing something very right.” Adults in the player’s life, leading by example.

When the newscast finished, I pondered about why the story made the news. I was happy that the actions of the boys made national headlines, but saddened that acts of sportsmanship are not the norm. The realization that stories like this are highlighted because they are seen as something special and extraordinary was disheartening to me.

Throughout this year, the NMAA and our member schools are focusing on the importance of sportsmanship by coaches, players and spectators. When you attend a game as a spectator, remember that you too are setting an example for the kids on the court or field and for the individuals around you. Remember that it takes just one person to make a difference and the way you act can set an example for your community.

Be mindful of the example you set in whichever role you play in interscholastic athletics – as a coach, a parent, a player or a spectator. Be POSITIVE and support your team, without being negative towards opponents or contest officials. We need to all be a part of changing the culture of interscholastic athletics so that doing what is right is no longer newsworthy. Competing with Class should be the rule, not the exception.

Let us all band together and lead by example. Show the youth of today that sportsmanship matters. Show our student-athletes the proper way to win and lose. Show our “leaders of tomorrow” that their character far outweighs their performance. In New Mexico, our news story should always read, “It is the way the game is supposed to be played so, why is it such a big deal?” In New Mexico, let good sportsmanship and positive behavior always be the norm.

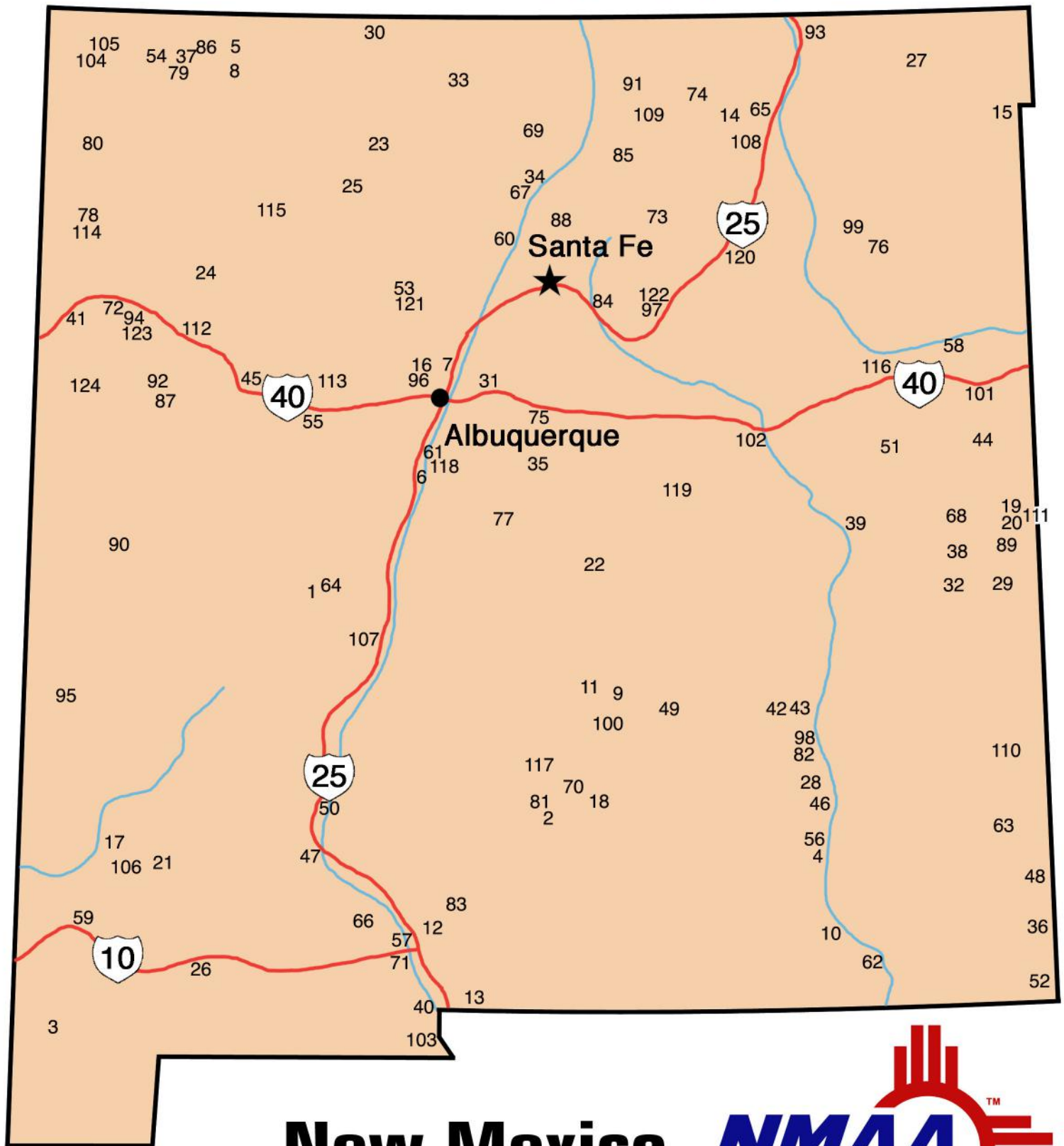

Legend of the Pool La Cueva's Jeremy Bastian



Some student-athletes who perform well in the pool go on to accomplish even bigger things outside the water. This is true about this year's "Legend of the Pool" spotlight on Chaplain, Major Jeremy Bastian. Born in Albuquerque in 1976, Jeremy first got involved in swimming at the age of 11. "My mother swam growing up in Casper, Wyoming and she got me involved," said Jeremy. Once at the high school level, he continued to compete in the pool for La Cueva High School. His primary event was the 100m butterfly. "I believe I ranked 7th in the state in 1995," he recalled. Jeremy helped set a new state record as a member of the boys' medley relay team (the record was recently broken in 2018). "I was never truly gifted as a swimmer, but I enjoyed contributing to a team of outstanding individuals who worked hard every day."

To get an even closer look at him, you can speak to those who spent a great deal of time with him, such as his high school coach. "Jeremy was part of my first full 4-year graduating class at La Cueva," said former Bears coach Quint Seckler. "You will not find a better man, a better leader, or a better family guy anywhere. Jeremy was one of the most respected student-athletes to ever wear the navy blue."

