Promoting International Epilepsy Day

International Epilepsy Day 2025: Campaign Launched to Close Seizure First Aid Knowledge Gap. New findings from Amárach Research have found that less than half of the Irish population would know what to do if they witnessed a person having a seizure.

The research, which was commissioned by Epilepsy Ireland, has been released to coincide with International Epilepsy Day and the launch of a new campaign by the organisation highlighting how seizure first aid is clear when you know what to do.

Epilepsy is a neurological disorder which affects the brain. It is a tendency to have repeated seizures. This tendency can be long term, but the seizures can be controlled meaning that a person can have epilepsy, but they may not have active seizures. Seizures can start in a part of the brain or happen in both sides of the brain at once.

Over 45,000 people in Ireland have epilepsy meaning it is one of the most common neurological conditions in the country, while over 50 million people live with epilepsy worldwide.

For many people, their epilepsy affects them most while seizures are active. For others, the impact of having epilepsy may be longer term, if their seizures continue.