Jeremy graduated high school in 1995. He then went on to attend Baylor University to pursue a degree with a Religion Major and Chemistry Minor. Two years later, he married his high school sweetheart, Chelsea Black, who attended Albuquerque Academy

as well as Baylor. Jeremy's path then took him in a direction of service. "My grandfather and father served in the United States Air Force and I was born at Kirtland Air Force Base (NM)," Jeremy described. "Later, we moved to Colorado Springs, CO and I joined the Reserves." Jeremy served at the Air Force Academy. "After one tour with the AFA cadets and cadre and seeing their commitment to excellence and selfless service, I considered it an honor for me and my family if they would accept me into active duty and join their profession and calling. They accepted me and I am grateful."

Jeremy is currently a chaplain with the United States Air Force and, over the course of his career, has been stationed in Massachusetts, Honduras, Washington, Afghanistan, Turkey, New Mexico and, currently, Germany where he plans to be for two more years. He currently serves as the Installation Chaplain assigned to 470 Air Base Squadron, North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) Air Base in Geilenkirchen, Germany. In this role, he directs all multi-national ministries for 5,100 members and 17 NATO partner nations to facilitate religious and spiritual accommodations for all component forces and their dependents. He has received multiple awards and decorations for his work. He was awarded the Air Force Meritorious Service Medal with one oak leaf cluster, the Air Force Commendation Medal with two oak leaf clusters, the Joint Service Achievement Medal, along with an Air Force Recognition Ribbon.



Five years ago, Jeremy lost his sister suddenly to an unexpected blood clot that took her life. It was Jeremy's connection to his former coach that helped him get through the tragedy. "This was/is devastating to my family as I suddenly became an only child to my parents," Jeremy explained. "The funeral was held in Colorado Springs and in that time of darkness, chaos, struggle and grief, Coach Seckler walked through the door of the church and I was simply stunned and overwhelmed with gratitude. While I had not seen him in 15 years, he came to the funeral and was a pillar of strength and support to me and my family."

Jeremy has learned that in a person's greatest time of need is when other people make the most difference by reaching out and helping. Jeremy Bastian is one of those individuals who now helps others when the time arises.

Jeremy and Chelsea recently celebrated 21 years together. They have three children, Kyle (12), Eli (10) and Luke (8).

What do you remember most about your high school experience? Do you have a favorite memory?

Looking back, I remember the people and the blessing of those who invested into me. Parents, siblings, pastors, teachers, coaches, mentors and peers play a large role into who I am today. If there is one thing I wish to express, it is this: thank you! I could never fully convey my gratitude to those who spent countless hours mentoring students such as myself because I know we carried those memories/lessons for a lifetime.

My two favorite memories: 1) restoring a 1969 Mach I Mustang with my father. It's still an on-going project since 1992, but I think we are almost done with it (I say this every year); 2) Riding the Iron Horse Bicycle Classic (a 50-mile bike race from Durango to

Silverton, Colorado) with my father; he was a dentist in Albuquerque for over 30 years.

Who's been your role model?

By His grace and mercy, I fall far short of emulating Christ but He is the one for me.

What is the best thing about being overseas?

It is humbling to visit WWI and WWII sites and walk the hallowed grounds where Americans served and gave their lives so that we would be a free people. I simply cannot express the feeling of reverence in visiting places like Normandy and the Battle of the Bulge.

You mentioned that about five years ago your sister suddenly passed away. What kind of relationship did you have with her? Were you competitive with one another in the pool?

Sara Bastian was a tremendous person; this is not as her brother but as someone who has heard amazing stories from people she knew. In high school, she won State all four years in soccer, I believe she won two State championships in swimming and State with the track team. Her senior year, she was a captain of three sports teams (soccer, swimming, track) and those teams won State championships. She was a National Honor Society member and won many awards and recognitions.

Yet, Sara truly loved the Lord and served Him faithfully. Her life was the profession of her faith and cared more for Him and people than all the recognition. She served in the Peace Corps for three years on a small African island named Cape Verde, she travelled to China to support children, and invited an immigrant to live with our family who had no money or support for a year. Wherever there was a need, she offered care and compassion with a fierce dedication to be what is good for this world.

What would you tell someone interested in joining the military or becoming a chaplain?

Walk by faith and you will arrive to the place God has called you; whether it be the military, becoming a chaplain or wherever you might be called to serve.

ELDORADO WINS 2018 STATE TITLE



Eldorado Boys, 2018 State Champions



Santa Fe Prep Boys, 2018 A-4A State Champions

The Eldorado Eagles hoisted the blue trophy overhead at the 2018 U.S. Bank State Swimming & Diving Championships. With the win, the Eagles collected their 10th boys' title, the first since 2015. Eldorado tallied 300 points on their way to the title, followed by Albuquerque Academy (272.5), La Cueva (272), Cibola (197) and Sandia (180).

Seven of the 12 events in the boys' state championship meet fell over the two-day event, including the 200-yard medley relay, the 200-yard freestyle, the 200-yard IM, the 500-yard freestyle, the 100-yard breaststroke, the 200 & 400-yard freestyle relays.

Darien O'Donnell, Tyler Thibodeau, Ben Waterman and Logan Ellis of Eldorado, broke the first record of the meet in the 200-yard medley relay in a time of 1:34.34, while Jake Hoagland of La Cueva captured gold in the 200-yard freestyle in record-breaking time of 1:38.07.

Josh Harlan of Cibola broke his own state record set back in 2017 in the 200-yard IM in a time of 1:48.04, over three seconds faster than his previous record time. Hoagland of La Cueva broke his second state record of the meet, this time in the 500-yard freestyle in a time of 4:28.19.

Sandia's 200-yard freestyle relay team of Maxwell Hawton, Cade Wintheiser, Joseph Jaramillo and Joseph Cecco was just under record time, touching the pad in a time of 1:25.95. Harlan also broke his set state record of the meet, this time in the 100-yard breaststroke in a time of 56.29, breaking a record that had stood since 2012.

The championship ended with one final record-breaking performance by the Eldorado Eagles in the 400-yard freestyle relay. O'Donnell, Blaze Sheldahl, Ellis, and Waterman touched the pad in a time of 3:09.39.

Issaac Newman of Eldorado ran away with the 1-meter diving competition with a score of 555.95, followed by Jake Gatten (416.65). Newman's score set a new pool record and earned him his second straight diving title.

For the second straight year, Santa Fe Prep laid claim to the blue trophy, tallying 71 points overall. Taos (8) finished second.



2018 State Championship Recap

CHARGERS HOIST BLUE TROPHY FOR THE SECOND STRAIGHT YEAR

The 2018 U.S. Bank Girls' State Swimming & Diving Championships came down to two teams battling for the blue trophy until the very end. When the dust settled it was the Albuquerque Academy Chargers standing atop the podium with a team score of 419, followed by the La Cueva (320). It was the Chargers' second straight state title in swimming & diving and their 17th overall.

Cottonwood Classical captured the A-4A State title, marking the first state championship in swimming & diving in school history.

One state records were broken during the 2018 State Championships, in the 200-yard freestyle. Albuquerque Academy's Sara Vianco broke the record in a time of 1:48.45, beating the old record by almost a full second. Vianco also took home the title in the 100-yard freestyle in a time of 50.69.

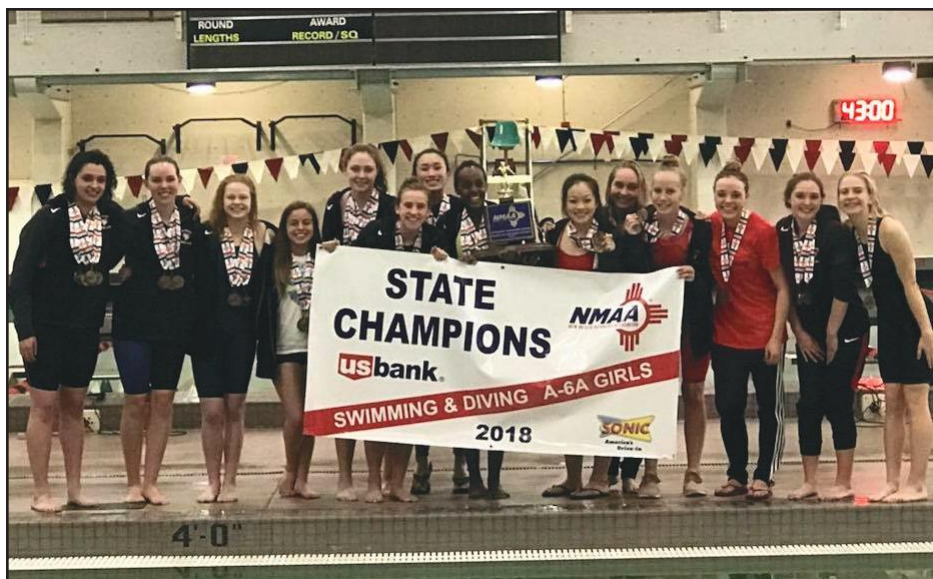
The 200-yard medley relay the La Cueva team of Madeline Mee, Anita Sumali, Chrysten Pacheco and Natalie Jones took home gold with a time of 1:47.11, over two seconds faster than their closest competitors. Lauren Burckel of Eldorado won both the 200-yard IM (2:05.00) and 100-yard breaststroke (1:02.20), defending her title in the breaststroke from the 2017 championships.

Natalie Jones of La Cueva was also a repeat winner from 2017 winning the 50-yard freestyle in a time of 23.69. La Cueva's Chrysten Pacheco grabbed her second medal of the meet with a winning time of 56.0 in the 100-yard butterfly, while Allison Bernier of Albuquerque Academy stood atop the podium in the 500-yard freestyle with a time of 5:05.85.

Las Cruces' Jacque Cervantes-Vanderlugt, Susan Gormley, Sierra Ortiz and Sarah Gormley won the 200-yard freestyle relay (1:3.24) just three-tenths off the state record, as Sandia's Fiona Trotz-Chavez took gold in the 100-yard backstroke in a time of 57.39.

The Bears dominated the relays during the meet, capturing the 400-yard freestyle relay in a time of 3:31.32.

Albuquerque Academy's Lillie Guo won gold in the 1-meter diving competition, tallying 471.45 points, besting Jessica Albanna of Albuquerque High who finished with 392.05 points. Guo captured her second state title in as many years.

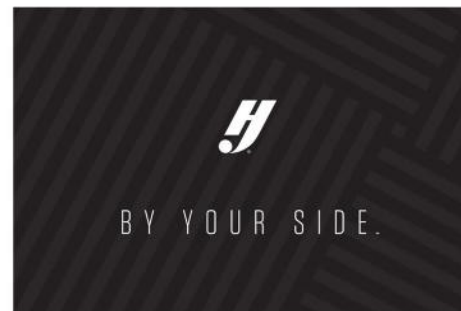

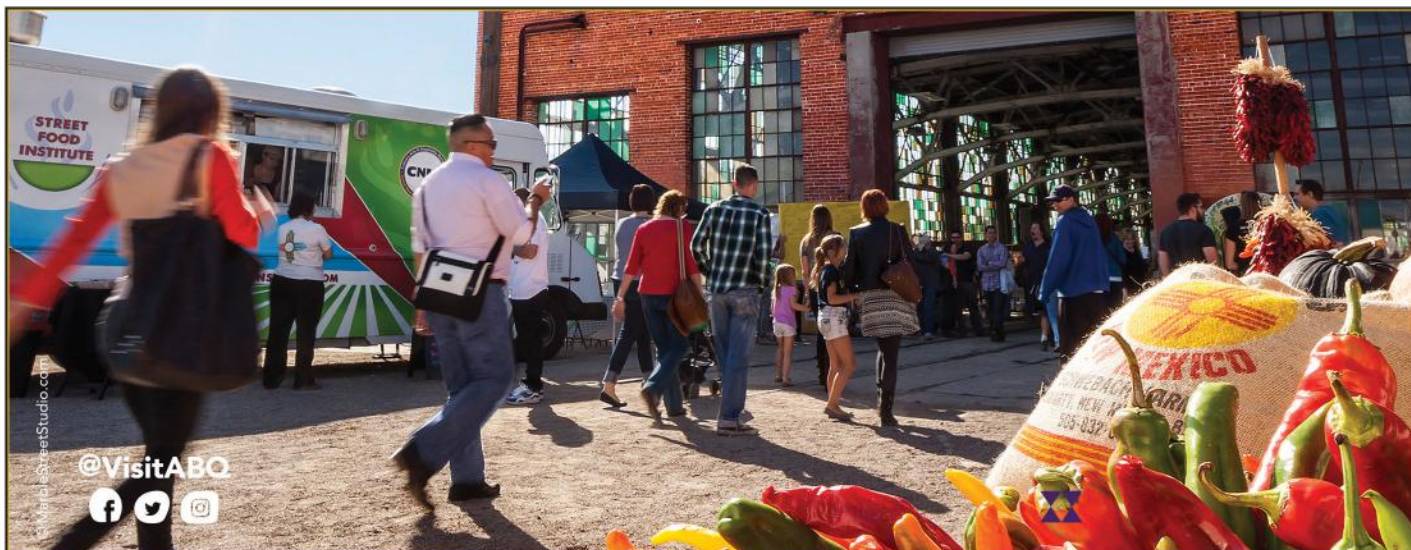

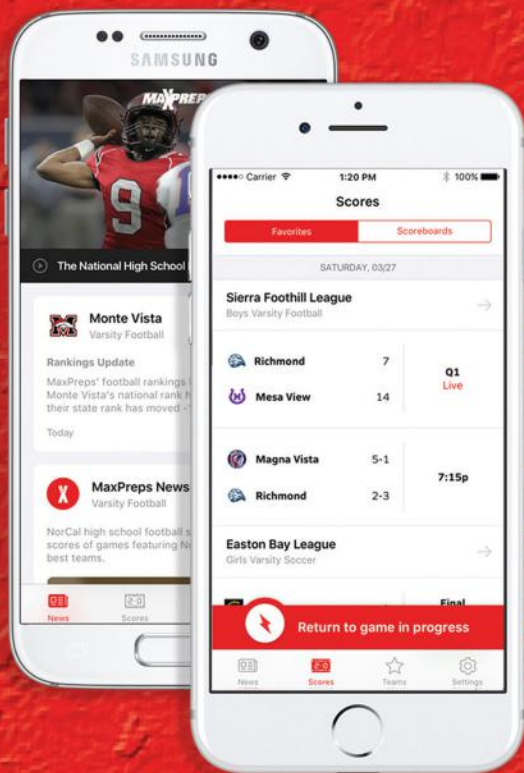
